GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Berth 1, Outer Harbour — 3-4 km from city center; shuttle buses typically provided by cruise lines

Best For: Wildlife (dolphins), café culture, regional wine country day trips

Walk to center: Not walkable from berth; shuttle or taxi ~10 min to Victoria Street

Don't Miss: Dolphin Discovery Centre on Koombana Bay — wild dolphins in the shallows daily

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dolphin Discovery Centre & Eco-Cruise** — Koombana Bay and the surrounding Bunbury waters host a local population of over 100 wild bottlenose dolphins.
- **Mangrove Boardwalk & Leschenault Inlet** — Stroll elevated boardwalks through Western Australia's southernmost mangrove forest, then loop around the calm...
- **CBD Mural Trail & Victoria Street Cafés** — Bunbury boasts the largest public mural collection in regional Australia.
- **Ferguson Valley Winery Day Trip** — A 25-minute drive inland brings you to Bunbury's boutique wine and craft-beer region, with cellar doors, cheese...
- **Busselton Jetty Excursion** — Forty-five minutes south, the 1.8 km Busselton Jetty is the longest timber-piled jetty in the Southern Hemisphere.

BEST WALKS

- **Koombana Bay & Dolphin Centre Loop** 3 km · 45 min · Easy — From the Visitor Centre head south along Koombana Drive to the Dolphin Discovery Centre, walk the bay shoreline where dolphins often...
- **Victoria Street Café Strip & Marlston Hill** 2 km · 30 min · Easy (short hill climb) — Walk Victoria Street from end to end, soaking up the café scene and murals, then detour up the timber stairway to Marlston Hill...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

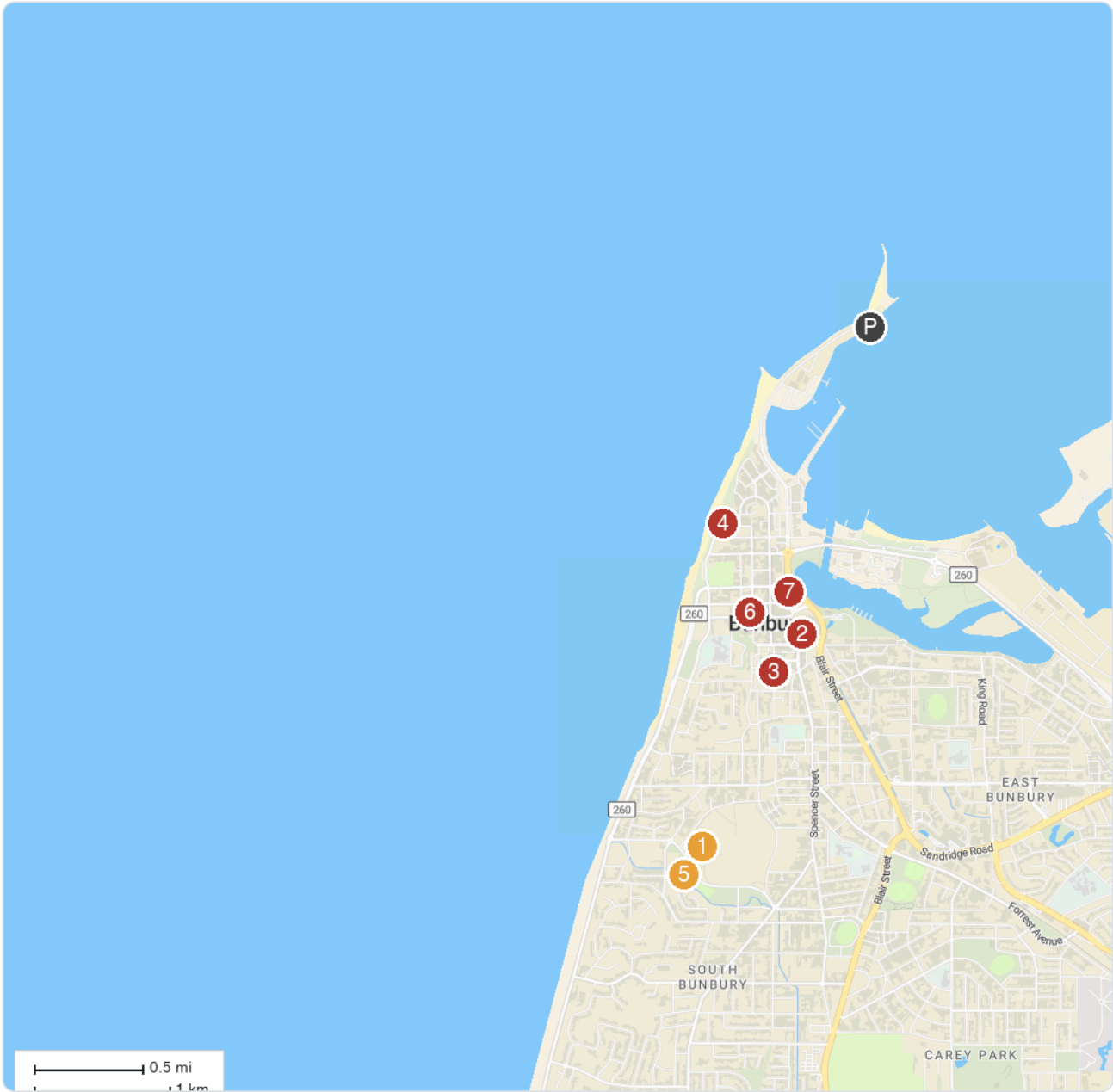
- Use the cruise shuttle. The port is industrial with no services — the complimentary shuttle to the Visitor Centre is the easiest start to your day. Confirm timings at the gangway.

Go early for dolphins. Wild dolphins are most active at Koombana Bay in the morning; the Dolphin Discovery Centre opens at 9

3	St Patrick's Cathedral	Bunbury's main Catholic church, a historic cathedral.	4	Bunbury Lighthouse	A historic lighthouse offering panoramic city and ocean views.
5	Bunbury Wildlife Park	See native Australian animals in a natural setting.	6	Bunbury Regional Art Gallery	Discover regional art in a historic former convent.
7	Bicentennial Square	A central public square for events and relaxation.	P	Cruise port / terminal
