

Bolgar, Tatarstan, Russia

One of the oldest cities of medieval Russia, Bolgar sat at the crossroads of Eurasian civilisations. Today its vast archaeological park — a UNESCO World Heritage site — draws both history travellers and Muslim pilgrims to the place where the Volga Bulgars embraced Islam in 922 CE.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Bolgar Historical & Archaeological Complex** — Walk the atmospheric ruins of medieval Volga Bulgaria: the Cathedral Mosque, Great Minaret, Khan's Palace remains...
- **White Mosque (Ak Mosque)** — Opened in 2012, this gleaming modern mosque — three domes, two minarets, granite-lined reflecting pool — is nicknamed...
- **Museum of Bulgarian Civilization & Koran Museum** — The riverside Museum of Bulgarian Civilization covers 1,600 exhibits tracing Bolgar's medieval golden age.
- **Museum of Bread** — A charming open-air complex on the edge of the park with a reconstructed windmill, watermill, blacksmith's shop, and...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Ruins Loop** 3–4 km · 1.5–2.5 hrs · mostly flat grassy park — From the pier, pass through the Western Gate into the UNESCO complex.

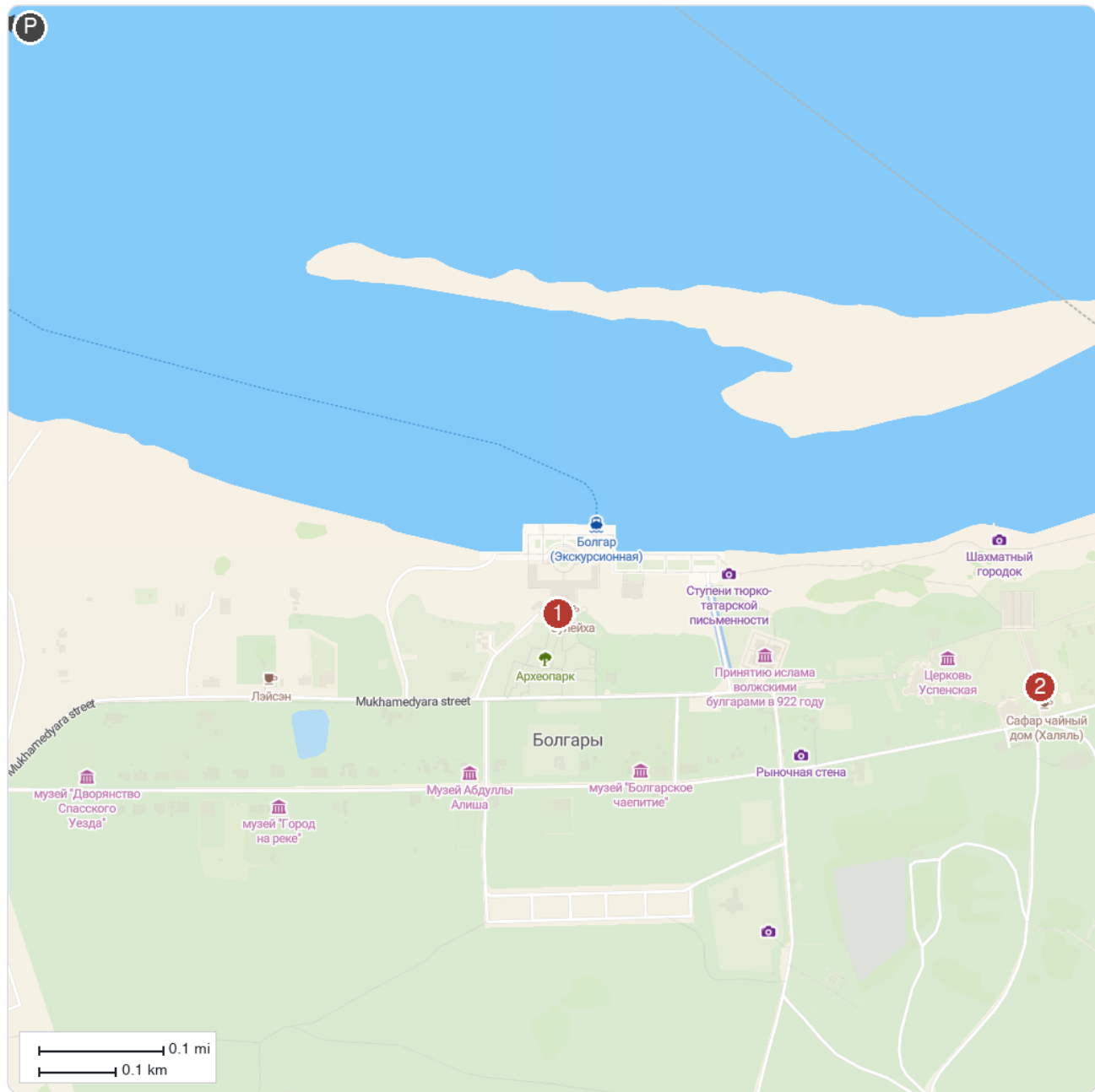
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear comfortable shoes. The archaeological complex is large and entirely outdoors on uneven ground — you'll easily walk 3–4 km between monuments.
- Dress modestly for mosques. Women should carry a headscarf; bare shoulders and shorts are not appropriate inside the Cathedral Mosque or White Mosque.
- Bring rubles in cash. Card acceptance at small kiosks and museum entrances is inconsistent; smaller notes are useful for museum tickets and snacks.
