TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Château d'Angers & the Apocalypse Tapestry** — The massive 13th-century fortress about 9 km away houses the world's largest surviving medieval tapestry — roughly 100...

- **Anjou Wine & Château de Brissac** — The Brissac area, 11 km south-east, is the gateway to Anjou's rosé and Coteaux du Layon appellations.
- **Loire à Vélo Riverside Ride** — Hop on the famous Loire à Vélo trail directly from the port.
- **Traditional Loire Boat Trip** — Operators La Batellerie de la Loire and Instants de Loire offer guided trips on flat-bottomed traditional boats (toutes...)
- **La Pointe — the Boatmen's Quarter** — Walk the narrow lanes of this artisan neighbourhood at the confluence of the

BEST WALKS

- **La Pointe Confluence Trail** 2 km · 30–45 min · Easy — Follow the interpretive nature trail from the halte fluviale pontoon through La Pointe to the exact spot where the Maine meets the...
- **Belvédère de la Piverdière Panorama Walk** 4 km round trip · 1–1.5 hrs · Easy — A gentle uphill path leads to a 7-hectare park with a viewpoint over the Maine, the Basses Vallées Angevines wetlands, and the Angers...

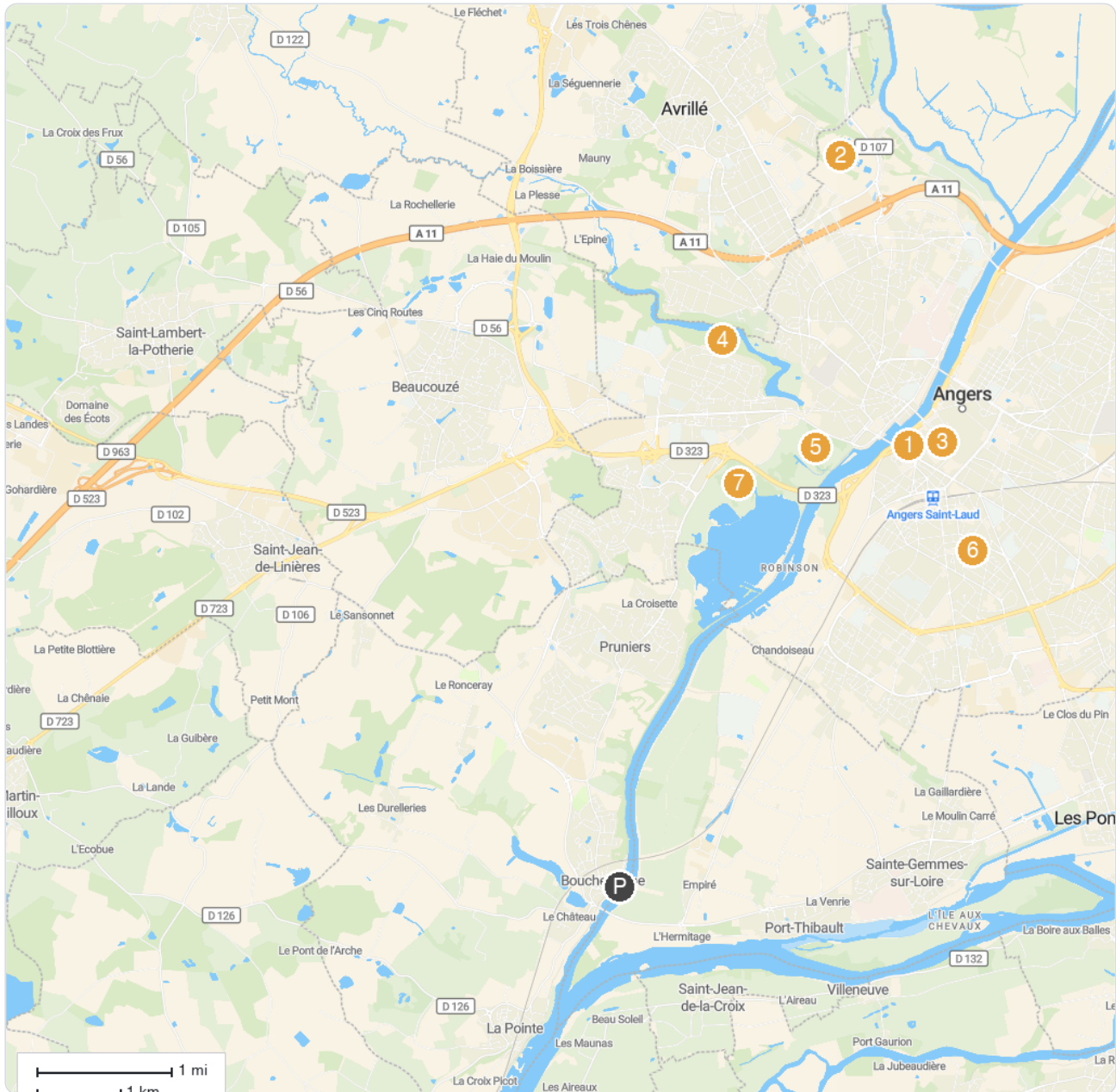
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
