GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Bucksport Town Dock (400-ft upgraded concrete float, ADA gangway)

Walk to center: ~5 min along the waterfront walkway to Main Street

Don't Miss: Climbing the Penobscot Narrows Observatory — 420 ft up, the only bridge observatory in the US

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Fort Knox State Historic Site** — Explore one of the best-preserved Civil War-era granite forts in America.
- **Penobscot Narrows Observatory** — Ride to the top of the Penobscot Narrows Bridge — 420 feet up — for 360-degree panoramic views of Penobscot Bay, the...
- **Fort Knox Nature Cruise** — Two-hour boat excursion through Bucksport harbor and the Penobscot River waterways.
- **Acadia National Park Day Trip** — American Cruise Lines sometimes offers day-trip excursions to Acadia National Park on Mount Desert Island, about an...
- **Bucksport Main Street Walk** — Stroll the brick waterfront walkway to downtown, browse the Lighthouse Arts Center gallery (100+ Maine artists), catch...

BEST WALKS

- **Bucksport Waterfront Walkway** 1 mile | Easy | Paved & flat | 20-30 min — A paved brick path along the Penobscot River from the town dock to downtown.
- **Main Street to Alamo Theatre Loop** 0.5 miles | Easy | 15-20 min — From the waterfront, walk up to Main Street to explore the Lighthouse Arts Center, Alamo Theatre, and local dining.
