

Belize City, Belize District, Belize

Belize City is a tender-only port — no cruise ship has ever docked at a pier here. That 15-minute boat ride unlocks the planet's second-largest barrier reef, towering Mayan temples, and cave tubing through the ancient Maya underworld.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor offshore, high-speed tenders run ~15-20 min to Fort Street Tourism Village pier

Walk to center: Fort Street pier to Swing Bridge ~0.6 mi / 15 min; to Baron Bliss Lighthouse ~0.5 mi / 10 min

Best For: Cave tubing, Mayan ruins (Altun Ha, Lamanai), barrier reef snorkeling, zip-lining

Don't Miss: Cave tubing at Nohoch Che'en Caves Branch or Lamanai ruins by river boat — book before you sail

 Getting around:  Taxi  \$10–15 USD ·  Rideshare  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Cave Tubing at Nohoch Che'en Caves Branch** — Float on inner tubes through ancient Mayan ceremonial caves lit only by headlamps, stalactites hanging overhead.
- Lamanai Mayan Ruins by River Boat** — Drive an hour to Tower Hill, then ride 26 miles up the New River — crocodiles sunning on the banks, howler monkeys...
- Altun Ha Mayan Ruins** — Belize's most visited Mayan site is about an hour's drive from the pier.
- Barrier Reef Snorkeling — Hol Chan & Shark Ray Alley** — Snorkel the protected Hol Chan Marine Reserve cut in the UNESCO World Heritage barrier reef, then drift over Shark Ray...
- Goff's Caye Beach & Snorkel** — A tiny uninhabited sand island sitting right on the barrier reef — postcard-perfect, uncrowded, and reachable in under...

BEST WALKS

- Fort Street to Baron Bliss Lighthouse** 0.5 mi · Flat · ~15 min one-way — A flat waterfront walk from the Tourism Village pier south along the harbor esplanade to the Baron Bliss Memorial Lighthouse and...
- Swing Bridge & Downtown Stroll** ~0.75 mi loop · Easy · 45-60 min — Walk north from the pier into the historic downtown.

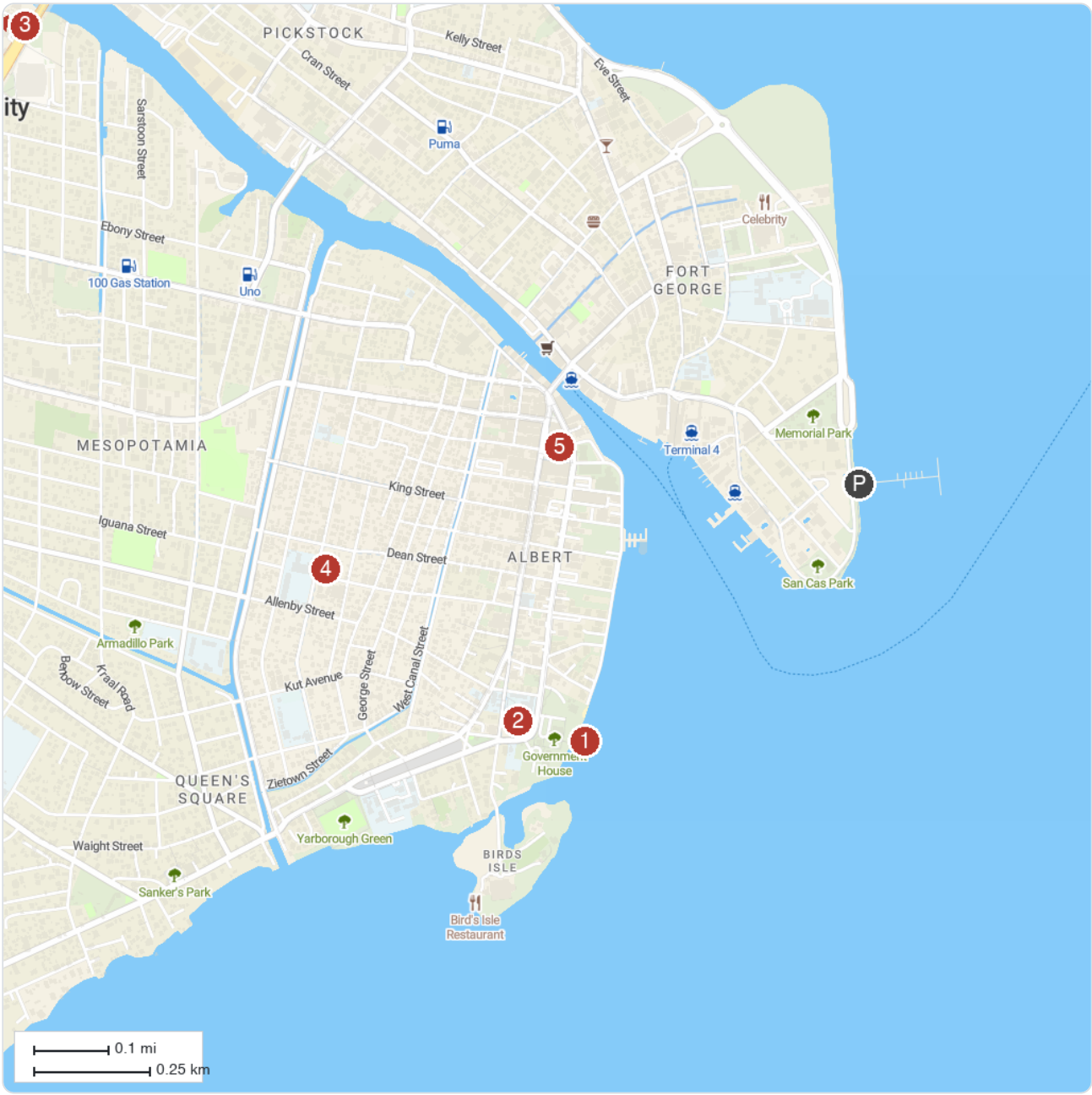
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
