TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Haedong Yonggungsa Temple** — One of Korea's only seaside Buddhist temples, founded 1376, perched on dramatic coastal cliffs north of the city.
- **Jagalchi Fish Market** — Korea's largest seafood market bustles with live tanks, dried fish stalls, and the famed 'Jagalchi Ajumma' women vendors.
- **Gamcheon Culture Village** — A maze of pastel-painted homes cascading down a hillside — dubbed the 'Machu Picchu of Busan.' Explore street art...
- **Taejongdae Cliffs & Lighthouse** — Rocky coastal cliffs on the southern tip of Yeongdo Island, with forested walking trails, a small lighthouse, and...
- **Haeundae Beach** — Busan's most famous beach — a wide sandy arc flanked by high-rise hotels.

BEST WALKS

- **Nampo Waterfront to BIFF Square** 2 km · 30 min · Easy — From BPIT walk the harbour promenade past the Busan Modern History Museum to Nampo-dong's pedestrian street, ending at BIFF Square for...
- **Yongdusan Park & Busan Tower** 1 km · 20 min · Easy — Escalators whisk you up to Yongdusan Park from Nampo street level.

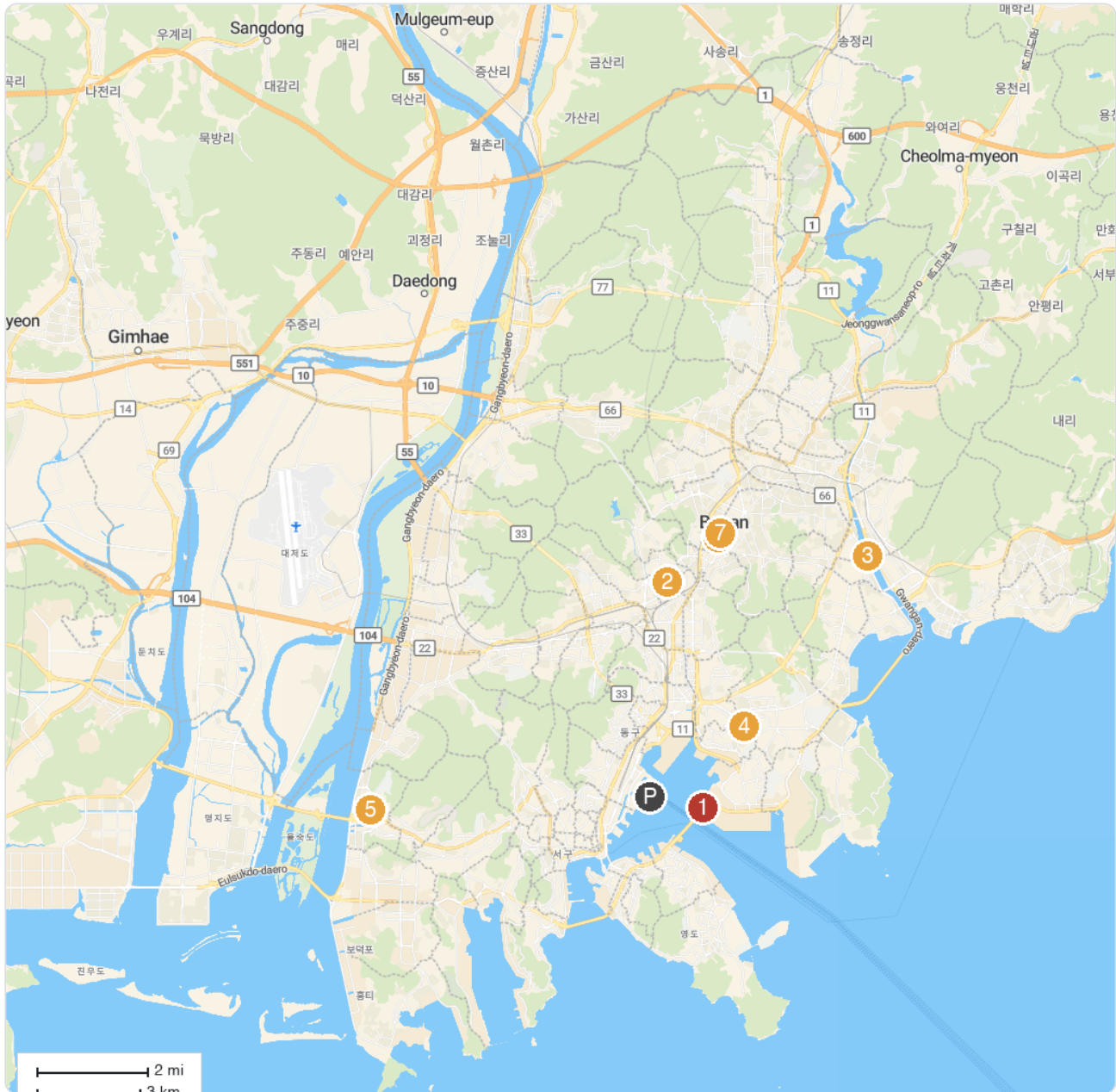
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
