GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor offshore; boats land at Codrington waterfront

Best For: Pristine pink-sand beaches, frigatebird watching, snorkeling

Walk to town: Codrington village is steps from the tender landing; beaches require a taxi or tour

Don't Miss: Codrington Lagoon frigatebird colony — one of the largest in the Western Hemisphere

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Codrington Lagoon Frigatebird Sanctuary** — Explore the mangrove-lined Codrington Lagoon by small boat to witness one of the largest magnificent frigatebird...
- **Pink Sand Beach at Low Bay** — Low Bay's powdery sand takes on a rosy blush from crushed coral and shell fragments — one of the finest pink-sand...
- **Snorkeling the Barbuda Reefs** — The island's western and southern reefs offer vibrant coral and abundant marine life in gin-clear water.
- **Martello Tower & Highland House** — Barbuda's Martello Tower is a 19th-century British lookout tower on the south coast.
- **Two Foot Bay & Indian Cave** — On Barbuda's northeast coast, Indian Cave shelters Amerindian petroglyphs estimated at several hundred years old, set...

BEST WALKS

- **Codrington Village Stroll** ~0.5 mi | Easy | 20–30 min — From the waterfront landing, walk along the main street through Codrington to see the small market, local shops, and Barbuda's modest...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash only. There are no ATMs on Barbuda. Bring USD or XCD — all transactions are cash. USD is universally accepted.
- Pack sun protection. The tender landing has no shade and the beaches are open. Sunscreen, hat, and water are essential.
- Negotiate tours upfront. Agree on price, stops, duration, and number of passengers before getting into any taxi or local boat.
