- **Round Churches Tour** — Bornholm's four whitewashed medieval round churches — fortress-like and utterly unique, with Østerlars the largest and...
 - **Hammershus Castle Ruins** — Northern Europe's largest medieval fortress ruin, sprawling atop granite cliffs on the wild north coast with sweeping...
- **Smokehouses & Art Towns** — Taste the famous smoked Bornholm herring ('sol over Gudhjem'), then browse the glass, ceramic, and craft studios of...
 - **Bornholm by Bike** — Rent a bike and roll the flat, scenic cycle paths between fishing villages, smokehouses, and granite coast — the...

BEST WALKS

- **Rønne old town stroll** ~2 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy — Wander the cobbled lanes of crooked, pastel half-timbered houses around Storegade and Laksegade, past the old square and the harbour.
- **Rønne harbour & coast** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — Along the working fishing harbour and out toward the coast, with the lighthouse and Baltic views just beyond town.
- **Kastellet & town walls** ~1.5 km · 1 hr · easy — The small round Rønne citadel (Kastellet) and the green ramparts at the southern edge of the old town.

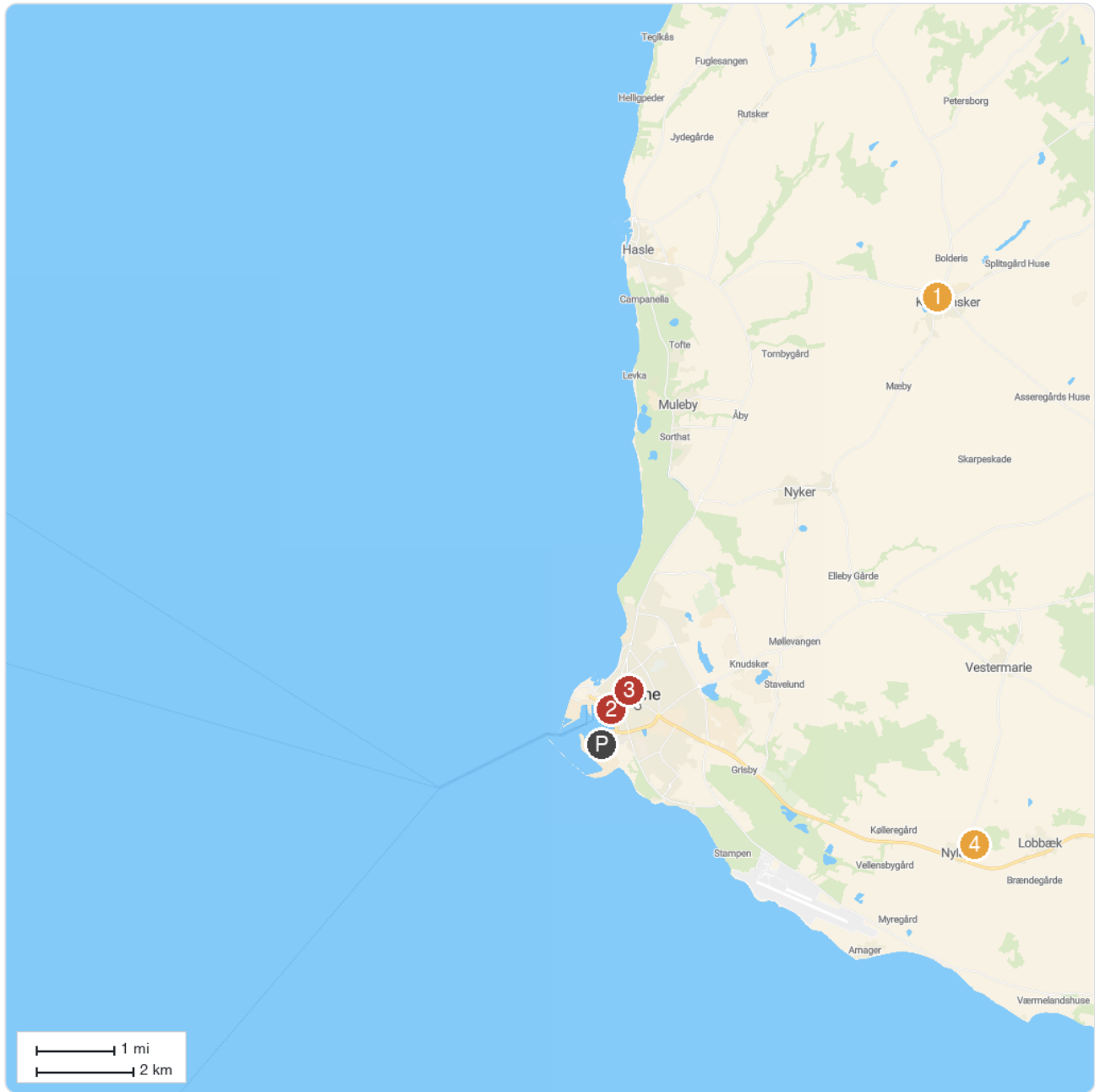
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Eat 'sol over Gudhjem.' Smoked herring topped with a raw egg yolk is the island's signature dish — try it at a traditional smokehouse.
- Rent a bike. Bornholm is flat, beautiful, and built for cycling — an e-bike from the harbour is the perfect way to reach the round churches and coast.
