- **Brusea Fishing Museum** — Explore the history of mussel farming and harbor life in Bruinisse at this local heritage museum, which includes a...
- **Grevelingenmeer Water Sports** — The Grevelingenmeer is Western Europe's largest saltwater lake and a haven for sailing, windsurfing, kitesurfing...
- **Watersnoodmuseum — Flood Museum** — A short drive from Bruinisse, this striking museum chronicles the catastrophic 1953 North Sea flood that devastated...
- **Cycle the Brouwersdam & Delta Works** — Rent a bike and ride to the Brouwersdam, the massive Delta Works dam separating the Grevelingenmeer from the North Sea...
- **Mussel Tasting at the Harbor** — Bruinisse is the self-proclaimed mussel capital of the Netherlands.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor & Mussel Boulevard Loop** 1.5 km · 20–30 min · Easy — Walk from the marina quay along the Havendijk past the working mussel boats, past the Mussel Monument on the Mussel Boulevard, then...
- **Grevelingenmeer Shoreline Walk** 3–4 km · 45–60 min · Easy — Follow the lakeside path south from the marina along the Grevelingenmeer shoreline.

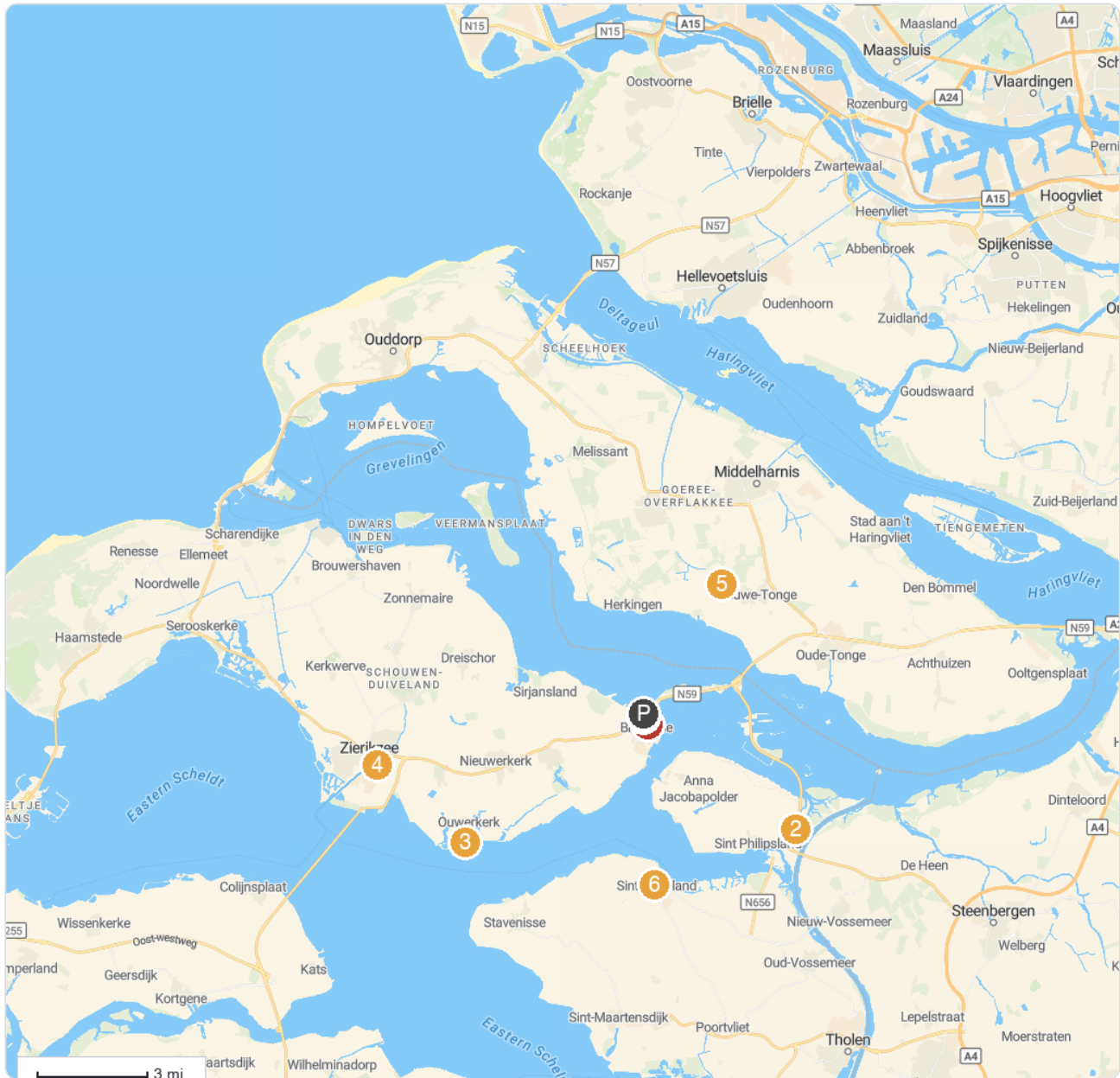
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
