TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Old Town Walking Tour** — Hit the essentials in two to three hours: Main Square, Roland's Fountain, Old Town Hall, St.
- **Bratislava Castle** — The city's defining silhouette rises above the Danube on a rocky hill.
- **The Blue Church & Presidential Palace** — St.
- **Devin Castle & Danube Confluence** — A striking medieval ruin ~12 km from the city at the confluence of the Danube and Morava rivers, on the former Iron...
- **Slovak Food & Beer Tasting** — The Old Town's side streets hide wine bars pouring local Malokarpatská wine and pubs serving bryndza halušky (potato...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Loop** 1.5–2 hrs · Easy · ~2.5 km — From the pier, walk north along the riverfront to Hviezdoslavovo Námestie, then into the Old Town past St.
- **Castle Hill Climb** 2–3 hrs · Moderate · ~4 km round-trip — From Main Square, follow Zámocká Street uphill through the castle gate to the grounds and museum.

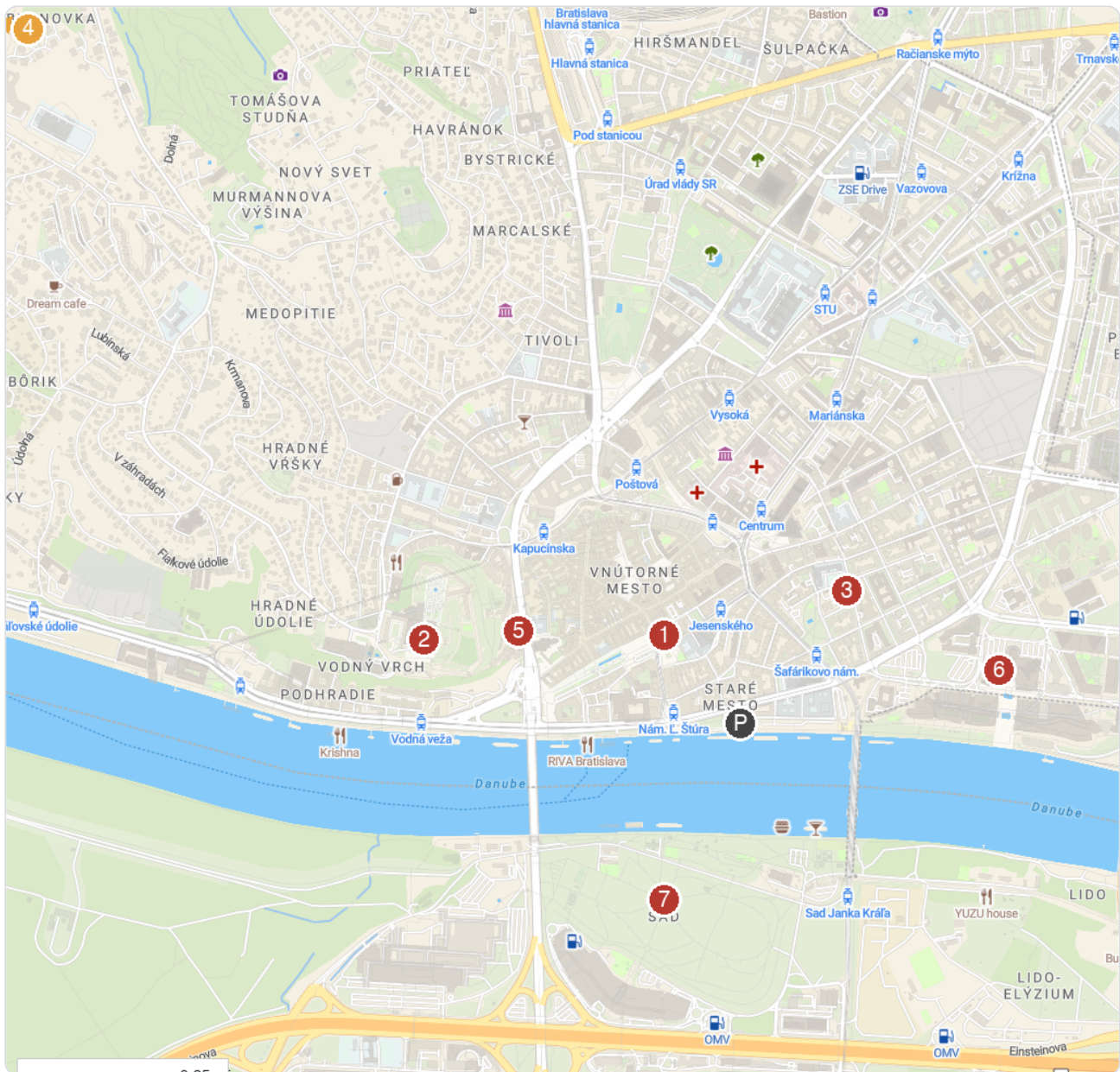
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euros everywhere. Bratislava uses the euro. ATMs are plentiful in the Old Town; exchange booths near the pier have poor rates.
- Walk everything in the center. The pier to Main Square is 10 minutes on foot. Uber/Bolt are cheap for Devin Castle or longer trips — taxis from the pier can overcharge.
- Castle is free to enter the grounds — only the museum inside charges admission (€10–12). Worth budgeting an hour for the courtyard and views even without a ticket.
