GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Anchor-and-tender at Pučišća, Bol, or Sumartin; no large cruise pier on the island

Best For: Zlatni Rat beach, stonemasonry heritage, Vidova Gora views, Dalmatian food and wine

Walk to center: Tender drops you in the village center; all main attractions within 5–30 min walk

Don't Miss: Zlatni Rat (Golden Horn) beach near Bol and the Pučišća Stonemasonry School

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Zlatni Rat (Golden Horn) Beach** — The most famous beach in Croatia — a long pebble tongue that juts into the sea and shifts direction with the wind.
- **Vidova Gora Summit** — At 778 m, Vidova Gora is the highest peak of any Adriatic island.
- **Pučišća Stonemasonry School** — Pučišća is built entirely from the island's prized white limestone and hosts a working stonemasonry school where...
- **Blaca Hermitage** — A remote 16th-century monastery and hermitage built into a cliff face in a desert canyon.
- **Škrip Village & Olive Oil Museum** — Škrip is the oldest continuously inhabited settlement on the island, with an Illyrian-era fort, Roman mausoleum, and a...

BEST WALKS

- **Bol Waterfront to Zlatni Rat** 2 km one-way · ~25 min · Easy paved promenade — From Bol's ferry/tender pier, follow the seafront promenade west through pine shade.
- **Pučišća Harbour & Old Town** 1 km loop · ~30 min · Easy stone lanes — From the tender quay, stroll the U-shaped Pučišća bay, lined with stone houses and fishing boats.
