GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Costa Morena Terminal (3–4 km from center) or Sant'Apollinare Pier (1–2 km, walkable)

Best For: History buffs, day trippers to Alberobello & Lecce, Puglia cuisine

Walk to Center: 10–15 min from Sant'Apollinare; shuttle or taxi from Costa Morena

Don't Miss: The Roman Column at the end of Via Appia, Piazza Duomo, a plate of orecchiette

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Alberobello & the Trulli** — A UNESCO World Heritage site unlike anything else in Europe.
- **Lecce Baroque Walking Tour** — Called the 'Florence of the South,' Lecce is 40 minutes from Brindisi and packed with extravagant Baroque churches and...
- **Brindisi Old Town on Foot** — The Roman Columns that once marked the end of the Via Appia, the 11th-century Cathedral on Piazza Duomo, Castello Svevo...
- **Ostuni & the Itria Valley** — Ostuni — the dazzling 'White City' — crowns a hilltop with whitewashed lanes and a 15th-century Gothic cathedral.
- **Torre Guaceto Beach & Nature Reserve** — A protected coastal reserve about 20 km north of Brindisi with clear Adriatic water, white sand, and no development.

BEST WALKS

- **Via Appia End to Piazza Duomo** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — Start at the surviving Roman Column on Via Colonne — the ancient marker of the Appian Way's terminus — then walk inland through the...
- **Lungomare Regina Margherita** 2 km · 40 min · Easy — Follow the palm-lined seafront promenade along the inner harbor, past the Castello Alfonsino visible on Sant'Andrea island, continuing...

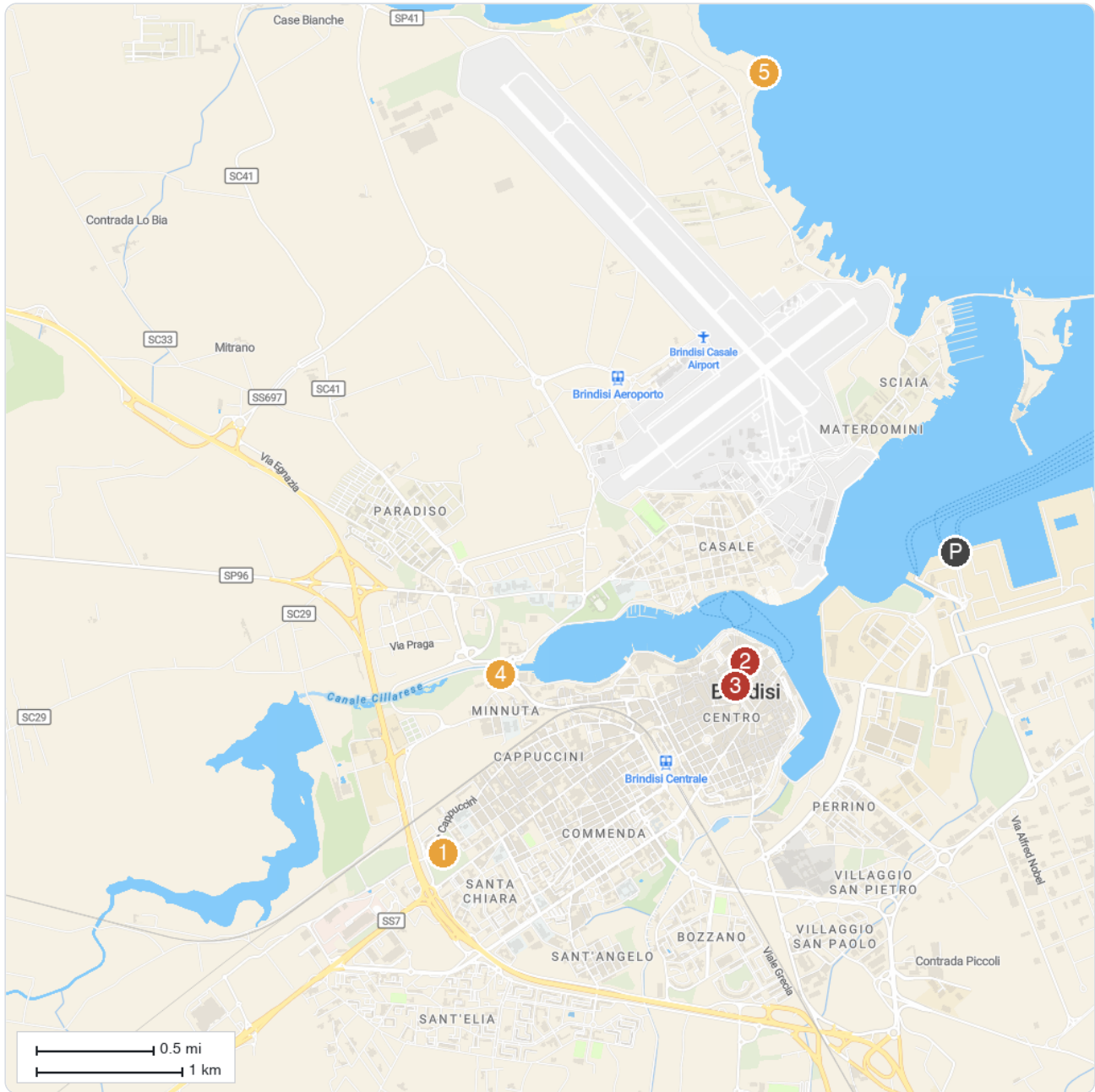
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Check your berth the night before. Costa Morena passengers need the shuttle or a taxi — don't assume you can walk to the city center.
- Start with Alberobello early. Trulli crowds build by mid-morning; the first coach of the day gets the quieter lanes.

- 1** **Parco Comunale Cesare Braico**
A large municipal park with green spaces and walking paths.
- 3** **Area Archeologica di San Pietro degli Schiavoni**
Ancient Roman road and ruins beneath a modern building.
- 5** **Punta del Serrone**
A scenic coastal point with a sandy beach and clear waters.

- 2** **Catholic cathedral of Saint John the Baptist, Brindisi, Italy**
Brindisi's main Romanesque cathedral, rebuilt after an earthquake.
- 4** **Parco del Cillarese**
A natural park with a lake, ideal for birdwatching.
- P** **Cruise port / terminal**
