TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Guadalest & Algar Waterfalls** — The hilltop village of El Castell de Guadalest — perched on a rocky outcrop with a medieval castle — is Benidorm's most...
- **Benidorm Old Town & Balcón del Mediterráneo** — The Casco Antiguo sits on a rocky promontory dividing Levante and Poniente beaches.
- **Aqualandia or Aqua Natura Water Park** — Benidorm hosts two big water parks: Aqualandia in Rincón de Loix (beside the Mundomar marine park), with towering...
- **Sierra Helada Natural Park Hike** — The limestone ridge behind Benidorm's Rincon de Loix district is a protected natural park.
- **Benidorm Island Boat Trip** — Illa de Benidorm sits just 3 km offshore and is a marine reserve with clear water for snorkelling.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Balcón del Mediterráneo** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — From the port quay, head uphill into the Casco Antiguo.
- **Levante Promenade Beach Walk** 3 km return · 45 min · Flat — Stroll north along the full length of Playa de Levante — one of Spain's longest urban beaches — past beach bars, sunbeds, and the...

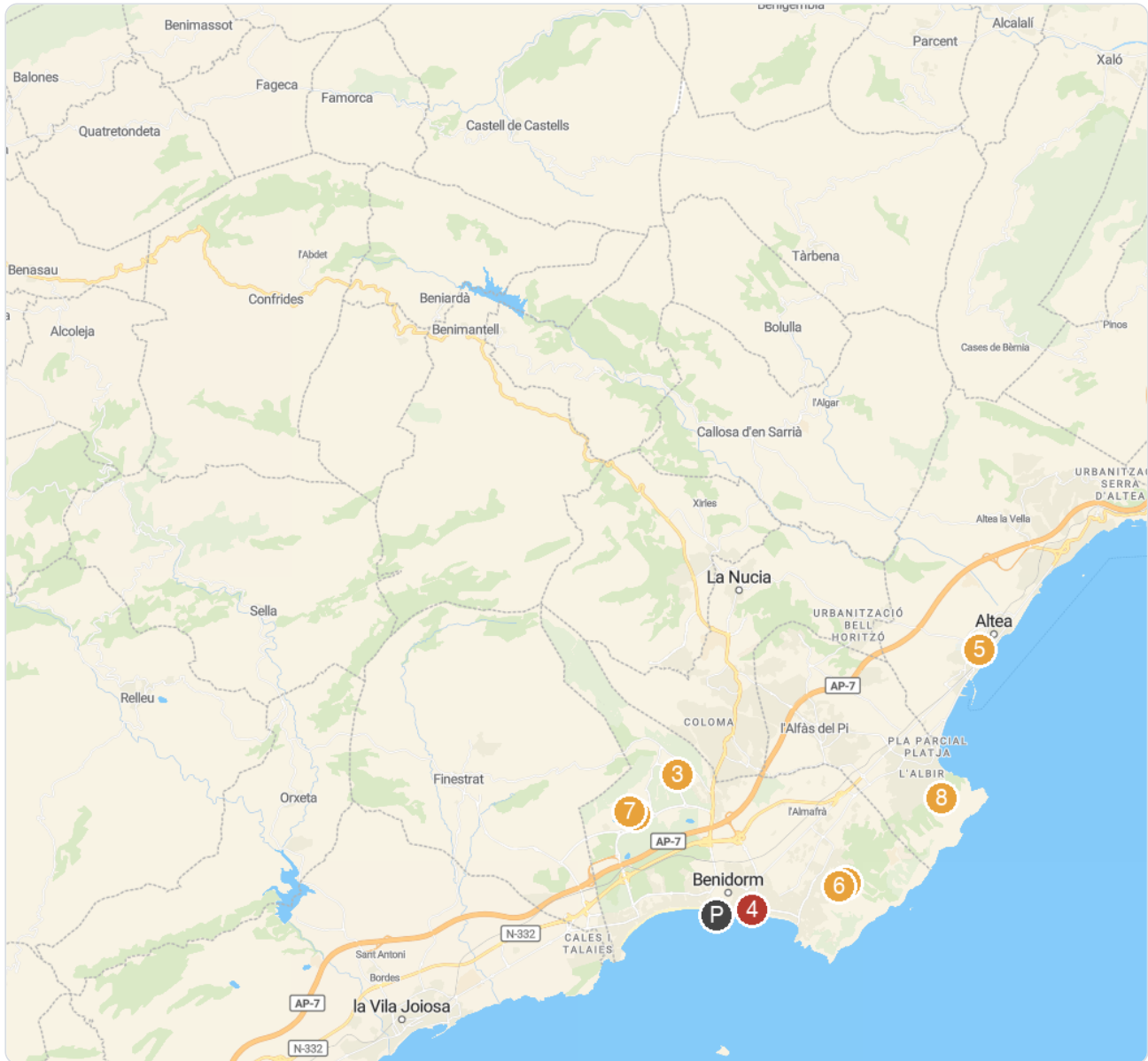
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender early. On busy calls the tender queue can add 45 minutes each way — collect your ticket before breakfast if you have a tour.
- Summer heat is real. July–August temperatures hit 35 °C. Carry water, wear sunscreen, and pace yourself if walking.
- Cash and cards both work. ATMs are plentiful in the Old Town and on the Levante promenade. Most restaurants accept cards.
