GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Batumi Passenger Terminal — ships dock alongside; city center is a ~15-min walk or 5-min taxi

Best For: Scenic promenade strolls, Adjara canyon day trips, Georgian food & wine

Walk to center: ~15 min on foot to Piazza Square; Boulevard starts immediately at port

Don't Miss: Ajarian Khachapuri (boat-shaped cheese bread) and Martvili Canyon boat ride

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  5–15 GEL (~\$2–6 USD) ·  **Rideshare**  Bolt, Maxim, Yandex Taxi

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Martvili Canyon Boat Ride** — Board small wooden boats to drift through a turquoise-green gorge carved by the Abasha River.
- **Prometheus Cave & Underground Lake** — One of the largest caves in the Caucasus, with dramatic stalactite chambers and an underground boat ride on a...
- **Batumi Boulevard & City Walk** — Stroll the full 7 km seafront promenade past the Ali & Nino kinetic sculpture, the spiral Alphabet Tower, Piazza...
- **Gonio Apsaros Roman Fortress** — A well-preserved Roman fortification just 15 km south of Batumi, dating to the 1st century AD.
- **Adjara Food & Wine Village Tour** — Head into the green Adjara hills for tastings of Georgian wine, Chacha (grape brandy), homemade cheese, and a spread of...

BEST WALKS

- **The Boulevard End-to-End** 4–5 km · 1–1.5 hrs · Flat & paved — Walk north from the passenger terminal along Batumi Boulevard — past the Dancing Fountains, Europe Square, Piazza Square clock tower...
- **Old Town Backstreets** 1.5 km · 45 min · Easy — Duck behind Piazza Square into Batumi's compact 19th-century quarter: narrow balconied streets, the Church of St.
