GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tied alongside a small riverside quay; most ships dock directly — no tender required

Best For: Wine estate visits, day trip to Salamanca, dramatic Douro gorge scenery

Walk to centre: Village is right at the pier — about 2 min walk, but facilities are very limited

Don't Miss: The Almirante Sarmiento Rodrigues Bridge viewpoint over the gorge

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €40–€50 to Pocinho

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Salamanca, Spain — Full-Day UNESCO City** — One of Europe's finest historic cities, about 2 hours by bus (≈122 km).
- **Castelo Rodrigo Hilltop Village** — This fortified medieval village perches on a crag above the Douro Superior plain, with crumbling castle ruins, old...
- **Alto Douro Quinta Wine Estate Visit** — The UNESCO Alto Douro Wine Region surrounds Barca d'Alva.
- **Douro International Natural Park Walk** — Barca d'Alva sits within the Douro International Natural Park, a cross-border protected area renowned for birds of prey...
- **Côa Valley Archaeological Park** — About 30km downstream, the Côa Valley Palaeolithic Rock Art Site is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with open-air...

BEST WALKS

- **Village Stroll & Bridge Viewpoint** ~1 km | 20-30 min | Easy | River views — From the quay, walk up into the village centre, then continue to the Almirante Sarmiento Rodrigues Bridge over the Douro.

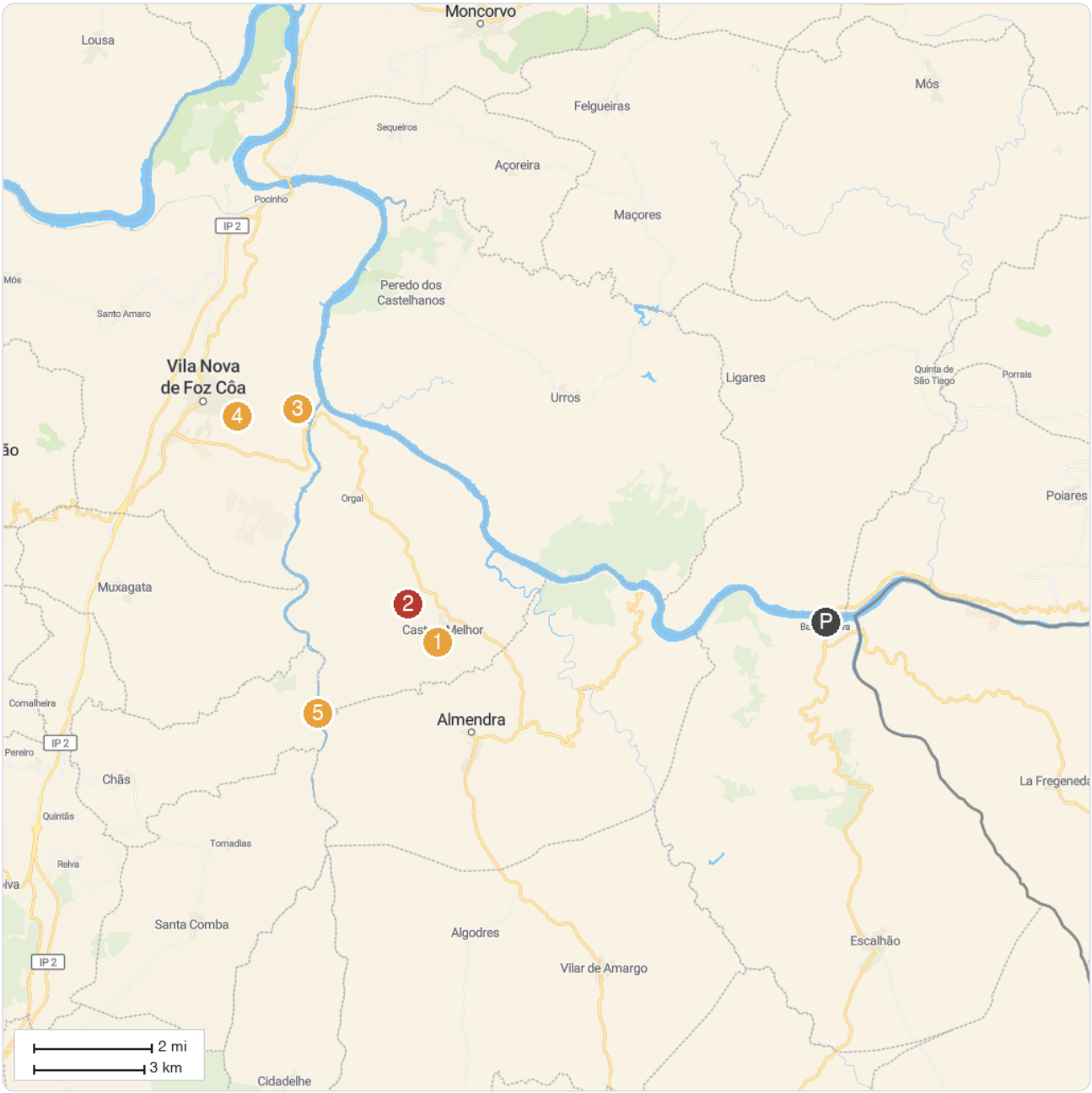
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash from Porto. Barca d'Alva has no ATM and almost no shops. Stock up with euros before you arrive, or rely on ship-board services.
- Book excursions early. Popular Salamanca and quinta tours fill up fast. Reserve through your ship before boarding or at least the night before this port call.
- Summer heat is intense. The Douro Superior valley can exceed 40°C in July/August. Carry water, wear a hat, and limit midday
