Docking: Beaufort Town Docks, Front Street — small/mid-size ships only (up to ~250 ft); walk-off access to downtown

Best For: Wild horse tours, maritime history, Cape Lookout ferry, kayaking, waterfront dining

Walk to center: Immediate — dock is on Front Street in the heart of the historic district

Don't Miss: Ferry to Shackleford Banks for wild Banker horses; NC Maritime Museum (Blackbeard artifacts)

 - North Carolina Maritime Museum** — One of the best free maritime museums on the East Coast, showcasing Blackbeard's flagship Queen Anne's Revenge...
 - Beaufort Historic Site & Old Burying Ground** — Walk through nine preserved 18th- and 19th-century structures including the 1732 Old Burying Ground — one of the oldest...

BEST WALKS

- Front Street Historic Waterfront Stroll** 0.5 mi · 20-30 min · Easy — The classic Beaufort walk: stroll Front Street from the Town Docks past the NC Maritime Museum, boutique shops, and waterfront...
- Historic District Loop** 1 mi · 40 min · Easy — Extend the Front Street walk inland to the Beaufort Historic Site, where nine preserved 18th-century buildings cluster together.

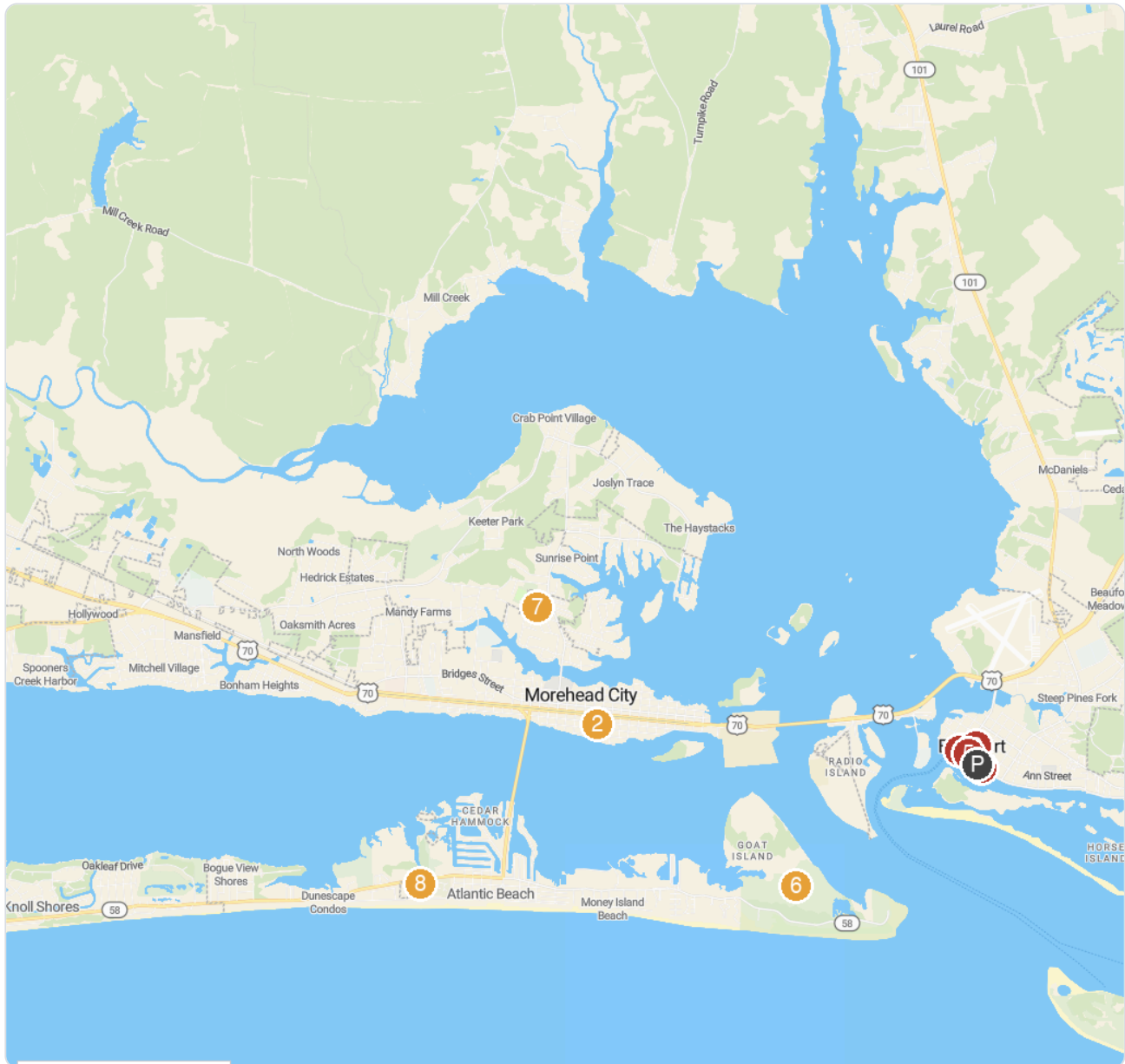
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
