GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Port of Broome jetty, ~6 km south of town; shuttle buses to Chinatown

Best For: Cable Beach sunsets, South Sea pearl shopping, Horizontal Falls seaplane tours

Walk to centre: Not walkable — free cruise-line shuttles run to Chinatown/Napier Terrace

Don't Miss: Camel ride on Cable Beach, dinosaur footprints at Gantheaume Point (low tide)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cable Beach Camel Ride at Sunset** — A Broome institution: ride a camel along 22 km of pristine white sand as the sun drops into the Indian Ocean.
- **Horizontal Falls Seaplane Tour** — Fly by seaplane into the Kimberley to see the extraordinary Horizontal Falls — tidal water rushing through narrow...
- **Gantheaume Point & Dinosaur Footprints** — Red pindan cliffs plunge into turquoise sea at Gantheaume Point.
- **Malcolm Douglas Crocodile Park** — Meet massive saltwater crocodiles relocated from the wild at this well-regarded park just outside Broome.
- **Pearl Luggers Museum & Chinatown** — Broome's multicultural pearling past is preserved at the Pearl Luggers Museum — restored 19th-century pearl luggers...

BEST WALKS

- **Chinatown Heritage Stroll** 1 km · Flat · 30–45 min — From the shuttle drop at Napier Terrace, explore Broome's historic Chinatown — pearl showrooms, the Sun Pictures outdoor cinema...
- **Cable Beach & Gantheaume Point Loop** 3 km · Easy sand/path · 1-1.5 hrs — Take the Explorer Bus to Cable Beach, walk south along the sand toward Gantheaume Point.

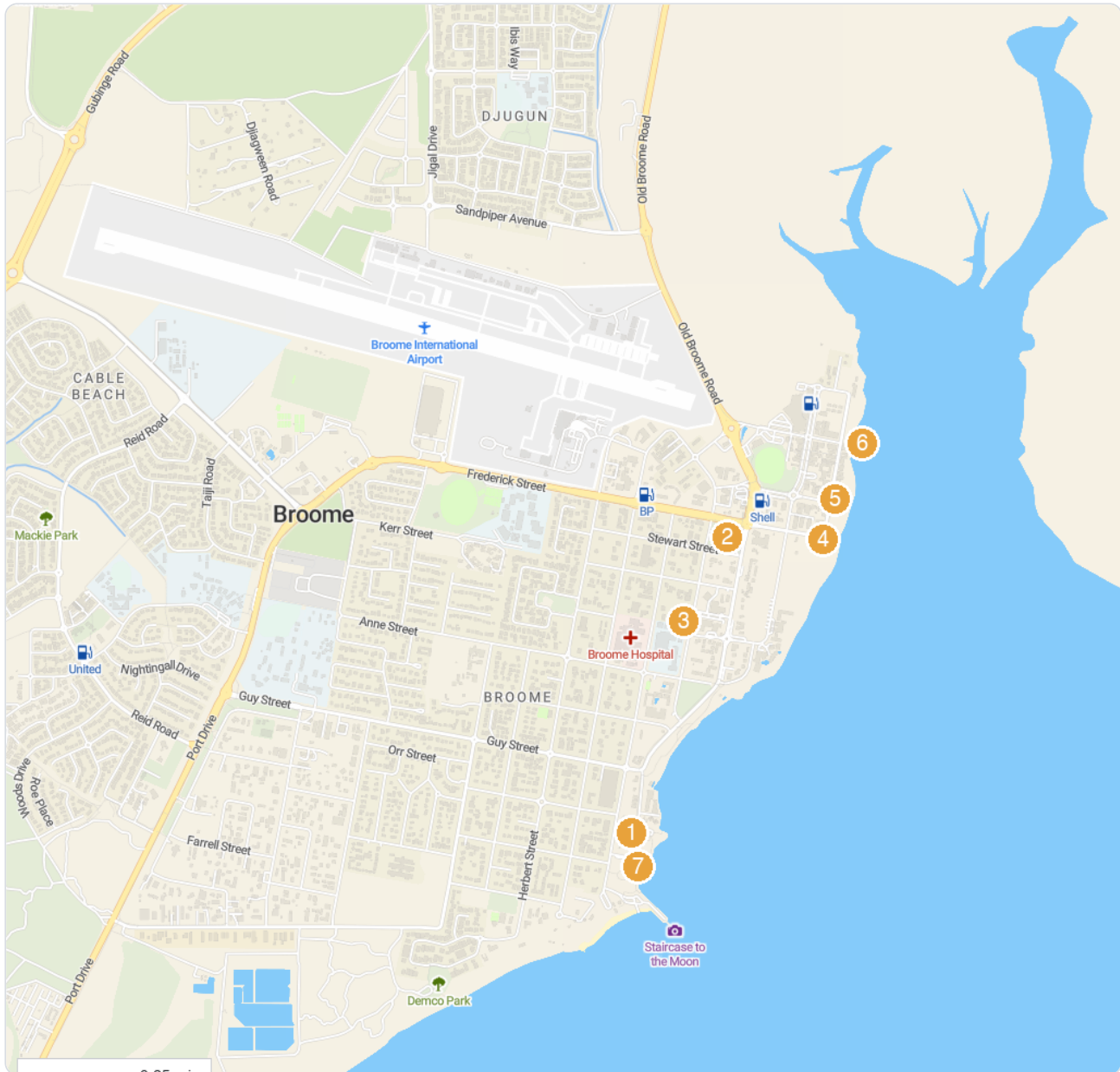
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Take the shuttle — don't walk. The pier is 6 km from town in an industrial area. The free cruise-line shuttle is your primary transport; it drops at Napier Terrace, Chinatown.
