TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Sagrada Família** — Gaudí's century-in-the-making basilica is unlike anything on earth.
- **Park Güell & Gaudí Modernisme Trail** — Mosaic terraces, stone viaducts and panoramic city views — Gaudí's hillside park is a 45-minute metro ride from the port.
- **Gothic Quarter & La Boqueria** — Medieval lanes radiating from the Barcelona Cathedral to Plaça Reial — all within walking distance of the Blue Bus stop.
- **El Born & Picasso Museum** — Hipster Barcelona in a medieval frame: the Picasso Museum spans five Gothic palaces with 4,000+ works tracing the...
- **Montjuïc — Castle, Cable Car & Miró** — The hilltop fortress above the port offers the best views of your ship at dock and the city beyond.

BEST WALKS

- **La Rambla to Gothic Quarter loop** ~3 km · 1.5–2 hrs · easy — Walk up La Rambla from the Columbus Monument, detour into La Boqueria market for fresh juice, then wind through Barri Gòtic lanes to...
- **El Born & Santa Maria del Mar** ~2 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy — From the Gothic Quarter, follow Carrer del Born to reach El Born's indie boutiques and the stunning 14th-century Santa Maria del Mar...
- **Passeig de Gràcia Modernisme mile** ~2 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy — Barcelona's grand boulevard lined with Gaudí's Casa Batlló and La Pedrera (Casa Milà), plus Puig i Cadafalch's Casa Amatller.

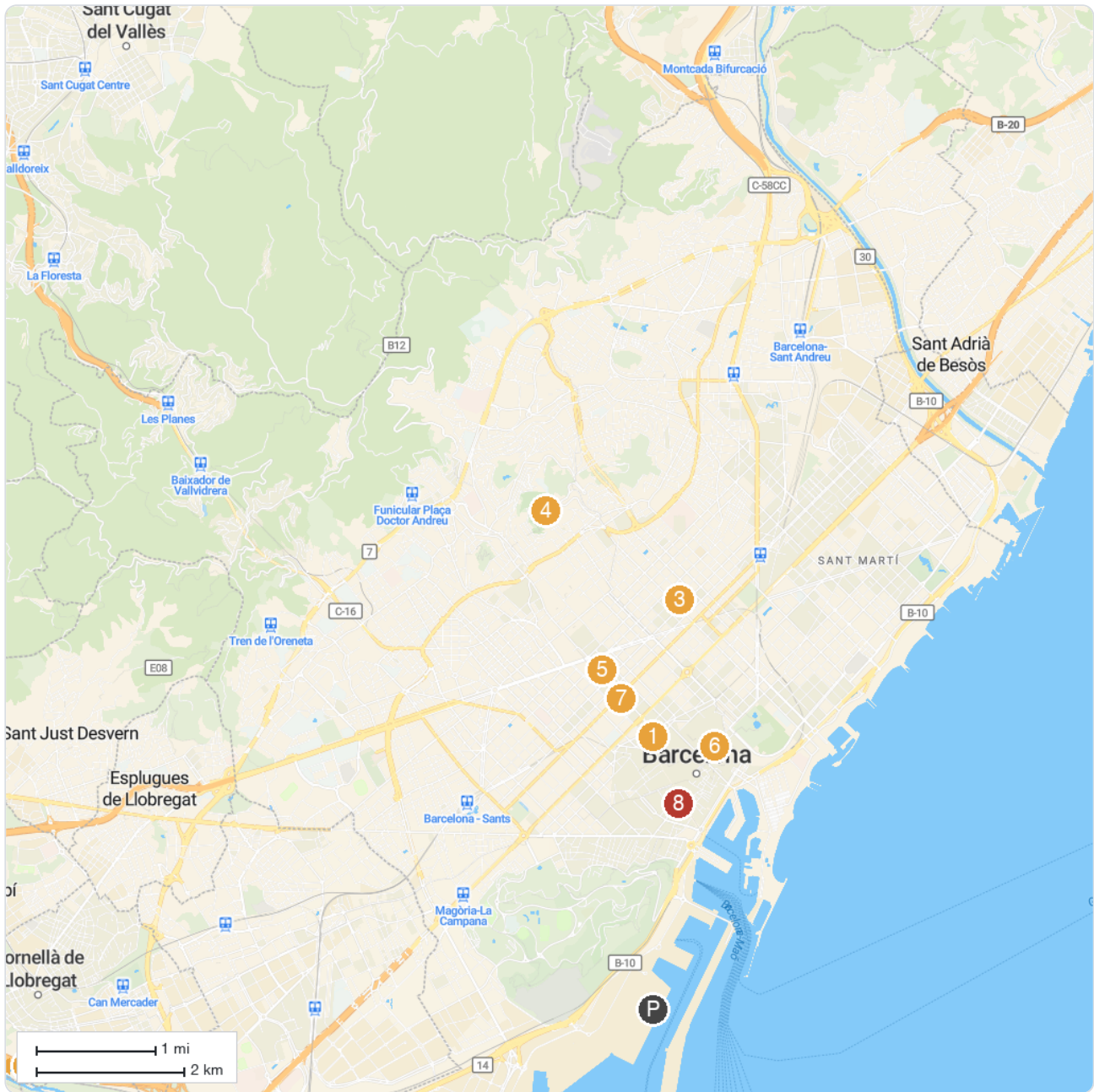
