Docking: Berthed at Quay 5, Port of Beirut — ~10-min walk to downtown

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Downtown Beirut & Roman Ruins** — Walk from the port to Place de l'Étoile, the restored Ottoman-era parliament square, then explore the Roman baths and...
- **Jeita Grotto & Harissa** — Jeita Grotto is one of the world's great cave systems — two interconnected limestone chambers with a boat ride on an...
- **National Museum of Beirut** — Lebanon's principal archaeology museum traces 6,000 years of civilization — Phoenician sarcophagi, Bronze Age...
- **Byblos (Jbeil) — Ancient Phoenician City** — One of the oldest continuously inhabited cities on earth, Byblos is a UNESCO World Heritage Site 40 km north of Beirut.
- **Beirut Food & Neighborhood Walk** — Lebanese cuisine is justifiably famous.

BEST WALKS

- **Port to Place de l'Étoile & the Souks** 1.5 km • ~25 min • Flat — Leave the cruise terminal and walk west along the waterfront, then turn inland toward Martyrs' Square.
- **Corniche Promenade to Pigeon Rocks** 4 km one way • ~50 min • Flat — From the port take a taxi to the start of the Corniche at Ain El-Mreisseh, then walk the seaside promenade south-west to Raouché and...

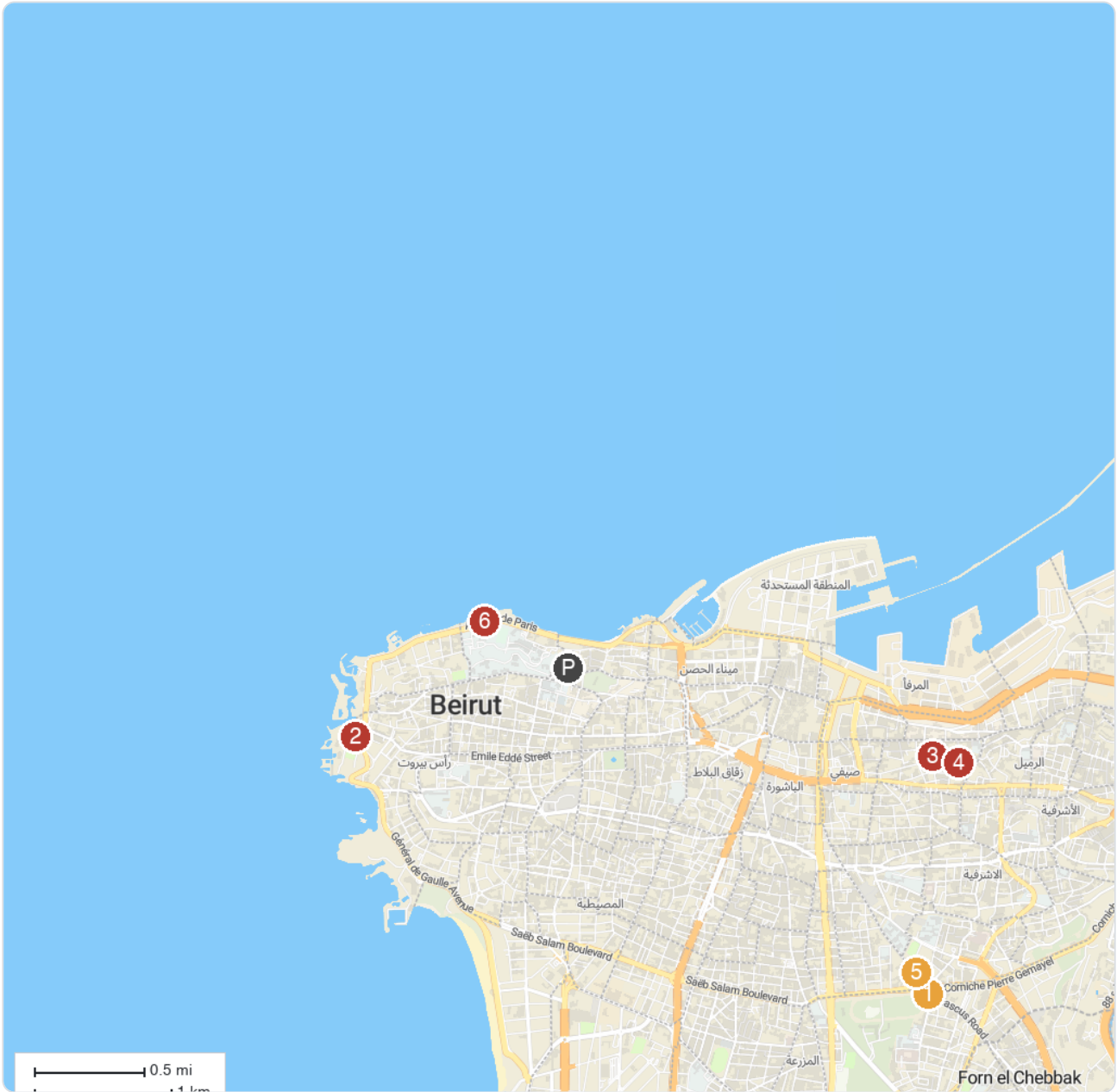
USD widely accepted; carry cash

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry USD cash. Lebanon's economy is cash-heavy. USD is accepted almost everywhere in Beirut. Bring enough for the day — ATMs are unreliable and credit card acceptance is limited...
- Check travel advisories. Beirut's political and security situation can shift. Many cruise lines skip Beirut if tensions are elevated.
