GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River berth on the Canabianco canal; small barges and expedition-style vessels only

Best For: Cycling, Po Delta scenery, off-the-beaten-path river Italy

Don't Miss: The Canabianco riverside cycle path and the nearby Torre Morosini in Polesella

- Po Delta Cycling Tour** — Pedal along the Canabianco and Po riverbanks through rice fields and wetlands.
- Torre Morosini & Villa Morosini, Polesella** — A 22-metre crenellated tower — all that survives of the late-16th-century Villa Morosini, attributed to Vincenzo...
- Rovigo City Half-Day** — The provincial capital 8 km north has a proper piazza, the Pinacoteca dell'Accademia dei Concordi art gallery (with...
- Po Delta Boat Tour** — From nearby Taglio di Po or Porto Tolle, small-boat tours wind through the Po Delta's labyrinthine channels and lagoon...

BEST WALKS

- Bosaro Town Stroll** 30 min · Easy · ~1 km — A short loop through the town centre takes in the Church of San Sebastiano Martire, the historic Town Hall, and the Canabianco...
- Canabianco Towpath Ride** 1–2 hrs · Easy · 8–15 km · Bike — The flat towpath running along the Canabianco is ideal for cyclists of all levels.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

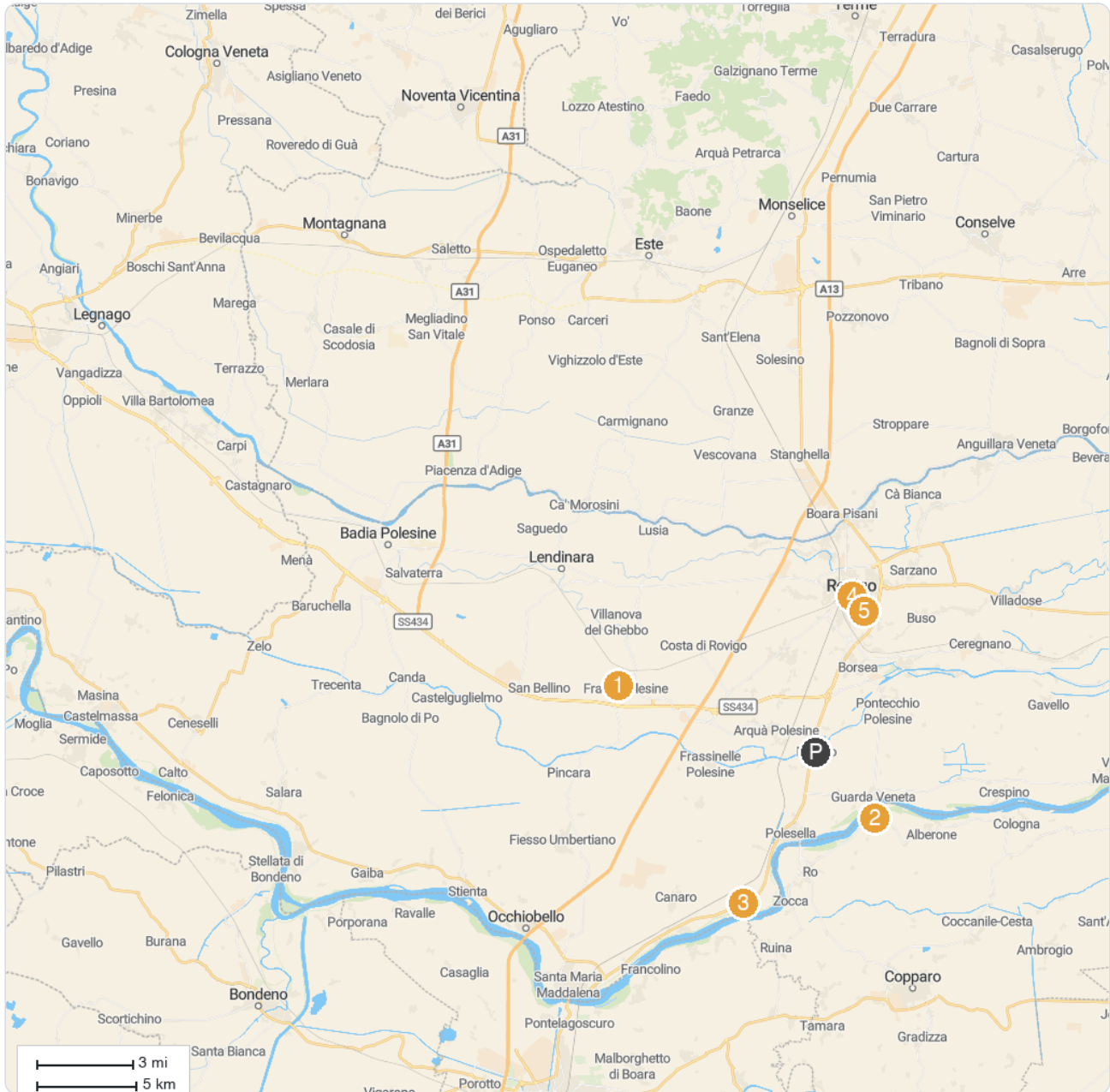
- Very limited services in town. Bosaro has a few trattorias but no ATM or pharmacy. Bring cash and anything you need before arrival; Rovigo has full facilities.
- Bring or hire a bike. Most river cruise operators organise bicycles onboard — confirm in advance. The flat terrain makes cycling ideal for all ages.

Try Po Delta rice. The Polesine is famed for its DOC-certified risotto, risotto with local ingredients (frog, eel, or freshwater fish) in the
