GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Salzhofufer, right beside the Millennium Bridge

Best For: Medieval architecture, Gothic churches, Havel river boat tours

Walk to centre: 3-min walk to Old Town; Cathedral Island ~20 min on foot

Don't Miss: Brandenburg Cathedral on Dominsel — founded 1165, the 'cradle of the Mark'

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Brandenburg Cathedral & Dominsel** — The Cathedral of St.
- **State Museum of Archaeology (St. Paul's Monastery)** — Housed inside the beautifully restored St.
- **Havel River Boat Tour** — Passenger boats depart from Salzhofufer for round trips on the Havel lakes — Breitlingsee and Beetzsee — passing reed...
- **Medieval Watchtowers & City Walls** — Four watchtowers survive from Brandenburg's medieval fortifications — including the Plauer Torturm and Steintorturm.
- **Slavic Village (Slawendorf)** — Right beside the Salzhofufer berth, this reconstructed 11th-century Slavic settlement gives a vivid picture of life in...

BEST WALKS

- **Three Historic Centres Walk** 4 km · ~1.5 hrs · Flat — Cross the Millennium Bridge from the berth into Neustadt, walk south to Altstadt, then cross to Dominsel to visit the Cathedral.
- **Lakeside Cycle / Walk — Mörscher See** 5-8 km loop · 1.5-2 hrs · Flat path — Head west from the city centre to the shores of Mörscher See for flat waterside paths, open lake views, and the peace of the...

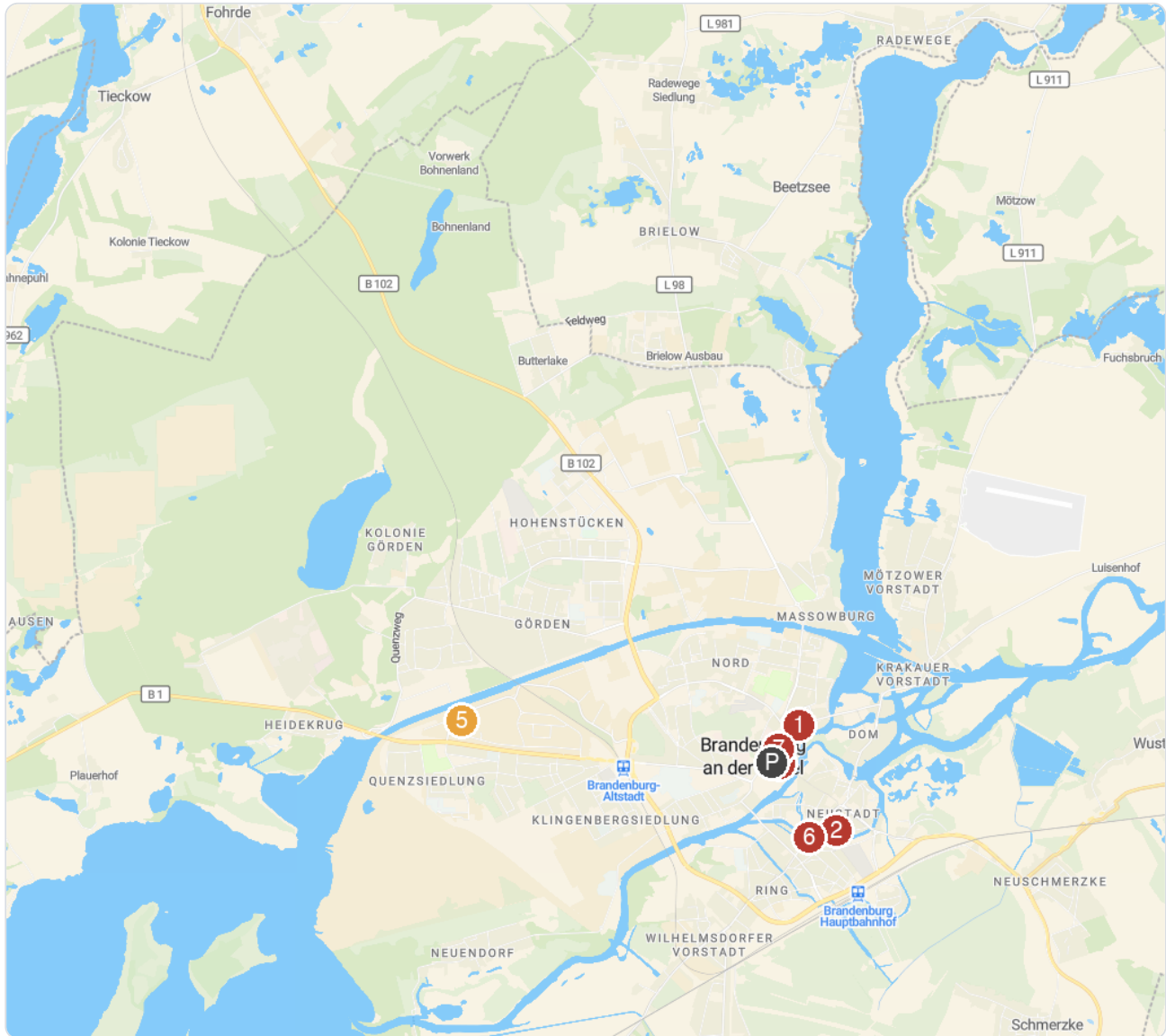
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

3 Stadtmuseum im Frey-Haus Stadtmuseum im Frey-Haus showcases Brandenburg an der Havel's city history.

5 Industrial Museum Brandenburg Industrial Museum Brandenburg preserves the city's steel industry heritage.

7 Marktbrunnen und Waldmops (Erinnerung an Lorient) Market fountain and Waldmops sculpture commemorate comedian Lorient.

2 Brandenburg State Archaeology Museum State Archaeology Museum displays Brandenburg's ancient history and artifacts.

4 Schulmuseum Reckahn Schulmuseum Reckahn is a historical school museum from the Enlightenment era.

6 Steintorturm Steintorturm is a medieval city gate tower with panoramic views.
