

# Warnemünde (for Berlin), Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Germany

Your cruise calls it Berlin, but your ship ties up in the Baltic resort of Warnemünde — 150 miles and 2.5 hours from the German capital. Commit to the full-day dash for the Wall, the Gate, and Museum Island, or keep it local with Rostock's Hanseatic squares and a sandy beach right off the pier.

**Distance to Berlin:** ~150 miles (240 km); 2.5–3 hrs each way by train or coach

**Don't Miss:** Brandenburg Gate and the Holocaust Memorial if you make it to Berlin; Alter Strom canal if you stay local

- **Berlin Cold War & WWII Highlights** — Brandenburg Gate, Checkpoint Charlie, Berlin Wall Memorial, Holocaust Memorial, and the Reichstag — a full-day...
- **Museum Island & Unter den Linden** — Berlin's UNESCO-listed Museum Island clusters five world-class museums on a Spree island.
- **Sachsenhausen Memorial Tour** — The former Nazi concentration camp north of Berlin, now a sobering memorial and museum.
- **Rostock Hanseatic City Walk** — Skip the Berlin rush and explore Rostock's beautifully restored old town: New Market Square with the pink baroque Town...
- **Schwerin Palace Day Trip** — The 'fairy-tale castle' set on an island in Schwerin Lake is one of Germany's most photogenic palaces.

## BEST WALKS

- **Warnemünde Waterfront Loop** 1.5 km · 30 min · Flat · Walk from pier — From the cruise terminal, head along the Alter Strom canal to the fishing harbour, then cross to the beach promenade and walk to the...
- **Rostock Old Town Walk** 2 km · 45 min · Easy · 15 min by S-Bahn from Warnemünde — From Rostock Hauptbahnhof, walk through the Steintor gateway into the old town, past the Kröpeliner Straße pedestrian zone to New...

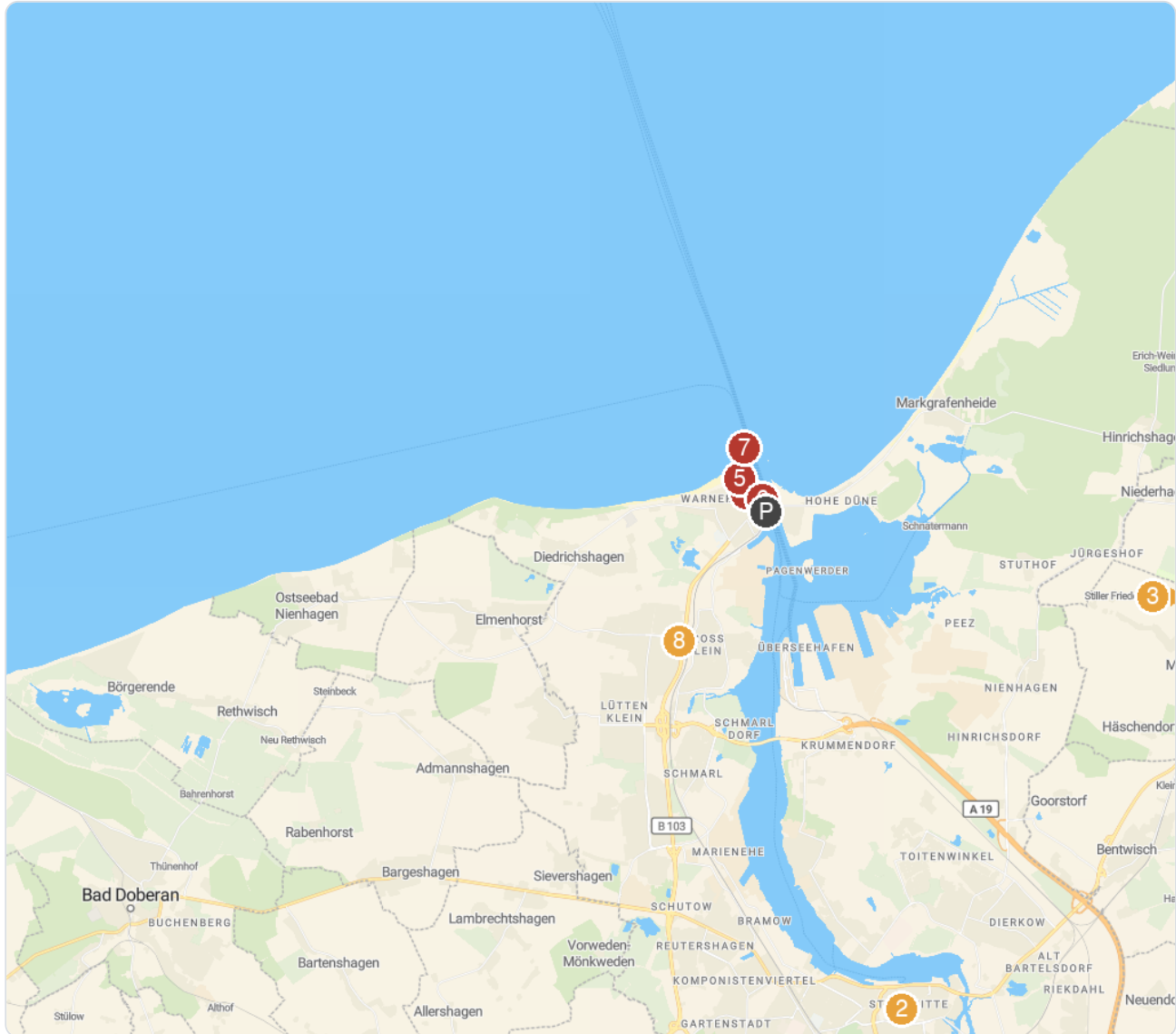
