

Bezdan, Vojvodina, Serbia

Where the Danube crosses into Serbia, Bezdan sits quietly on the left bank — a canal-laced village with a silk weaving tradition centuries old and wild wetlands stretching to the horizon. There's no cruise terminal here, just river, reeds, and real village life.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Public river dock on the Danube bank; no dedicated cruise terminal

Walk to center: 5 min from dock to village center

Getting around: **Taxi** 1,300–1,600 RSD (~€11–14)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Novitet-Dunav Silk Damask Workshop** — Visit Bezdan's most famous attraction — a working silk damask weaving workshop using 18 hand-powered wooden looms with...
- Gornje Podunavlje UNESCO Biosphere Boat Ride** — The Bačko Podunavlje biosphere reserve — nicknamed the 'European Amazon' — begins at Bezdan's doorstep.
- Chapel of Holy Trinity & Danube Locks** — See one of Vojvodina's oldest preserved monuments — the Chapel of Holy Trinity, built by local people between 1710 and...
- Bezdan Spa & Mineral Pools** — Bezdan's thermal spa offers sodium-bicarbonate mineral water at around 32°C.
- Sombor City Tour** — The regional capital (~18 km away) is sometimes called 'Little Vienna' for its tree-lined boulevards and elegant...

BEST WALKS

- Village Canal Walk** ~2 km · 30–40 min · Flat · Easy — From the river dock, walk into the village center along the main street to reach the Chapel of Holy Trinity.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

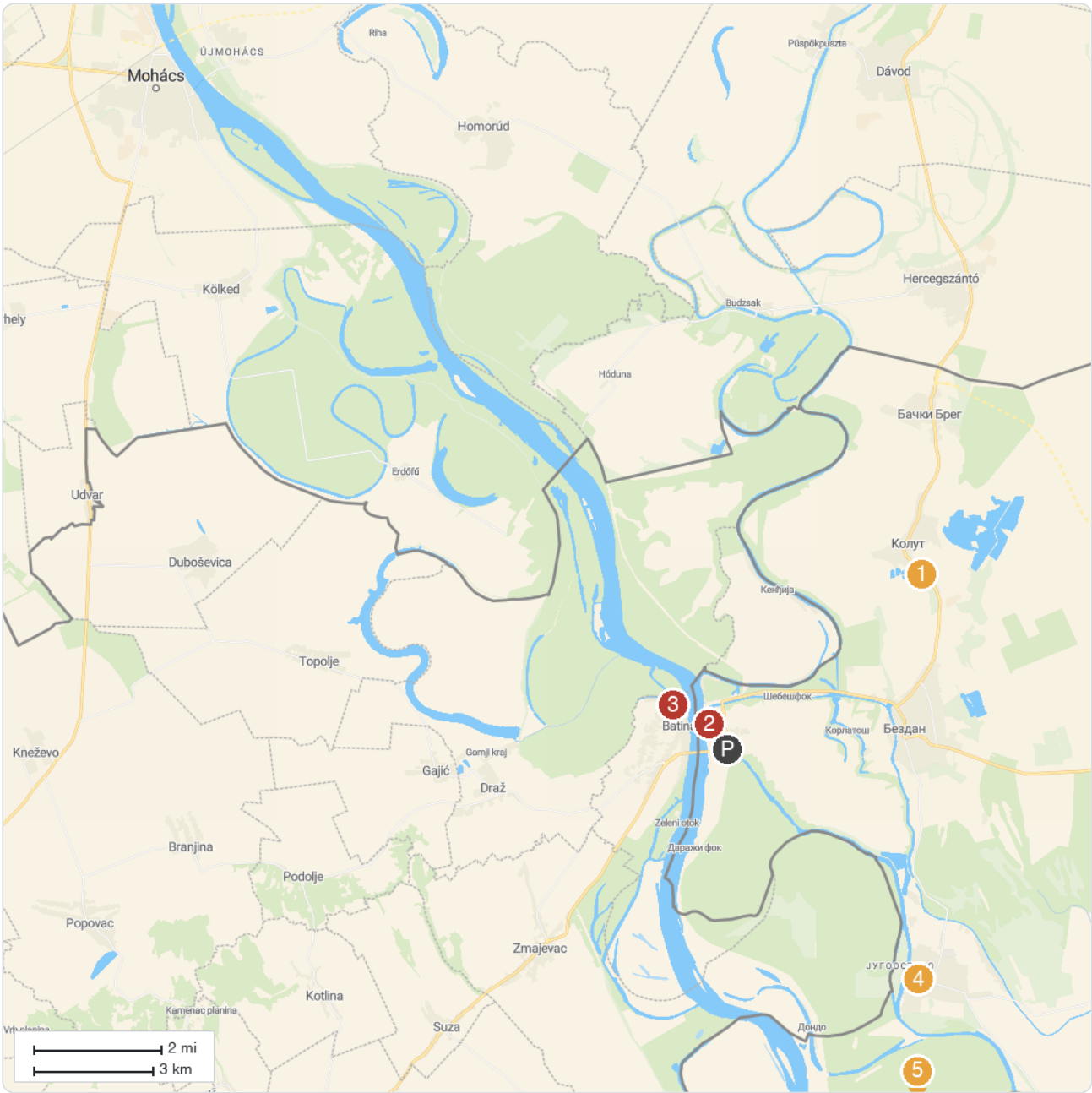
- Cash is king. Bezdan has very limited card acceptance. Bring Serbian dinars or euros — there is one small ATM in the village; it may not always be stocked.
- Bring insect repellent. The Danube floodplain wetlands mean mosquitoes, especially in summer evenings. Any nature excursion calls for repellent and light long sleeves.

Modest dress for the chapel. The Chapel of Holy Trinity is an active place of worship — cover shoulders and knees before
