Docking: Tender — ships anchor offshore; boats drop at the Seebrücke pier

Best For: Beach walks, chalk cliff excursions, historic steam railway

Walk to center: Immediate — tender lands at the pier head, town is right there

Don't Miss: Königsstuhl chalk cliffs at Jasmund National Park

Getting around: **Taxi** €4 base + meter

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Königsstuhl Chalk Cliffs & Jasmund National Park** — The 118-metre chalk headland is Germany's most iconic coastal scenery.
- **Prora — Nazi Megastructure on the Beach** — The 4.5-kilometre seafront complex built by the Third Reich as a 'Strength through Joy' resort was never used for its...
- **Rasender Roland Steam Railway** — Board the narrow-gauge steam train that has puffed across Rügen since 1895.
- **Jagdschloss Granitz Hunting Lodge** — A romantic 19th-century neo-Gothic castle set in forest above Binz, built for Prince Wilhelm Malte I.
- **Hiddensee Island Day Trip** — The car-free island west of Rügen rewards visitors with wild heathland, the white Dornbusch lighthouse, and utter quiet.

BEST WALKS

- **Strandpromenade Beach Walk** 2 km · 30 min · Easy · Flat seafront — Walk the full length of Binz's beachfront promenade from the Seebrücke pier northward past ornate spa villas, beach bars, and the wide...
- **Forest Path to Jagdschloss Granitz** 4 km one-way · 1 hr · Moderate · Forest trail — From the Binz Kleinbahnhof (narrow-gauge railway station), a marked trail leads through the Granitz forest to the hilltop hunting lodge.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

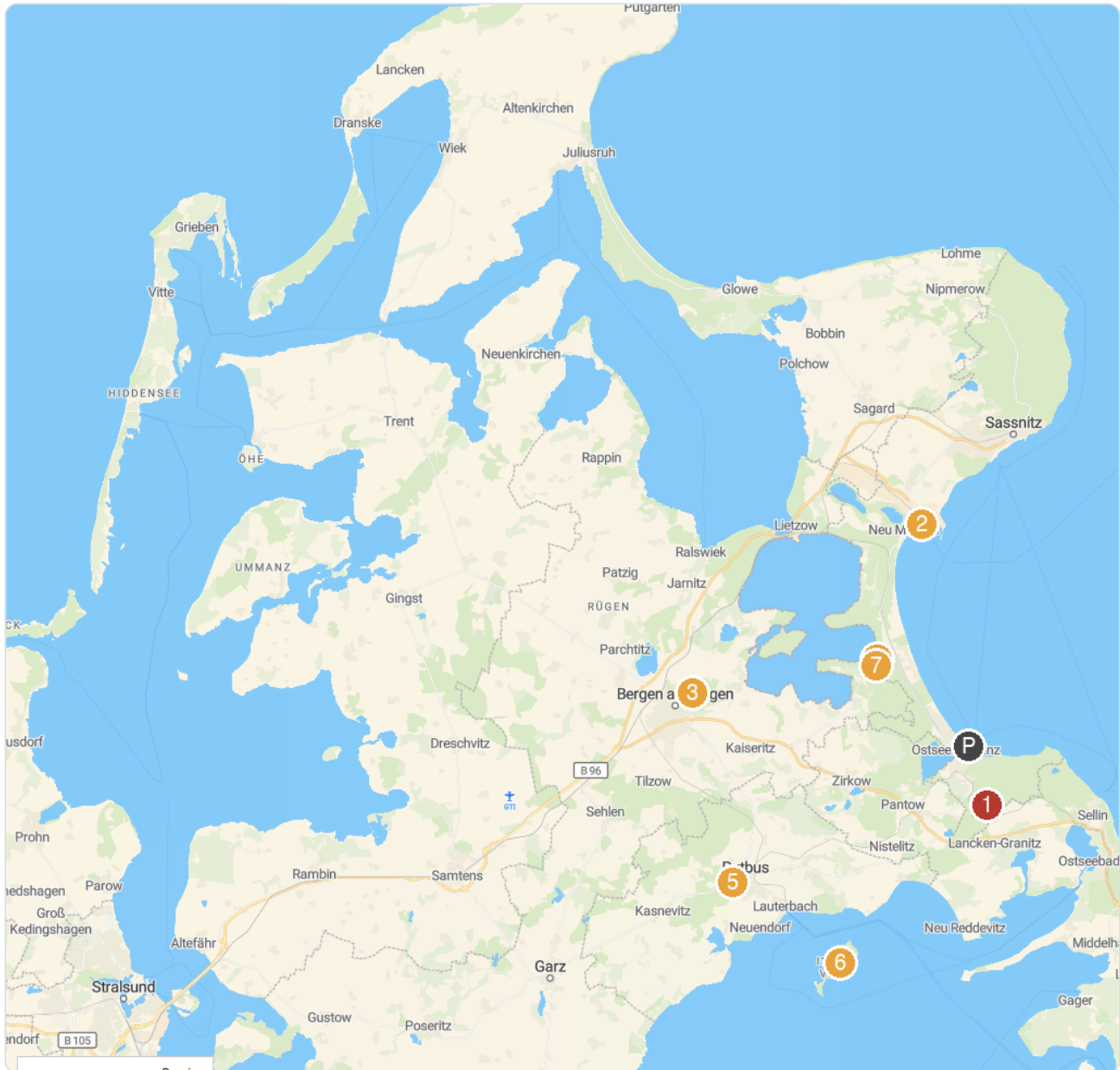
