GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Bremerton Marina / downtown boardwalk — no tender required

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **USS Turner Joy Naval Destroyer Museum** — Step aboard this Vietnam-era destroyer docked on the Bremerton Boardwalk.
- **Puget Sound Navy Museum** — Free museum next to the ferry terminal covering Puget Sound Naval Shipyard history, nuclear aircraft carriers, and...
- **Seattle Day Trip by Fast Ferry** — The Kitsap Transit fast ferry reaches downtown Seattle in ~30 minutes.
- **Elandan Gardens** — World-renowned bonsai collection set on a hillside above Sinclair Inlet, featuring trees hundreds of years old and...
- **Downtown Arts District & Manette** — Stroll downtown's galleries, independent shops, breweries, and cafes, then cross the Manette Bridge to the Manette...

BEST WALKS

- **Boardwalk Naval Trail** 1.5 miles · Flat · 30-45 min — Walk the full Bremerton Boardwalk from the marina past Harborside Fountain Park, the Puget Sound Navy Museum, and USS Turner Joy.
- **Manette Bridge Loop** 2 miles · Flat · 45-60 min — From the boardwalk, walk east through downtown, cross the Manette Bridge over Port Washington Narrows, explore the Manette...

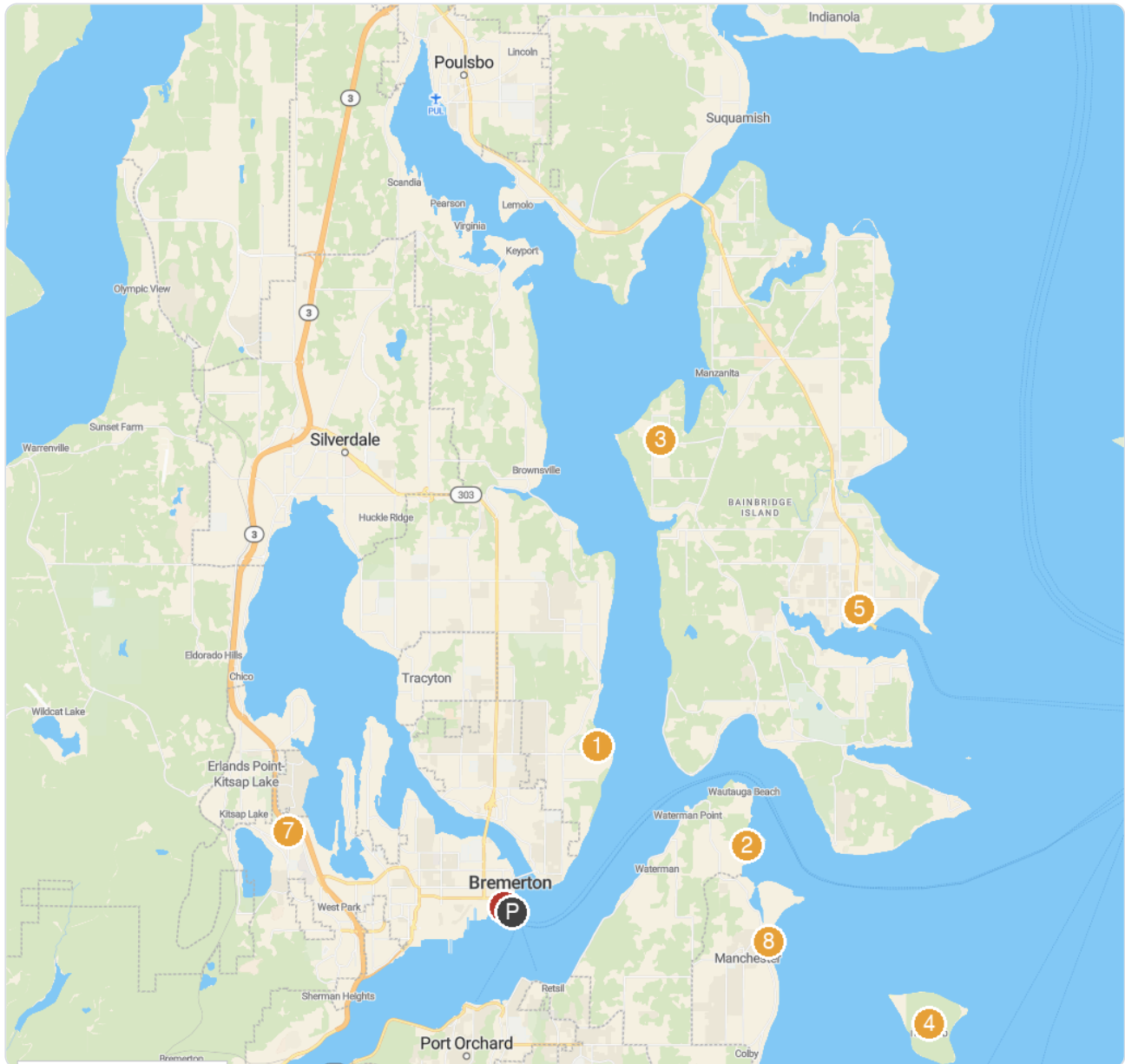
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Fast ferry to Seattle runs ~30 min from Bremerton's waterfront terminal. Round-trip takes most of your port day — only attempt it if call is 7+ hours.
- Puget Sound Navy Museum is free. USS Turner Joy charges admission; buy tickets at the gate on the boardwalk.
