GETTING ASHORE

- **German Emigration Center (Deutsches Auswandererhaus)** — Follow the personal stories of seven million emigrants who left Europe for the New World through Bremerhaven between...
- **Klimahaus 8° Ost — Climate House** — Walk the 8th meridian east through a series of immersive climate zones — from the Sahara to Antarctica — with realistic...
- **German Maritime Museum (Deutsches Schifffahrtsmuseum)** — Germany's largest maritime museum spans centuries of seafaring history.
- **Day Trip to Bremen** — The medieval Hanseatic city of Bremen is just 45 minutes by train.
- **Schaufenster Fischereihafen — Fish Harbor** — Bremerhaven's restored old fishing harbor is the place to eat fresh Fischbrötchen (fish sandwiches), smoked salmon, and...

BEST WALKS

- **Havenwelten Museum Loop** 2.5 km · ~35 min walk · Flat — From the cruise terminal, walk north along the Weser Dyke promenade to the Klimahaus, German Emigration Center, and German Maritime...
- **Fish Harbor Stroll** 3 km · ~40 min walk · Flat — Head west from the terminal past the Havenwelten to the Schaufenster Fischereihafen for lunch at the fish stalls, then loop back along...

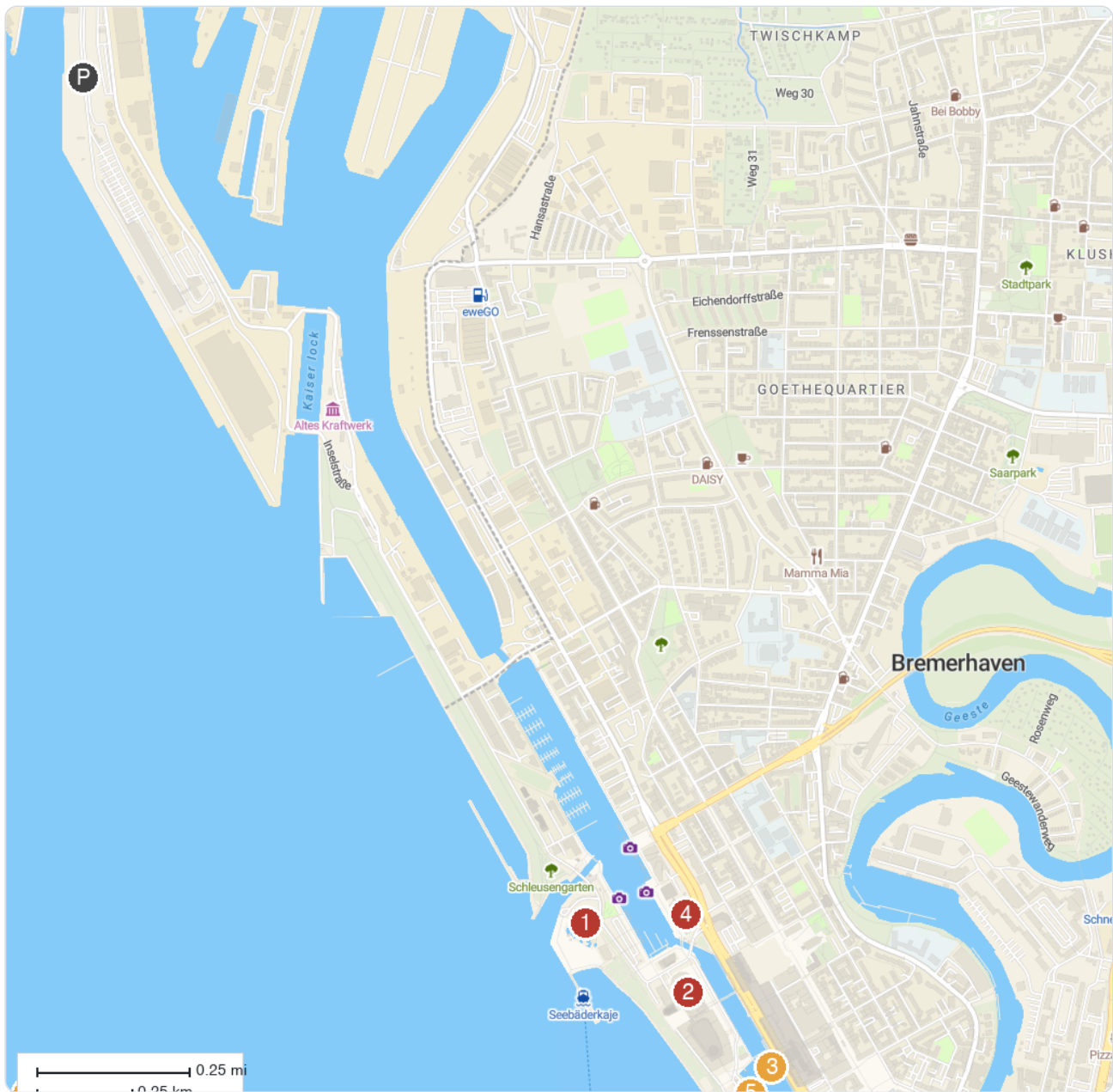
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash. Major attractions accept cards, but fish market stalls, small cafés, and the harbor bus often prefer euros. Day trip to Bremen early. Last trains back are in the evening, but leave yourself buffer time — ships don't wait.
