BEST WALKS

- **Seaport Waterfront Stroll** Scenic — Walk along the Harborwalk, exploring the modern architecture of the Seaport District and the waterfront views.

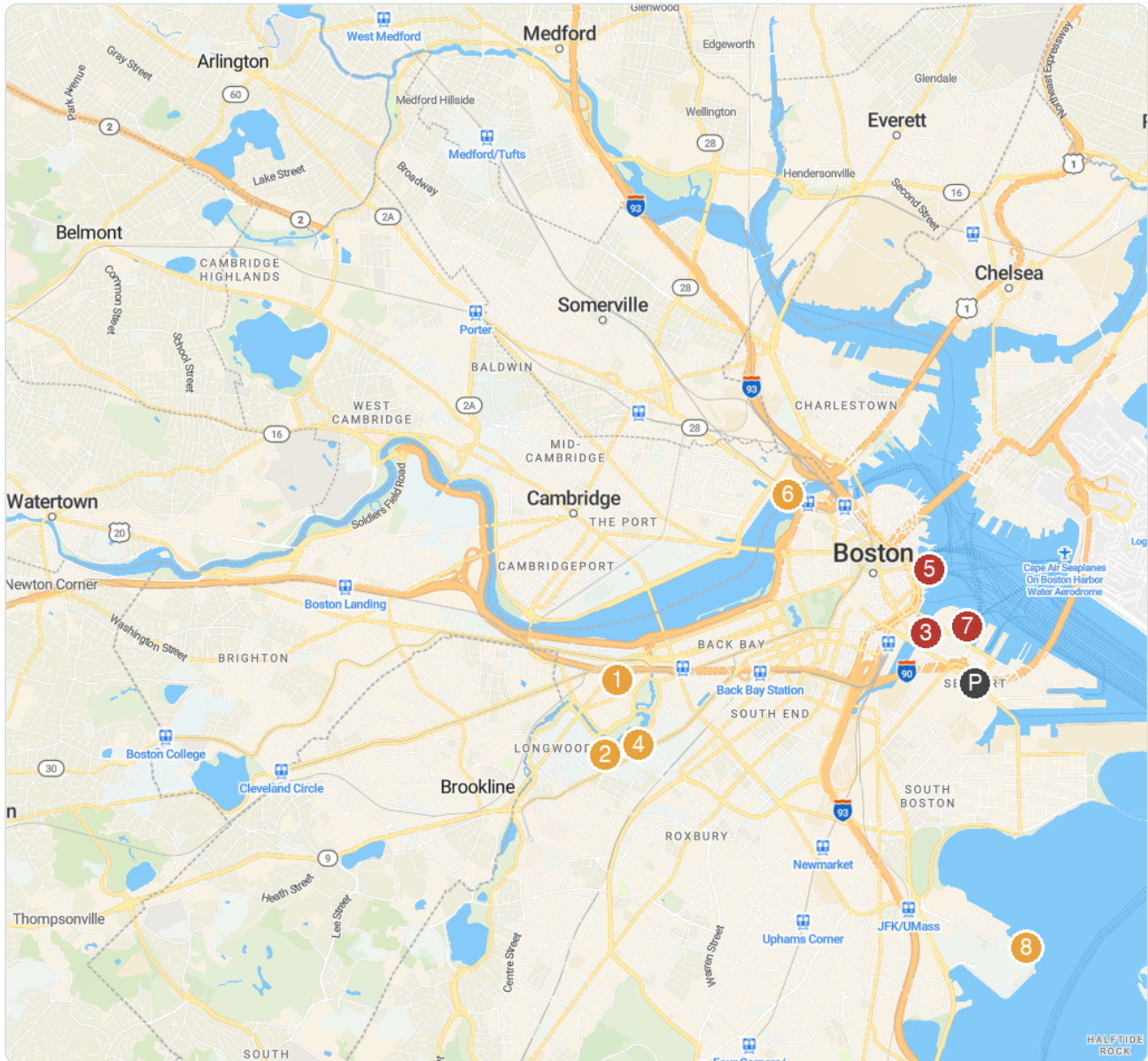
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
