- **Kalemegdan Fortress & Old Belgrade Walk** — Belgrade Fortress sits on a cliff at the confluence of the Sava and Danube — 2,000 years of layered history in one...
- **City Highlights & Nikola Tesla Museum** — A guided loop taking in Republic Square, Knez Mihailova Street, the Church of Saint Sava (one of the world's largest...
- **Novi Sad & Petrovaradin Fortress Day Trip** — Ninety kilometres north, Novi Sad's baroque old town and the dramatic Petrovaradin Fortress — nicknamed 'Gibraltar on...
- **Iron Gate Gorge & Golubac Fortress** — Drive east along the Danube to the dramatic Iron Gate canyon.
- **Skadarlija Bohemian Quarter & Serbian Food** — Belgrade's cobblestoned Skadarlija district is lined with traditional kafanas (taverns) serving ćevapi, burek, and...

BEST WALKS

- **Sava Quay to Kalemegdan Fortress** 2.5 km · 30-35 min · Moderate (uphill) — From the pier, walk north along the Sava embankment past Beton Hala's cafes, then climb Karadjordjeva Street to the old city.
- **Knez Mihailova Street to Skadarlija** 1.8 km · 20-25 min · Easy — Stroll Belgrade's main pedestrian boulevard from Republic Square past boutiques, galleries, and street musicians, then duck east into...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry dinars for local spots. Most tourist restaurants accept cards, but kafanas and market stalls prefer cash. ATMs are plentiful on Knez Mihailova Street.
- Wear sturdy walking shoes. Belgrade is built on hills — the walk from the Sava pier to the fortress involves a genuine climb on cobblestones.
