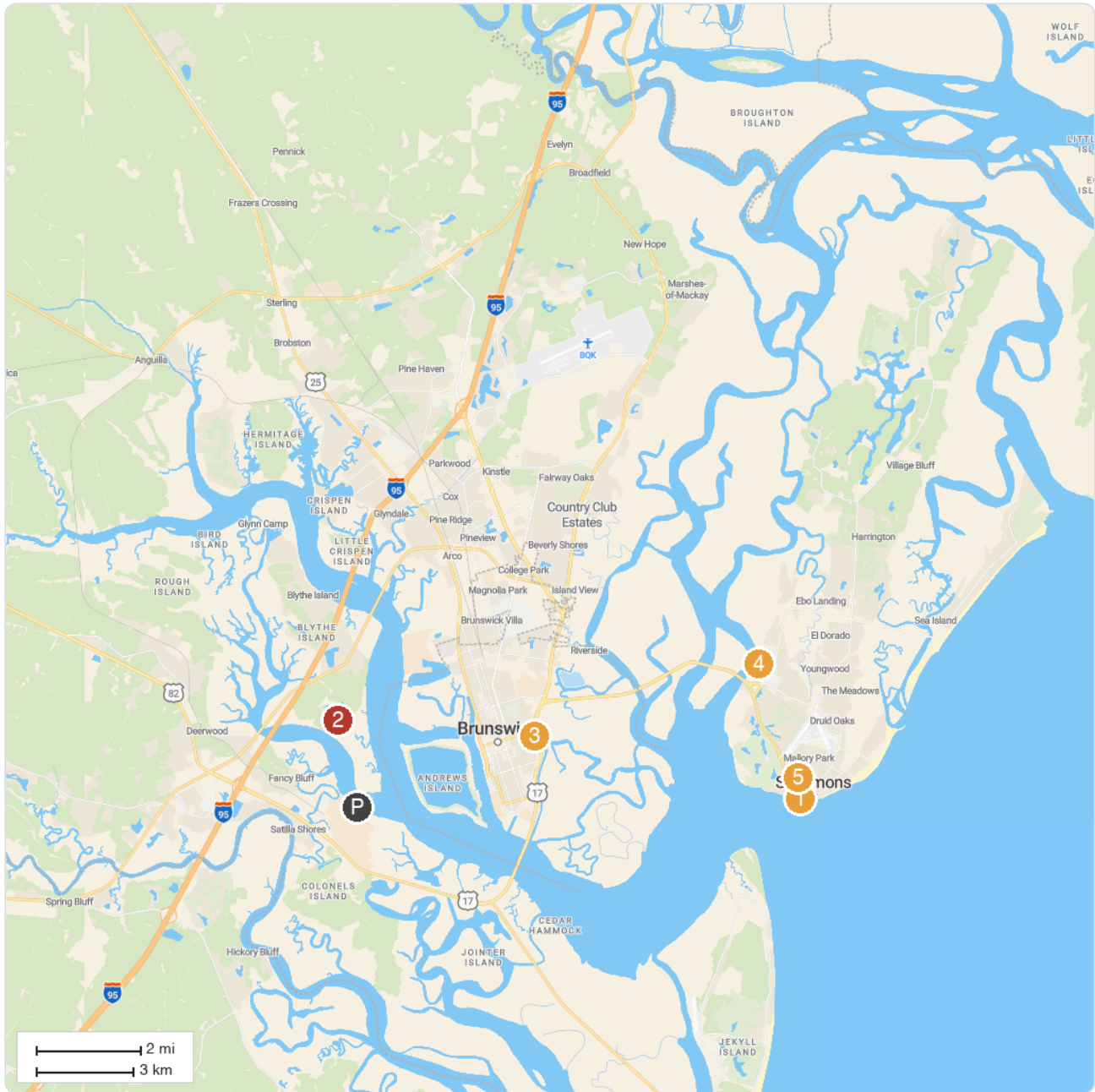
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Small-ship port: Brunswick is not a mainstream large cruise port — it's primarily called by American Cruise Lines and similar small-ship operators. Infrastructure is modest but...
- Island access by taxi: The Golden Isles (St. Simons, Jekyll) require a short taxi or Uber ride. Confirm ride availability before heading out on your own.
- Bring bug spray: Coastal Georgia marshes mean mosquitoes and no-see-ums, especially in warmer months. Insect repellent is essential for outdoor activities.
