GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Tender to Borgholm guest harbour — town centre is a 5-minute walk
- Walk to centre:** 5 min flat walk; Borgholm Castle 15 min uphill
- Best For:** History, cycling, royal sites, UNESCO landscapes
- Don't Miss:** Borgholm Castle ruins and Solliden Palace gardens

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  100–300 SEK (~\$11–32 USD) ·  **Rideshare**  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Borgholm Castle Ruins** — Dating to the 12th century and rebuilt multiple times, Borgholm Castle is one of Scandinavia's most dramatic ruins.
- Solliden Palace Gardens** — The Swedish Royal Family's summer residence lies just south of the castle.
- Stora Alvaret UNESCO Landscape** — The flat limestone alvar plain that runs the length of southern Öland is a UNESCO World Heritage site, famous for rare...
- Eketorp's Castle** — A fully reconstructed ring-fort from the Iron Age and medieval period in southern Öland.
- Trollskogen & Northern Öland** — The "Enchanted Forest" nature reserve in northern Öland features ancient gnarled pines and twisted oaks draped in ivy...

BEST WALKS

- Harbour → Castle → Solliden Loop** 4 km round-trip | 1.5–2 hrs | Moderate (uphill to castle) — Walk north along the waterfront into town, browse the main street, then climb the hill to Borgholm Castle ruins.
- Princess Estelle's Walk — Castle Forest to Solliden** 2.5 km one-way | ~45 min | Easy forest path — A marked woodland trail through the castle forest, named after the Crown Princess, linking the castle ruins directly to Solliden...

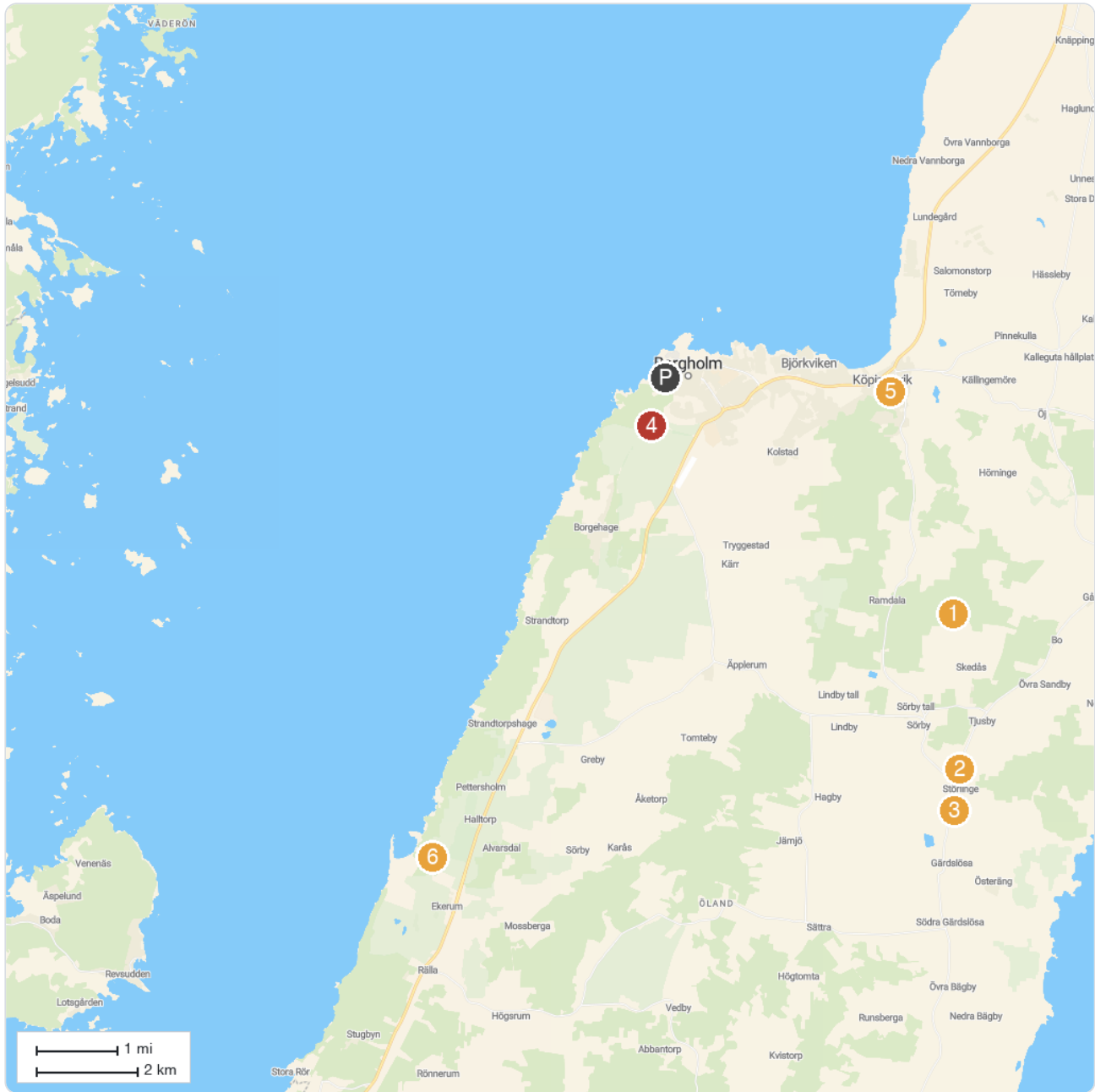
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Confirm last tender time. Borgholm is a tender port — missing the last boat means a long detour. Check the ship's schedule before heading off for the day.
- Rent a bike. Öland is flat, beautiful, and perfect cycling territory. Several rental shops are near the harbour. It's the best way to see more of the island in a half-day.
