GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock at Tagbilaran City Tourist Pier (265 m berth); no tendering required for most calls

Best For: Nature lovers, wildlife spotters, river cruisers, beach days

Walk to center: Tagbilaran downtown is ~10 min walk from the pier; most attractions need a van or tour

Don't Miss: Chocolate Hills viewpoint at Carmen and the Philippine Tarsier Sanctuary in Corella

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Chocolate Hills & Carmen Viewpoint** — More than 1,200 nearly identical conical mounds stretch across central Bohol.
- **Philippine Tarsier Sanctuary** — The Corella sanctuary protects one of the world's smallest primates in a semi-wild forest enclosure.
- **Loboc River Floating Buffet Cruise** — Bamboo raft-restaurants drift along the jungle-fringed Loboc River while a local band plays and you eat a Filipino...
- **Panglao Island Beach Day** — Alona Beach on Panglao Island offers powdery white sand, turquoise shallows, and beachfront cafés.
- **Baclayon Church & Museum** — One of the oldest coral-stone churches in the Philippines; the present church was completed in 1727, on a Jesuit...

BEST WALKS

- **Tagbilaran City Pier to Baclayon Church Walk** 4 km · ~1 hr · Flat — Head east along the coastal road from the pier past Carlos P.
- **Bilar Man-Made Forest Trail** 1 km · Easy · Shaded — A dense corridor of mahogany trees planted decades ago lines the road through Bilar.

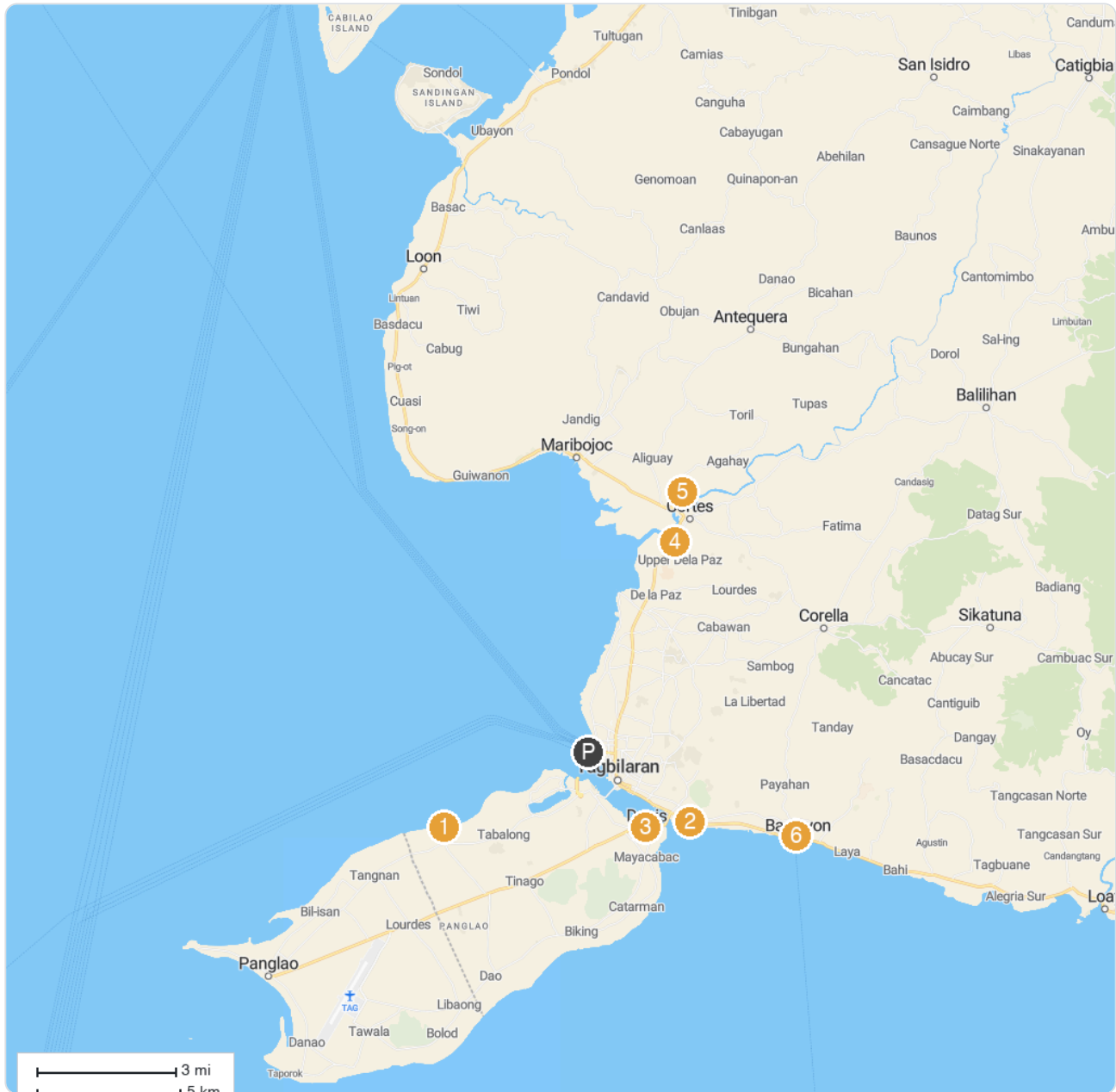
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Manage your return time carefully. Chocolate Hills + tarsiers + Loboc River is a tight full day. Pick two if time is short, or start at the pier the moment gangway opens.
- Carry Philippine Pesos. ATMs are in Tagbilaran city centre but queues can be long. Remote attractions and small vendors are cash
