GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Magazia 1 or East Terminal — no tender

Best For: History day-trips (Nessebar, Sozopol), beaches, easy city walks

Walk to center: 5-10 min on foot to Sea Garden and pedestrian streets

Don't Miss: Lake Atanasovsko — the otherworldly pink salt lake north of town

Getting around: **Taxi** 5–15 BGN (~€3–€8) · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Nessebar Old Town (UNESCO)** — A rocky peninsula packed with Byzantine churches, medieval ruins, and 19th-century wooden houses.
- Sozopol Old Town & Bay** — Cobbled lanes, ancient Apollonia ruins, and a pretty harbour about 34 km south of Burgas.
- Lake Atanasovsko Pink Salt Lake** — Just north of the port, this hypersaline lake turns vivid pink in summer — a wild, photogenic landscape.
- St. Anastasia Island Boat Trip** — A short ferry from Burgas harbour takes you to a small island with a medieval monastery (founded in the 10th century...
- Burgas City Highlights Walk** — Stroll from the port through the Sea Garden to the Aleksandrovska pedestrian street, the Archaeological Museum, and...

BEST WALKS

- Sea Garden & Central Beach Loop** 2 km • 30-40 min • Easy — From the pier, walk north into the Sea Garden (Morska Gradina) — Bulgaria's largest coastal park.
- Old Town Pedestrian Streets** 1.5 km • 20-30 min • Easy — Head west from the port along Bulair Street into the city centre.

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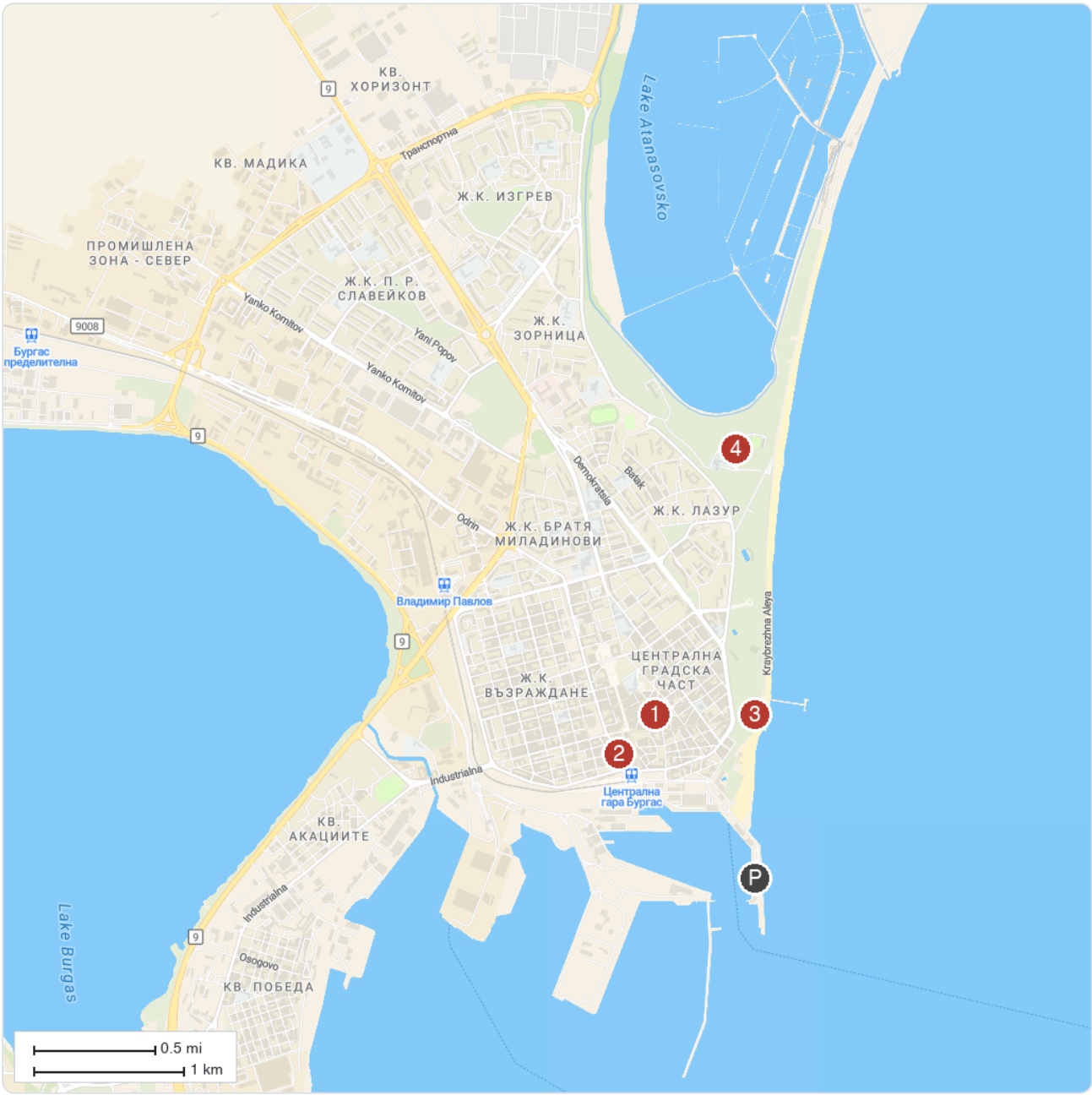
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euro since 2026: Bulgaria adopted the euro on 1 January 2026. ATMs dispense euros; most places take cards. Keep a little cash for smaller cafes and market stalls.
- Taxi caution: Summer overcharging is well-documented. Use Bolt or Uber (both active in Burgas), or insist the driver starts the
