GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor offshore; tenders to Caticlan Jetty, then bangka boat to Cagban Port on Boracay (30–40 min total)

Best For: Beach days, island hopping, water sports, sunset sailing

Walk to Beach: 10–15 min e-trike ride from Cagban Port to White Beach Station 2/D'Mall

Don't Miss: Sunset paraw sail along White Beach, island hopping to Crystal Cove

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **White Beach Day** — Walk or e-trike along the 4-km White Beach from Station 3's quiet south end to the luxurious Station 1.
- **Island Hopping Tour** — A classic Boracay boat tour typically visits Crystal Cove Island (sea caves, snorkelling, cliff views), Puka Beach on...
- **Sunset Paraw Sailing** — A paraw is the traditional Filipino double-outrigger sailboat.
- **Helmet Diving** — No scuba certification needed — helmet diving lets you walk on the seabed at 4–5 metres depth while breathing normally...
- **Puka Beach & North Island** — Puka Beach (Yapak Beach) on Boracay's northern tip is wilder and less developed than White Beach.

BEST WALKS

- **White Beach End-to-End** 4 km one-way · Easy · 45–60 min — Start at the southern end of White Beach (Station 3, quiet and budget) — a short e-trike from Cagban Port — and walk north along the...
- **D'Mall to Willy's Rock** 1 km · Easy · 15 min — Short beach stroll from the main shopping hub at D'Mall north to Willy's Rock, a coral-encrusted outcrop topped with a small Our Lady...

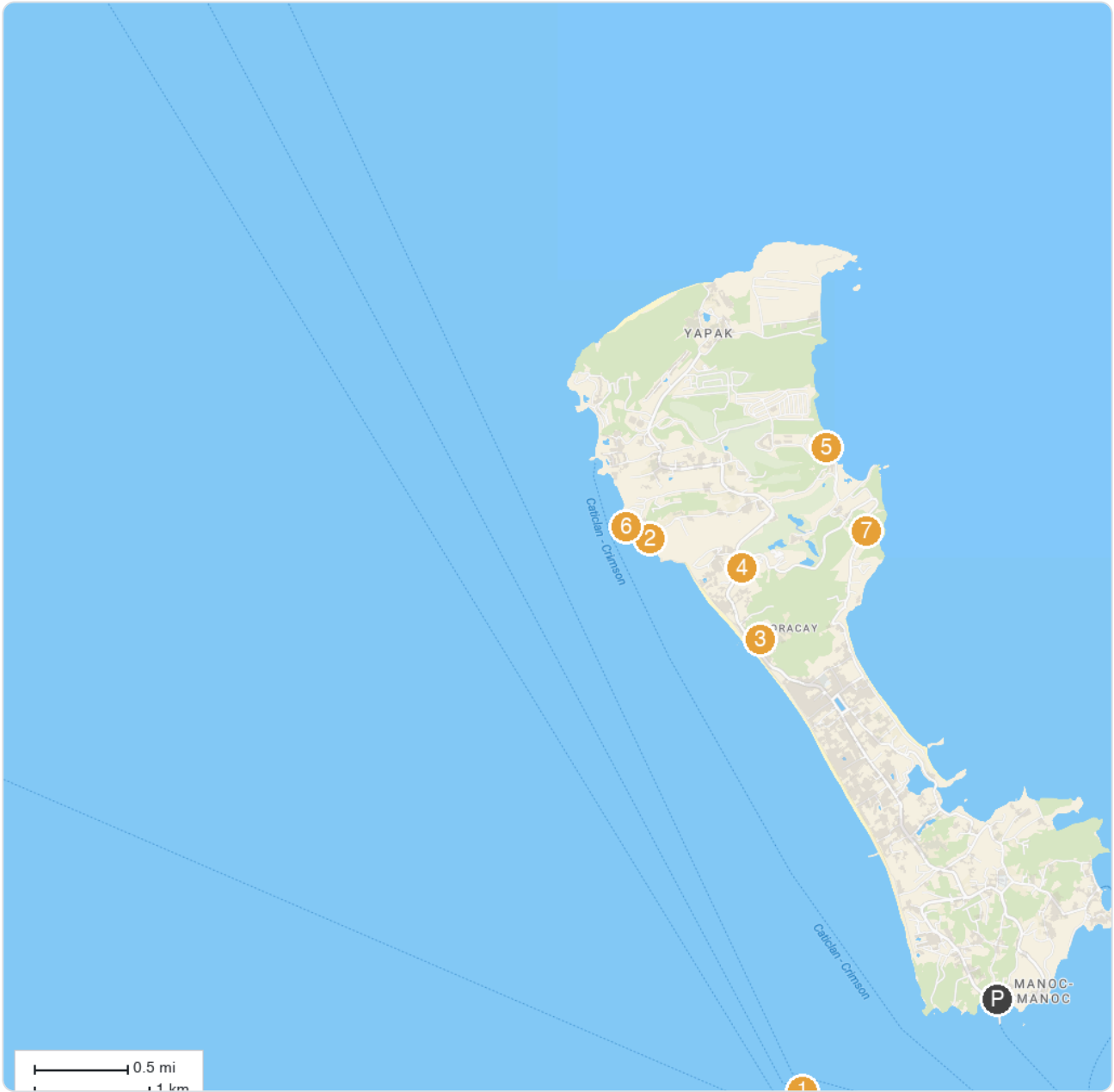
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
