GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier-docked on the northern waterfront; ~10-min walk to city center

Currency Tip: Euros only; ATMs in town. Cards accepted at larger businesses.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **La Soufrière Volcano Hike** — Hike to the 1,467 m summit of Guadeloupe's active volcano through mossy rainforest and sulfurous fumarole fields.
- **Les Chutes du Carbet (Carbet Falls)** — Three spectacular waterfalls inside Guadeloupe National Park.
- **Cousteau Marine Reserve Snorkel & Dive** — Jacques Cousteau called the Ilets Pigeon off Malendure Beach one of the world's best diving sites.
- **Fort Delgrès & Basse-Terre City Walk** — Explore the 17th-century Fort Delgrès, a significant landmark in Caribbean resistance history, then stroll...
- **Deshaies Botanical Garden** — A lush 7-hectare tropical garden in Deshaies showcasing over 1,000 species of exotic flowers, trees, and wildlife...

BEST WALKS

- **Basse-Terre Colonial City Loop** 1.5 km · ~45 min · Easy — From the cruise pier, walk south along the waterfront to Fort Delgrès, then loop through the historic center via the Cathédrale...
- **Cascade aux Écrevisses Forest Walk** 1 km · ~30 min · Easy — A short, well-marked jungle path off the Route de la Traversée leads to this lovely waterfall with a swimming hole — an easy reward...

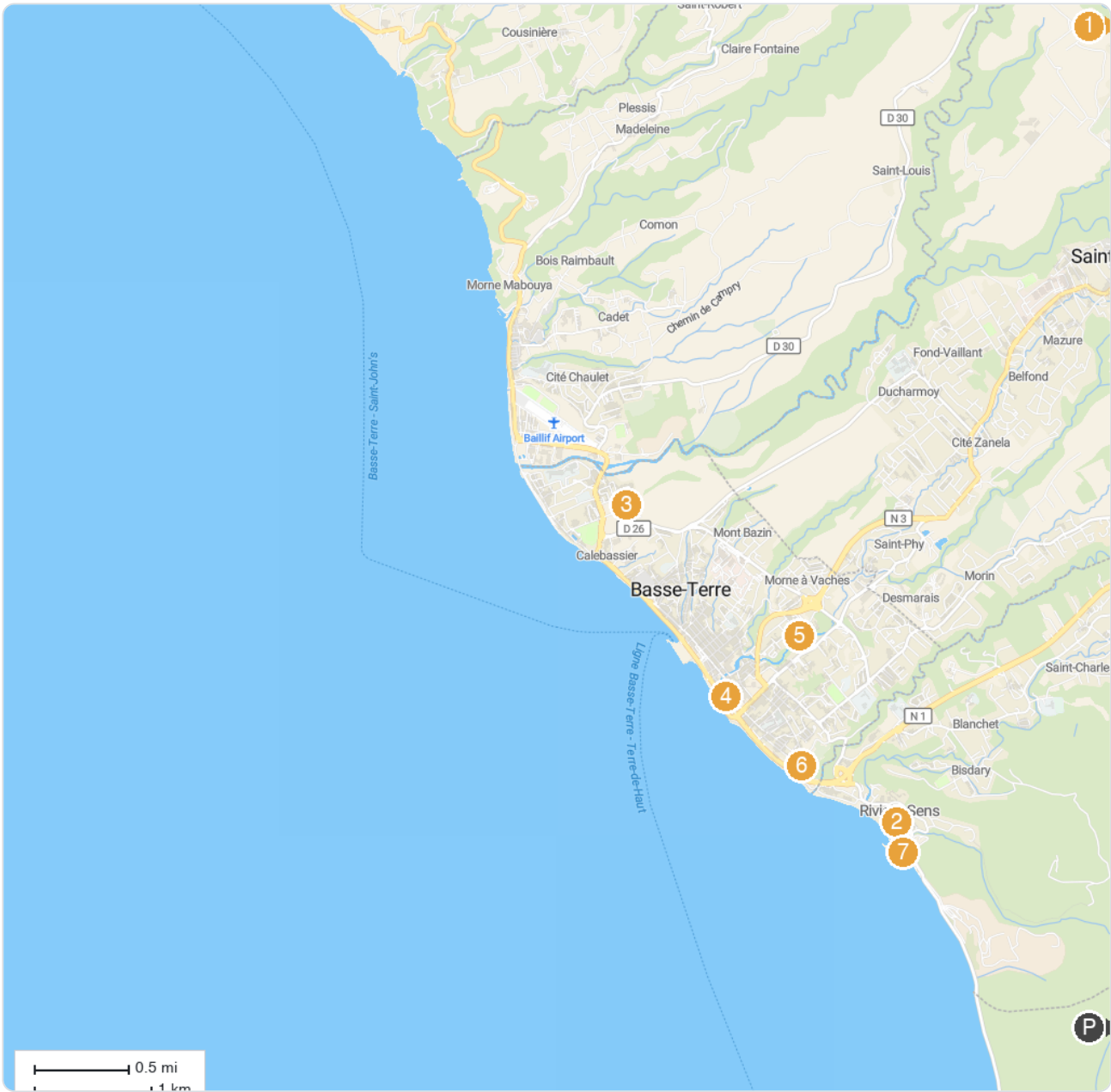
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Weather is unpredictable on the volcano. La Soufrière summit is often shrouded in cloud by midday — start hikes early and book a guide.
- Euros only — no XCD here. ATMs are available in Basse-Terre city. Cards accepted at restaurants and larger shops but carry
