

Berlevåg, Finnmark, Norway

One of Norway's most remote coastal stops, Berlevåg earns its reputation through sheer Barents Sea drama — colossal tetrapod breakwaters, a harbour museum that tells the story of fighting the sea, and Arctic wilderness that begins right at the pier.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Berlevåg Harbour Museum** — Housed in a restored waterfront warehouse, this museum chronicles Berlevåg's epic battle with the Barents Sea...
- **Tetrapod Breakwater Walk** — Stroll the breakwaters protecting the harbour and marvel at the 11,000+ four-legged concrete tetrapods that keep the...
- **Sandfjorden Beach & Dunes** — A short drive west leads to Sandfjorden, a surprisingly wide white-sand Arctic beach backed by dunes.
- **Tanahorn Peak Hike** — A moderate 3.5 km hike starting 8 km west of Berlevåg leads to the Tanahorn summit with sweeping panoramas over the...
- **Kjølnes Lighthouse** — Built in 1916 and rebuilt after WWII, Kjølnes Fyr stands on the headland approach to Berlevåg with classic coastal views.

BEST WALKS

- **Village Harbour Loop** 1 km · 20 min · flat — From the pier, walk past the tetrapod breakwaters to the Harbour Museum, then loop back through the village past the rebuilt Berlevåg...
- **Kjølnes Lighthouse Drive & Walk** ~5 km by road · 45 min · easy coastal walk — Drive or take a taxi east along the coast to Kjølnes lighthouse.
