GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Multiple quayside piers on the Pest bank of the Danube; ships typically dock at Akadémia, MAHART International, or Vigadó piers near the city center

Best For: Architecture, history, thermal baths, river panoramas, Central European cuisine

Walk to Center: Most piers are within 5–15 min walk of the Chain Bridge and Váci Street shopping area

Don't Miss: Fisherman's Bastion at sunrise and a sunset view of the floodlit Parliament from the Danube

Getting around: Taxi ~€5–€15 · Rideshare Uber, Bolt · Hop-on hop-off Hop-on hop-off

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Buda Castle & Castle District** — UNESCO World Heritage hilltop quarter with Buda Castle, Fisherman's Bastion, Matthias Church, and sweeping views over...
- Hungarian Parliament Building** — One of Europe's largest and most ornate parliament buildings, viewable in full glory from the river.
- Széchenyi Thermal Baths** — Budapest's most famous thermal complex in City Park, with large outdoor and indoor pools fed by natural hot springs.
- Jewish Quarter & Dohány Street Synagogue** — The Great Synagogue on Dohány Street is the largest in Europe and anchor of Budapest's historic Jewish district.
- Great Market Hall & Hungarian Food** — The ornate 1897 Neo-Gothic market hall on Fővám Square stocks fresh paprika, sausages, lángos, and Tokaj wine.

BEST WALKS

- Pest Embankment to Chain Bridge & St. Stephen's Basilica** 2.5 km · ~1 hr · Easy — Stroll north along the riverside promenade past the MAHART piers, up to the Széchenyi Chain Bridge for iconic Danube panoramas, then...
- Castle Hill Loop** 3 km · ~2 hrs · Moderate — Cross the Chain Bridge, ride the funicular to the top, explore Fisherman's Bastion, Matthias Church, and the courtyards of Buda...
- Andrássy Avenue to Heroes' Square** ~1.5 km one-way · ~30 min · Easy — From the Opera House on Andrássy Avenue, walk the grand UNESCO-listed boulevard past Art Nouveau mansions and embassy buildings to...

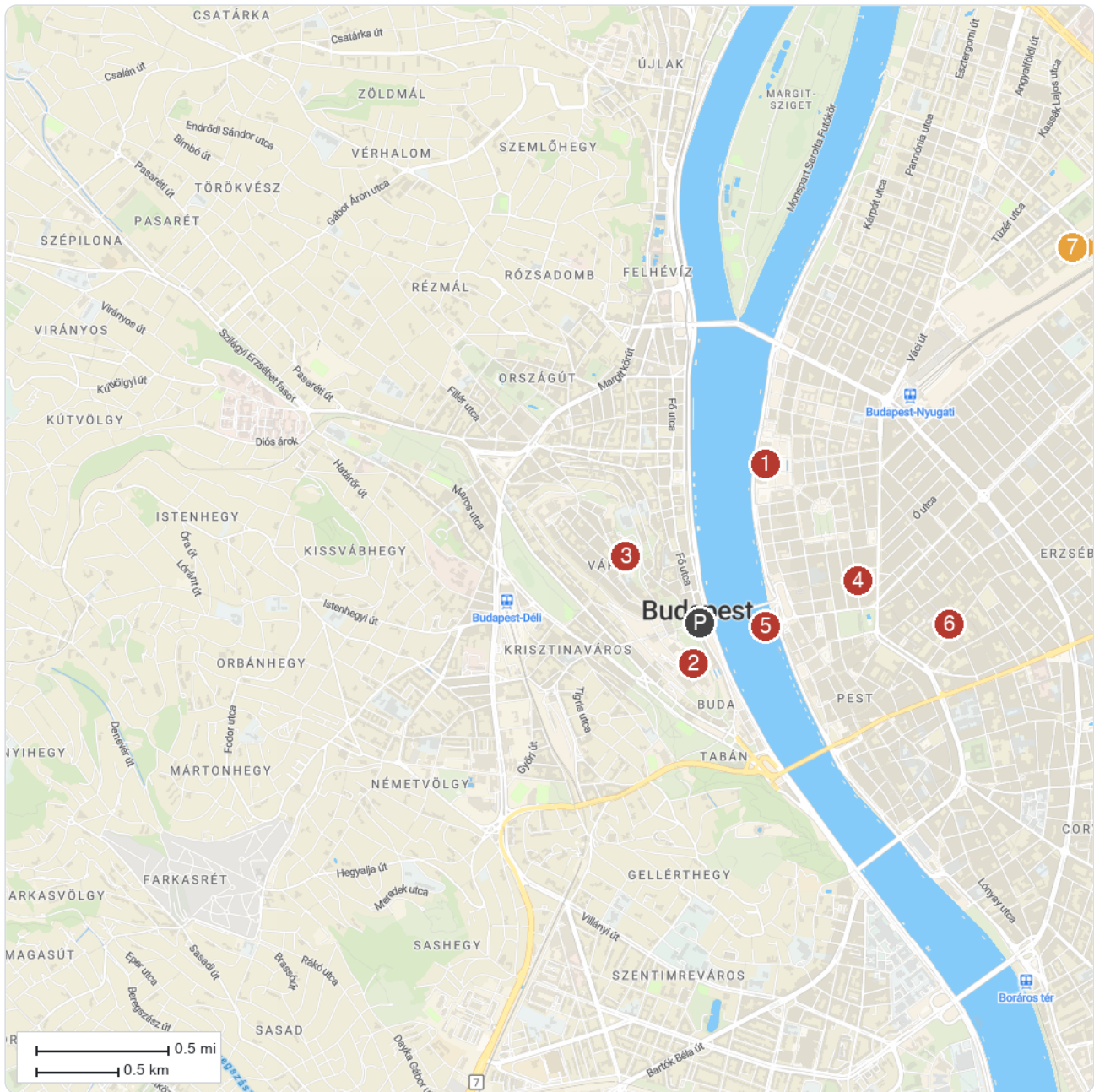
