

Bergen, Vestland, Norway

Norway's second city sits wrapped in seven mountains and a harbor that's been busy since the Vikings. Bryggen's painted wooden facades are a UNESCO icon, the fjords begin just outside town, and you can ride a funicular to the clouds before lunch.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Central piers (Skolten, Festningskaien, Bontelabo) — 5-10 min walk to Bryggen. Large ships may dock at Dokken/Jekteviken, 2.5 km from center.

Best For: Fjord day trips, UNESCO heritage, hiking, seafood

Walk to center: 5 min from Skolten/Festningskaien; free shuttle from Dokken terminal

Don't Miss: Fløibanen funicular ride + Flåm Railway day excursion

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Flåm Railway & Nærøfjord Cruise** — The classic full-day 'Norway in a Nutshell' circuit: coach to Voss or Myrdal, then the scenic Flåmsbana railway...
- **Fløibanen Funicular & Mount Fløyen** — A six-minute funicular ride from the city center delivers panoramic views of Bergen, its seven mountains, and the harbor.
- **Bryggen Wharf & Hanseatic Museum** — Wander the narrow alleys of Bergen's UNESCO-listed medieval wharf, then step into the Hanseatic Museum to understand...
- **Hardangerfjord Day Trip** — Coach east to the Hardangerfjord — Norway's 'Queen of Fjords' — famed for fruit orchards in bloom, and the...
- **Bergen Fish Market (Fisketorget)** — The covered Fish Market on the wharf is Bergen's most atmospheric food stop — fresh shrimp, smoked salmon, fish soup...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor & Bryggen Loop** 2 km · 45-60 min · Flat, easy — Start at the Fish Market, walk north along the quay to Bryggen Wharf, duck into the alleyways behind the facade, visit Bergenhus...
- **Fløibanen to Fløyen Summit Walk** 0.5 km walk up + 6-min funicular · 1.5-2 hrs return · Easy-moderate — Walk from the harbor to the Fløibanen station at the base of the hill, ride the funicular to the Fløyen summit, enjoy the panoramic...

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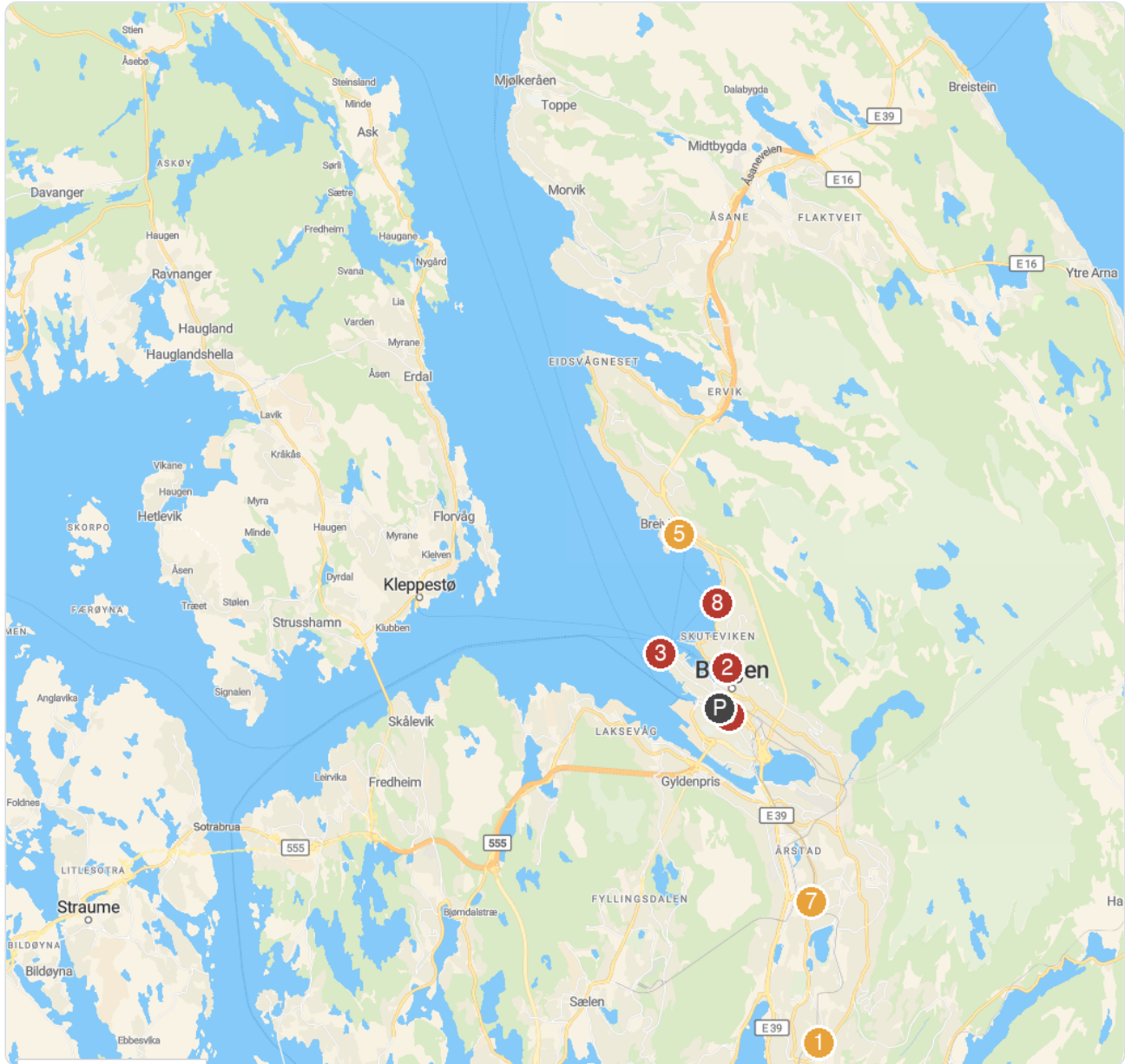
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
