GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River piers at St. Johann, Klybeck, or Dreiländereck — exact pier confirmed close to arrival

Best For: Art & culture lovers, Old Town strolls, Rhine river experiences

Walk to center: 10–15 min on foot from St. Johann; tram from Klybeck/Dreiländereck

Don't Miss: Basler Münster terrace view, a motorless Fähri river ferry crossing

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Basel Old Town (Altstadt) Walk** — Wander cobblestone lanes to the vivid red 16th-century Rathaus on Marktplatz, then climb to the Pfalz terrace at Basel...
- **Basler Münster** — Basel's great Gothic cathedral dominates the Rhine skyline.
- **Kunstmuseum Basel** — One of Europe's oldest and finest public art collections, spanning Old Masters to contemporary works.
- **Tinguely Museum** — Jean Tinguely's whimsical, noise-making kinetic sculptures fill a purpose-built riverside museum designed by Mario...
- **Rhine Fähri Ferry Crossing** — Ride one of Basel's four traditional motorless Fähri boats across the Rhine — they use only the river's current and a...

BEST WALKS

- **Rhine Promenade & Old Town Loop** 3–4 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Flat — Follow the Rhine north from St.
- **Dreiländereck (Three-Country Corner)** Easy stroll · 30 min from pier · Flat — From the Dreiländereck pier, walk to the obelisk monument marking where Switzerland, Germany, and France converge at the Rhine.

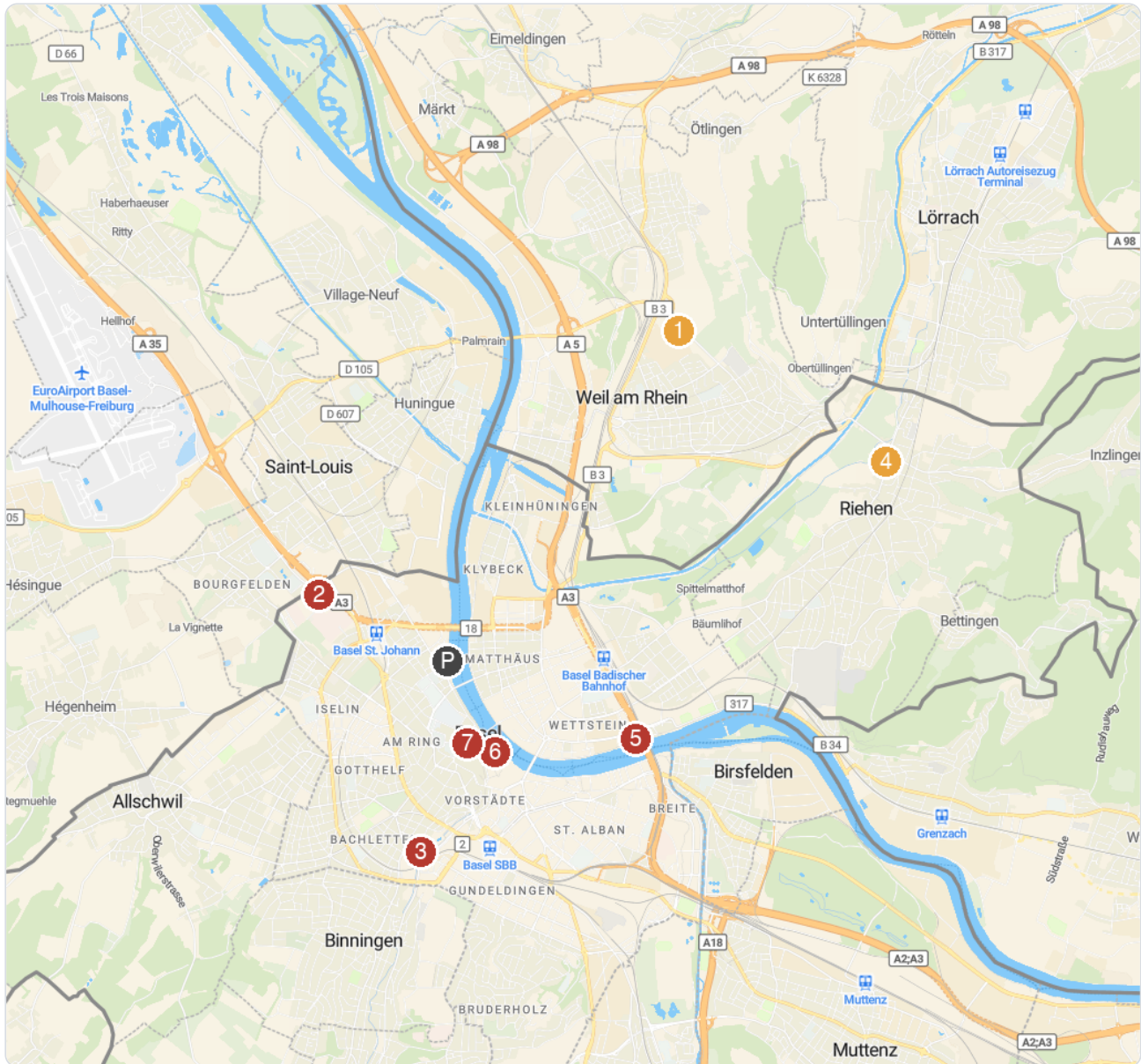
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Confirm your pier early. Basel has three docking locations — St. Johann is by far the most central. Check with your cruise director the evening before arrival.
- Trams are excellent. Basel's tram network is fast and reliable. A day pass (Tageskarte) covers all zones and pays off if you're moving around.
