GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock at Downtown Marina (Safe Harbor Beaufort) on Bay Street — steps from the historic district

Best For: History lovers, Gullah culture, antebellum architecture, and nature walks

Walk to center: Immediate — Henry C. Chambers Waterfront Park and Bay Street shops begin at the marina exit

Don't Miss: Old Point neighborhood mansions and a boat tour spotting dolphins in the Beaufort River

- **Historic District Walking Tour** — Guided 2-hour stroll through the National Historic District, past antebellum mansions in Old Point, the Verdier House...
 - **Gullah-Geechee Sea Islands Tour** — Motor-coach tour to St.
 - **Hunting Island State Park** — Five miles of uncrowded barrier-island beach, maritime forest trails, and a climbable
- 19th-century lighthouse with...

 - **Dolphin & Boat Tour** — Narrated open-water boat tour through the Beaufort River and tidal creeks searching for bottlenose dolphins, osprey...
 - **Kayak the Sea Islands** — Paddle through tidal creeks and salt marshes around the Sea Islands with a local guide — excellent for birdwatching and...

BEST WALKS

- **Bay Street & Waterfront Stroll** 1 mile | 30 min | Easy | Flat — Walk the length of Bay Street from the marina past antebellum storefronts, art galleries, and the Henry C.
- **Old Point Neighborhood Loop** 2 miles | 45-60 min | Easy | Flat — From the marina, head east toward the Point to explore Beaufort's grandest antebellum mansions draped in live oaks and Spanish moss.

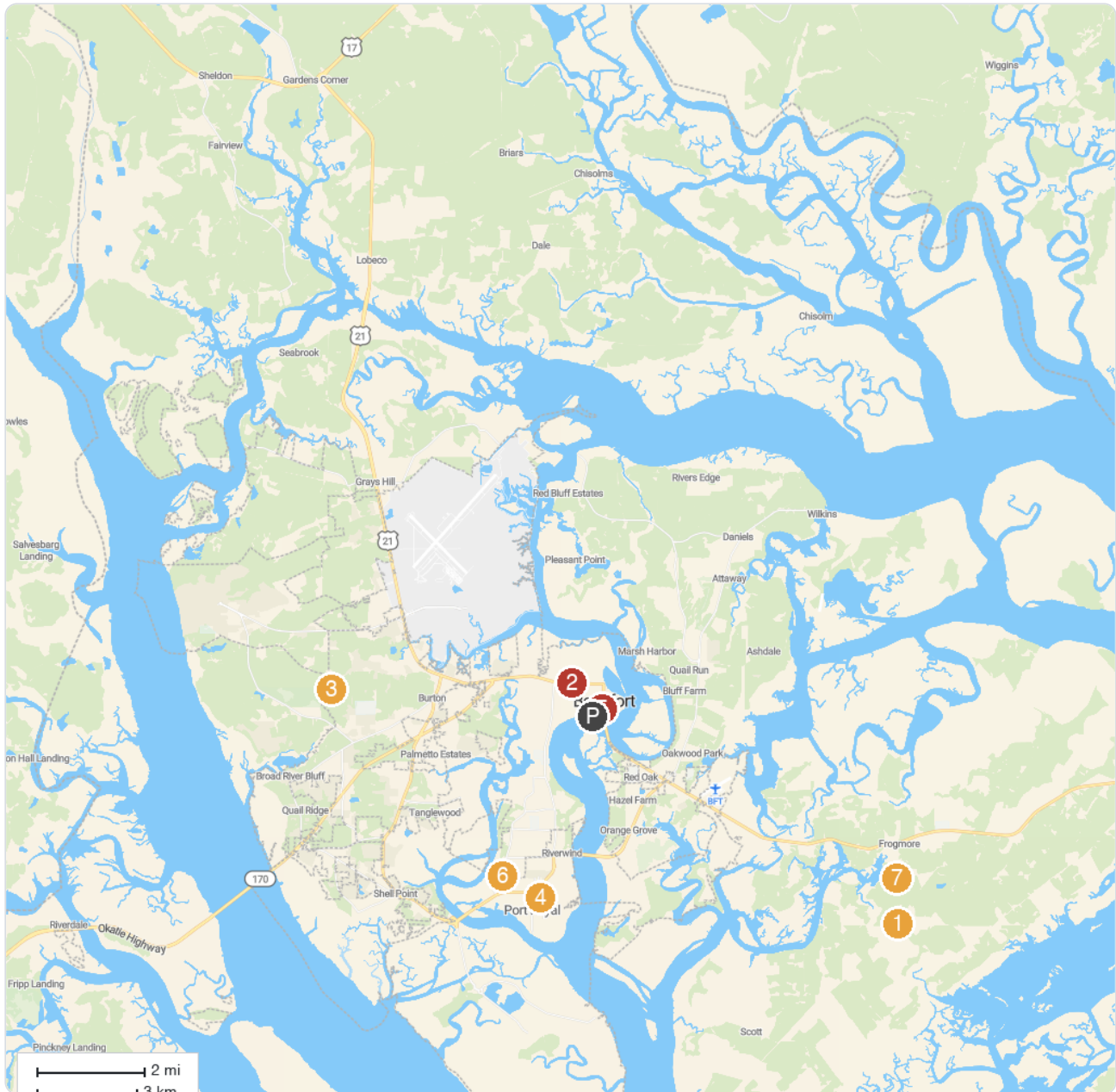
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Best season is Nov–April. Summer in Beaufort is hot and humid; spring and fall calls offer ideal walking weather.
- Bring bug spray in warm months. Lowcountry marshes mean mosquitoes and no-see-ums, especially in wooded areas.
- Gator awareness on trails. Beaufort-area nature walks pass through genuine alligator habitat — stay on marked paths and don't
