TOP THINGS TO DO

- Titanic Belfast Museum** — Nine interactive galleries trace the Titanic from its construction in the very shipyard outside the window to the ocean...
 - Giant's Causeway** — A UNESCO World Heritage Site of 40,000 interlocking basalt columns formed by ancient volcanic activity.
 - Causeway Coastal Route & Highlights** — The A2 coastal road between Belfast and the Causeway is one of Europe's
- great drives.

 - Belfast City Walk: Cathedral Quarter & Murals** — The Cathedral Quarter is Belfast's creative heart — Victorian pubs, street art, and St Anne's Cathedral.
 - Ulster Museum** — Free national museum in the Botanic Gardens with Irish art, natural history, and a mummy from ancient Egypt.

BEST WALKS

- City Center to Titanic Quarter** 3.5 km · 45 min · Easy · Flat — Follow the River Lagan north from the Albert Clock past the Waterfront Hall to the Titanic Quarter.
- Cathedral Quarter & City Hall Loop** 2.5 km · 30 min · Easy · Flat — A short loop from the city center taking in St Anne's Cathedral, the cobbled Hill Street, the Crown Liquor Saloon (a Victorian gin...

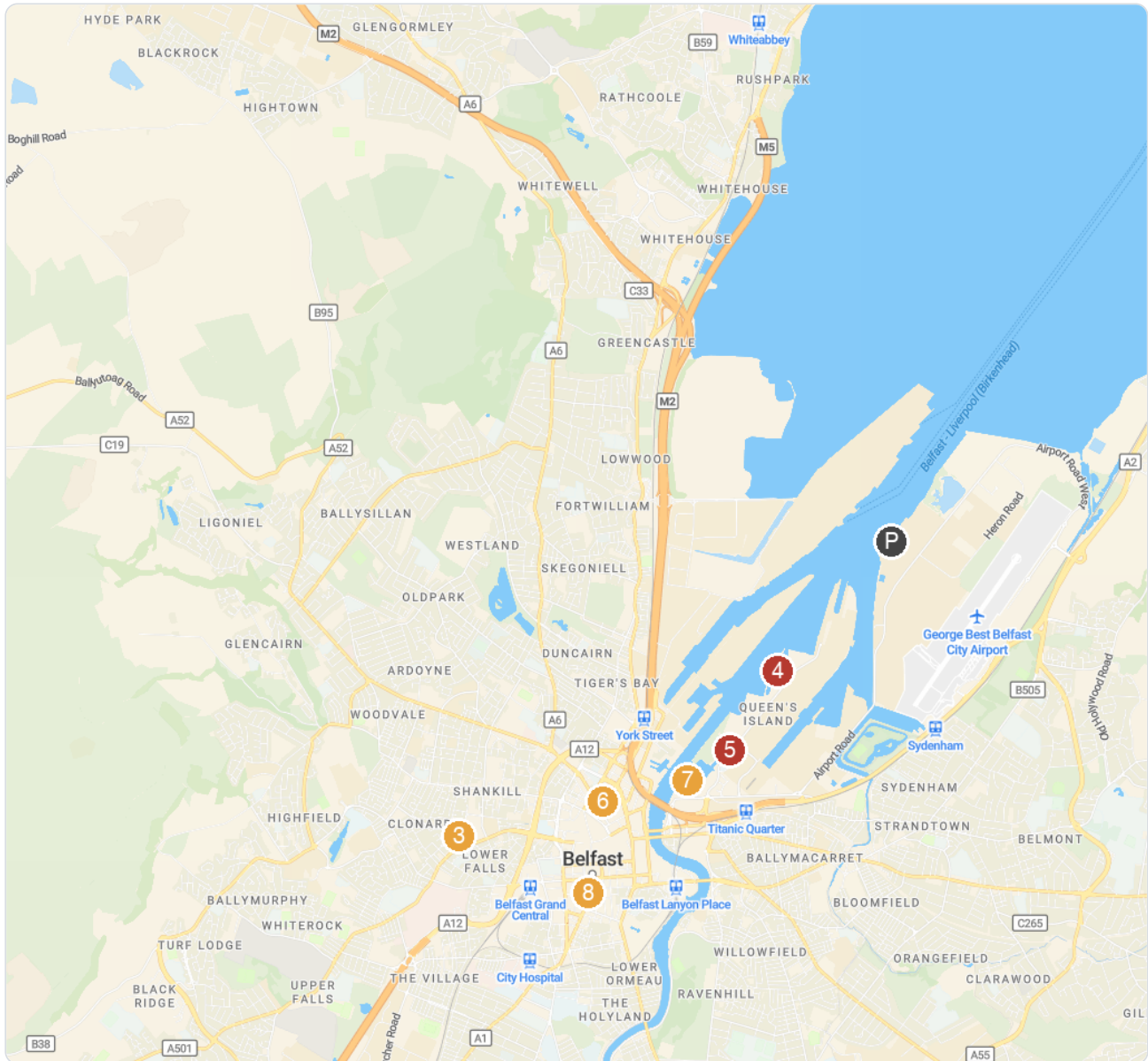
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
