GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pontoon berths in the Old Port, left bank of the Danube

Walk to center: ~20 min on foot or 5 min by taxi to Traian Square

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Brăila Historic Centre Walk** — The fan-shaped city descends toward the Danube in concentric arcs.
- **Small Wetland of Brăila (Balta Mică a Brăilei)** — A Natura 2000 and Ramsar-listed floodplain just outside the city, sometimes called the 'mini Danube Delta.' Boat trips...
- **Brăila Museum 'Carol I' & Art Museum** — The Brăila Museum occupies the former Hôtel Français, displaying prehistory through modern Romania.
- **Lacu Sărat Saltwater Spa** — A short tram ride from the city, this saltwater lake resort has been a health destination since the 19th century.
- **Danube Delta Gateway (Tulcea)** — On longer port calls, some excursions head to Tulcea (~90 km), the main gateway city for the UNESCO Danube Delta...

BEST WALKS

- **Danube Esplanade to Traian Square** 1.2 km · 20 min · Easy — Follow the Esplanade promenade north from the port, passing the kinetic fountain and riverside terraces, then cut up through the...
- **Historic Centre Circuit** 2.5 km · 45 min · Easy — From Traian Square, walk down Republic Street past merchant houses and cafes, detour to the Maria Filotti Theatre, cross to the Church...

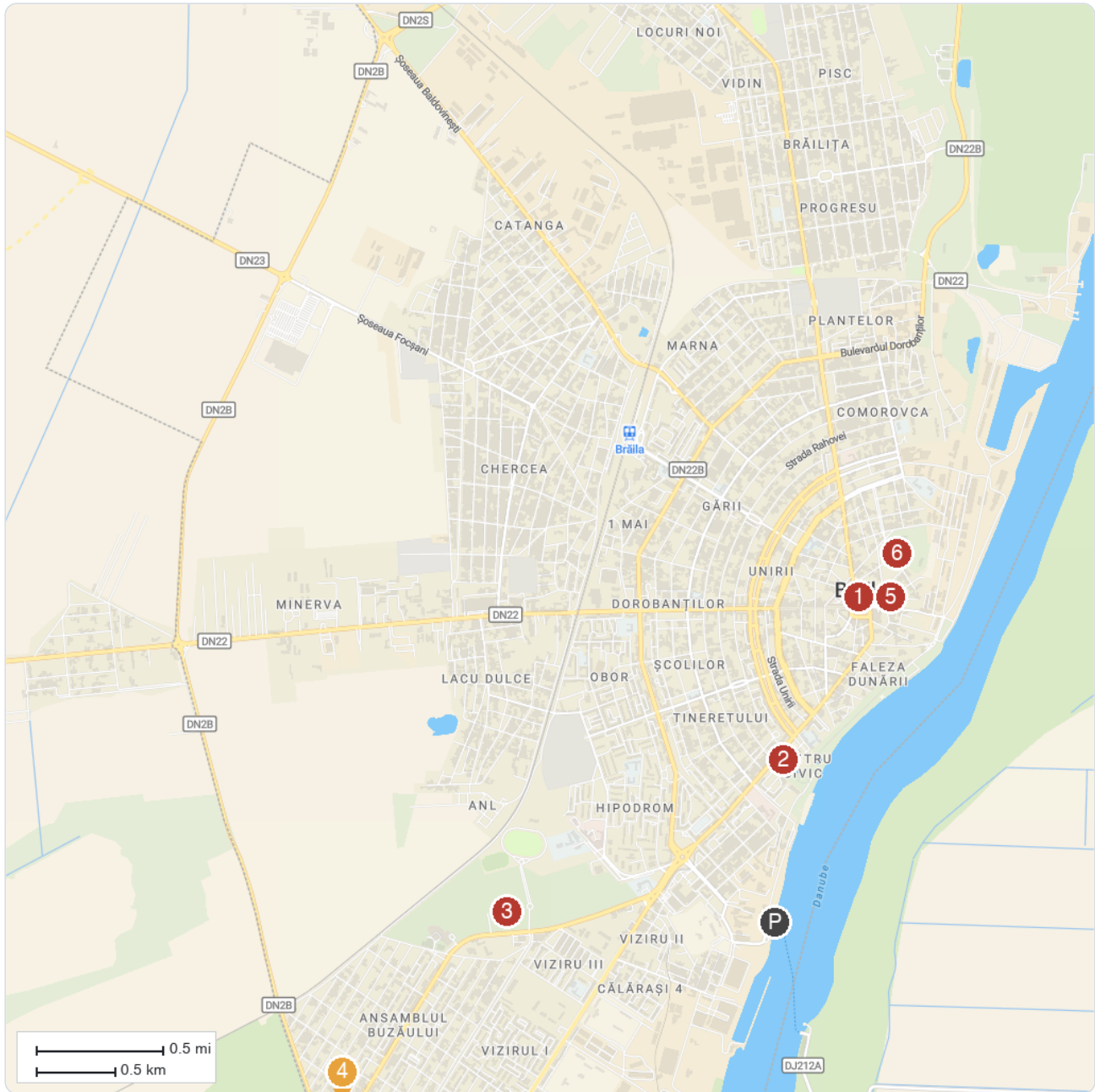
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use lei, not euros. Romania is not in the Eurozone. ATMs are available in the city center; exchange at a bank or official bureau, not from strangers near the port.
- Taxis are cheap but negotiate first. The ride from the port to Traian Square should cost under 20 lei. Make sure the meter is
