TOP THINGS TO DO

- **SS Great Britain & Brunel's Dock** — Board the world's first ocean-going iron-hulled, screw-propelled ship, designed by Isambard Kingdom Brunel and restored...
- **Clifton Suspension Bridge & Gorge** — Another Brunel masterpiece, this 1864 suspension bridge spans the spectacular Avon Gorge.
- **Harbourside & Banksy Street Art Walk** — Bristol's regenerated docklands buzz with waterside bars, the M Shed museum, Arnolfini arts centre, and original Banksy...
- **Day Trip to Bath** — Bath is only 13 miles from Bristol and accessible by frequent direct train (15 minutes from Temple Meads).
- **Cotswolds Villages** — A guided coach tour takes you into the honey-stone villages of the Cotswolds — Bourton-on-the-Water, Burford, or Castle...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbourside & Old City Loop** 2.5 miles · mostly flat · 1-1.5 hrs — From Bristol Temple Meads, walk along the floating harbour past M Shed and the Arnolfini, across Prince Street Bridge to the...
- **Clifton Village & Suspension Bridge** 1 mile in Clifton · hilly · 1 hr — Take a bus or taxi to Clifton Village, browse the boutiques on Regent Street and The Mall, then walk down to the gorge viewpoint and...

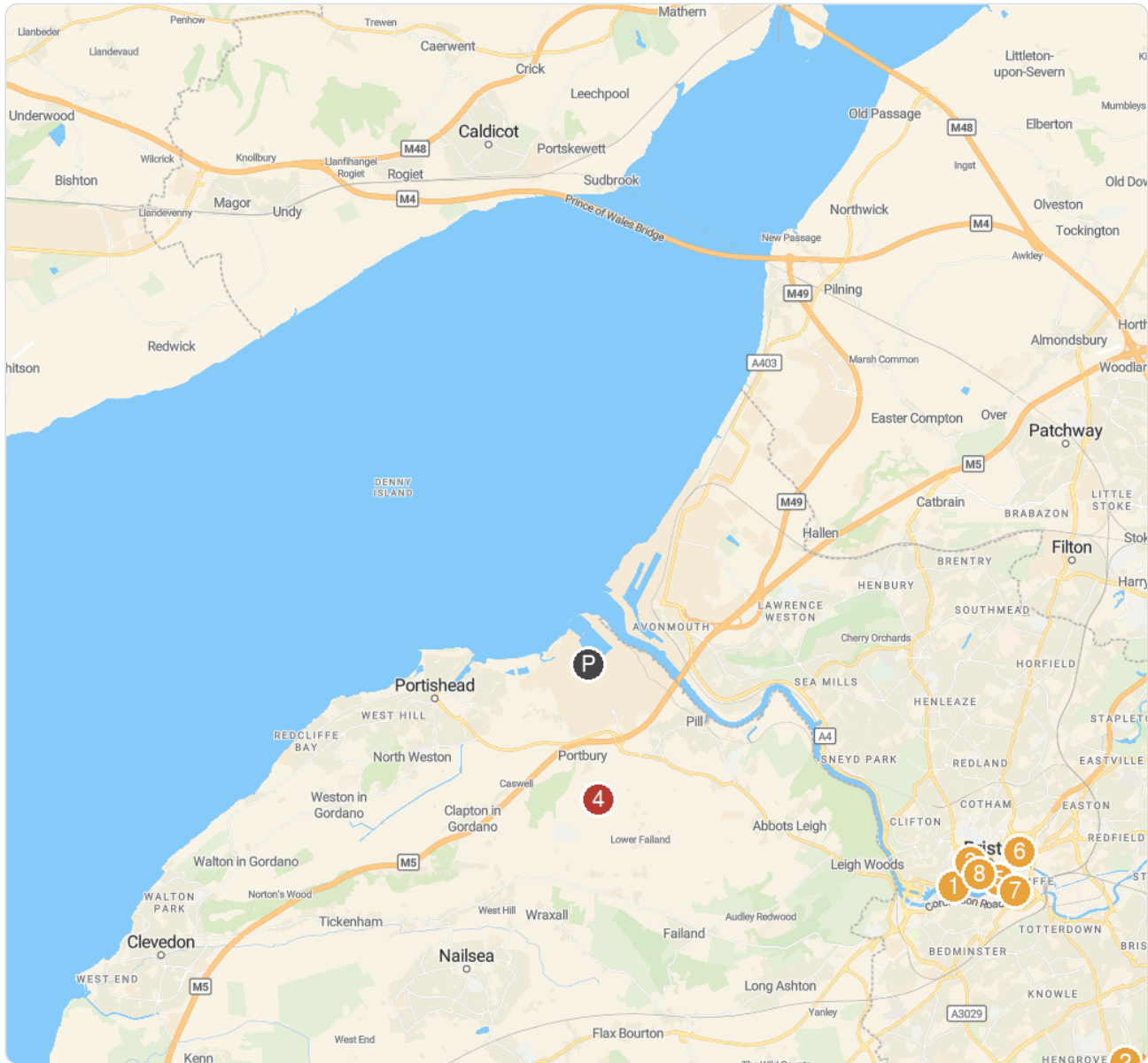
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
