GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships berth at Quai des Chartrons or Bassens; the old city is a short walk or free shuttle from the quay

Best For: Wine lovers, architecture fans, and foodies — Bordeaux's UNESCO old town rivals any European city center

Walk to center: 5-15 min on foot from Quai des Chartrons to Place de la Bourse and the Miroir d'Eau

Don't Miss: Miroir d'Eau (world's largest reflecting pool), Cité du Vin wine museum, and a glass of Bordeaux at a riverside café

- **UNESCO Old City Walking Tour** — Bordeaux's entire historic centre is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- **Cité du Vin — World-Class Wine Museum** — The Cité du Vin is a stunning building by XTU Architects — its swirling, golden form evokes wine in motion and the...
- **Saint-Émilion Wine Village Day Trip** — Just 40 km east, Saint-Émilion is a medieval village carved into limestone cliffs, surrounded by some of the world's...
- **Garonne Riverfront Cycle Ride** — Rent a bike (multiple hire spots near Quai des Chartrons) and cruise the flat, car-free promenade along both banks of...
- **Médoc Wine Route Drive** — Head north through the famous Médoc wine route — home to Château Margaux, Château Latour, and Pauillac's legendary...

BEST WALKS

- **Quai des Chartrons to Miroir d'Eau** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat — Walk south from the ship along the Garonne promenade.
- **Old City Loop — Cathedrals, Markets & Grand Théâtre** 3.5 km · 1 hr · Flat cobblestones — From the Miroir d'Eau, head inland through the Rue Sainte-Catherine pedestrian shopping street (one of Europe's longest), to the...

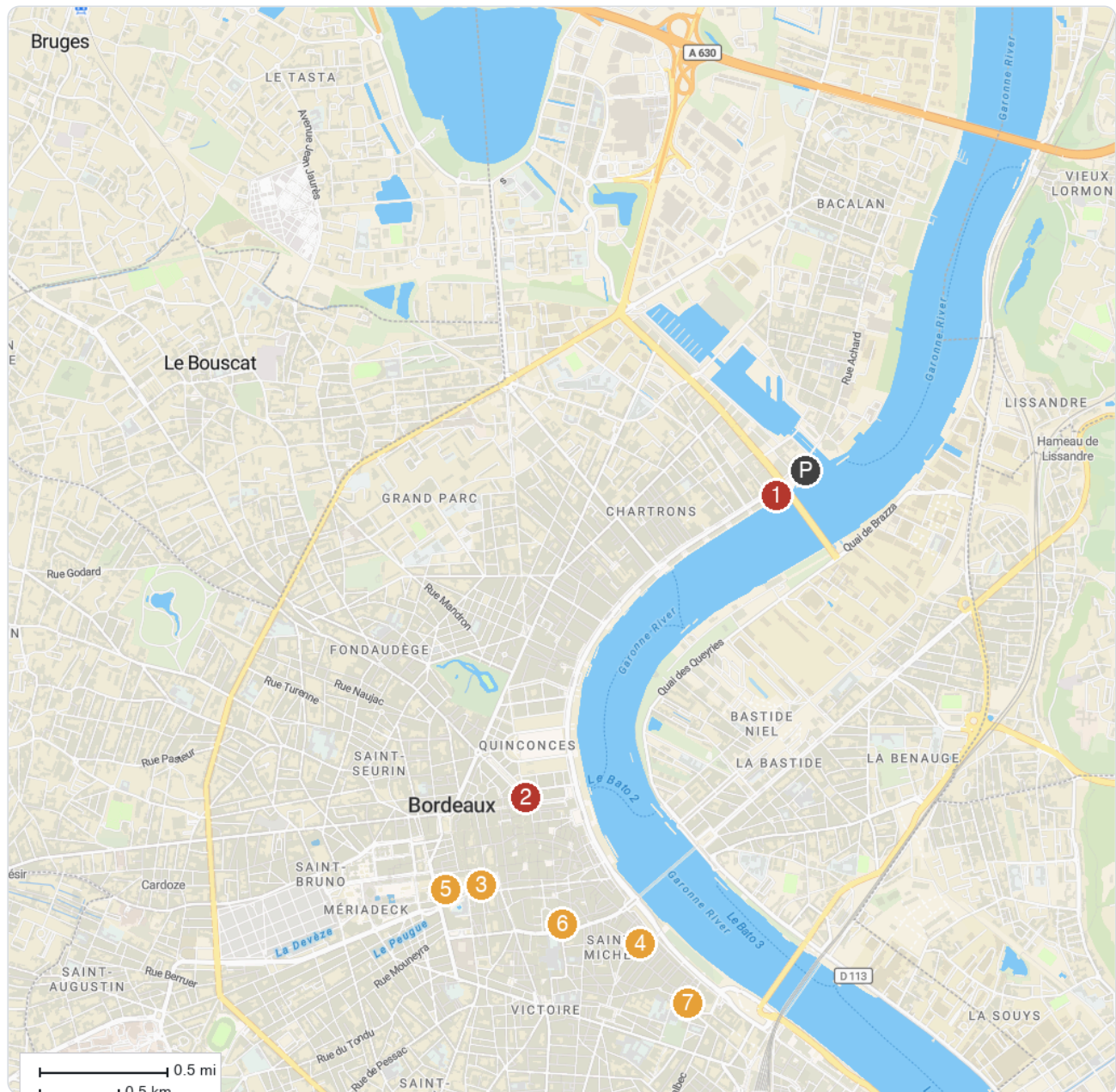
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
