

Utqiaġvik (Barrow), Alaska, USA

The northernmost community in the United States, Utqiaġvik sits where the Chukchi and Beaufort Seas meet — a place of polar light, Iñupiat tradition, and rare Arctic wildlife that few cruise passengers ever reach.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor offshore; no deep-water pier

Best For: Arctic culture, wildlife, bucket-list geography

Walk to center: ~10 min from tender landing to Whale Bone Arch / downtown

Don't Miss: Iñupiat Heritage Center and the Whale Bone Arch

Getting around: **Taxi** \$8 flat rate (within town); +\$2/person extra · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Iñupiat Heritage Center Tour** — The Iñupiat Heritage Center is the cultural heart of Utqiaġvik, with exhibits on language, traditional crafts, whaling...
 - Whale Bone Arch & Arctic Ocean** — Walk to the iconic arch made from bowhead whale jawbones overlooking the Arctic Ocean — a symbol of Iñupiat whaling...
 - Point Barrow — Northernmost USA** — A full excursion to Point Barrow, the northernmost tip of the United States,
- passing tundra landscape and the ancient...

 - Arctic Wildlife & Tundra** — Guided tundra excursions look for polar bears, ringed seals, walrus, caribou, and over 100 species of migratory birds.
 - Will Rogers & Wiley Post Memorial + Historic Sites** — Visit the monument commemorating pilot Wiley Post and entertainer Will Rogers, who died in a 1935 crash near Barrow.

BEST WALKS

- Downtown to Whale Bone Arch & Arctic Ocean** 1 km · Easy · 15–20 min — From the tender landing, walk along the seafront road to the Whale Bone Arch and the Arctic Ocean shore.
- Heritage Center & Town Walk** 1.5 km · Easy · 30 min — Walk from the town center past the Will Rogers and Wiley Post Monument to the Iñupiat Heritage Center on C Street.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Dress for Arctic conditions. Even in July–August, temperatures average 34–50°F (1–10°C) with wind chill. Waterproof layers and warm gloves are essential.
- Transport is very limited. There are few taxis and no car rentals. Book all excursions through your ship or a local operator
