GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Nile riverbank mooring; ships tie up near the city corniche

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Meidum Pyramid** — Dating to the reign of Pharaoh Sneferu (~2600 BC), the Meidum Pyramid is Egypt's earliest attempt at a true pyramid — a...
- **Heracleopolis Magna (Ihnasya el-Medina)** — Once the capital of Egypt during the First Intermediate Period, Heracleopolis Magna lies ~15 km west of Beni Suef.
- **Beni Suef Museum** — A compact but well-curated regional museum covering Pharaonic, Greco-Roman, Coptic, and Islamic artefacts from the...
- **Wadi Sannur Cave** — A rarely visited limestone cave system (karst) in the Eastern Desert, about 70 km southeast of Beni Suef, known for its...
- **Coptic Monasteries of Middle Egypt** — The region around Beni Suef is rich in early Christian heritage.

BEST WALKS

- **Kornish el-Nile Stroll** 1–2 km • Flat • 20–30 min — A pleasant walk along the Nile Corniche, Beni Suef's riverside promenade.
- **City Centre & Market Walk** 1.5 km • Flat • 30–40 min — From the corniche, walk inland toward the city centre and Al-Gawhara Market.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry Egyptian Pounds (EGP). ATMs exist in the city centre but USD/EUR are not widely accepted outside hotels. Withdraw cash before heading to outlying sites.
- Negotiate taxis in advance. Fix a round-trip fare before you get in — agree on the price and waiting time at the site. Shared minibuses also run but routes are complex.
