GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Coron Bay; 15-30 min tender ride to Coron Town Pier (Lualhati Park Pier)

Best For: Snorkeling, WWII wreck diving, island hopping, scenic lake hikes

Walk to center: Coron Town Pier is right in the heart of town — market, shops and tricycles are steps away

Don't Miss: Kayangan Lake viewpoint and Twin Lagoon — both reached on the same island-hopping bangka tour

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kayangan Lake & Twin Lagoon Tour** — The quintessential Coron day.
- WWII Shipwreck Diving & Snorkeling** — Coron Bay holds one of the world's best collections of WWII Japanese shipwrecks, sunk in 1944.
- Siete Pecados Marine Park Snorkel** — Seven limestone islets just off Coron Town harbor some of the richest coral reefs in the area.
- Maquinit Hot Springs** — A rare saltwater hot spring about 20 minutes from town by tricycle.
- Mt. Tapyas Viewpoint Hike** — A short tricycle ride from the pier, then roughly 700 steps to the summit.

BEST WALKS

- Coron Town Center Stroll** 1 km · 20 min · Easy · No elevation — From the pier, walk through Lualhati Park along the waterfront, past the wet market to Coron Central Plaza and the town church.
- Mt. Tapyas Steps** ~700 steps each way · 45-60 min round trip · Moderate · Bring water — A short tricycle ride from the pier drops you at the base of Mt.

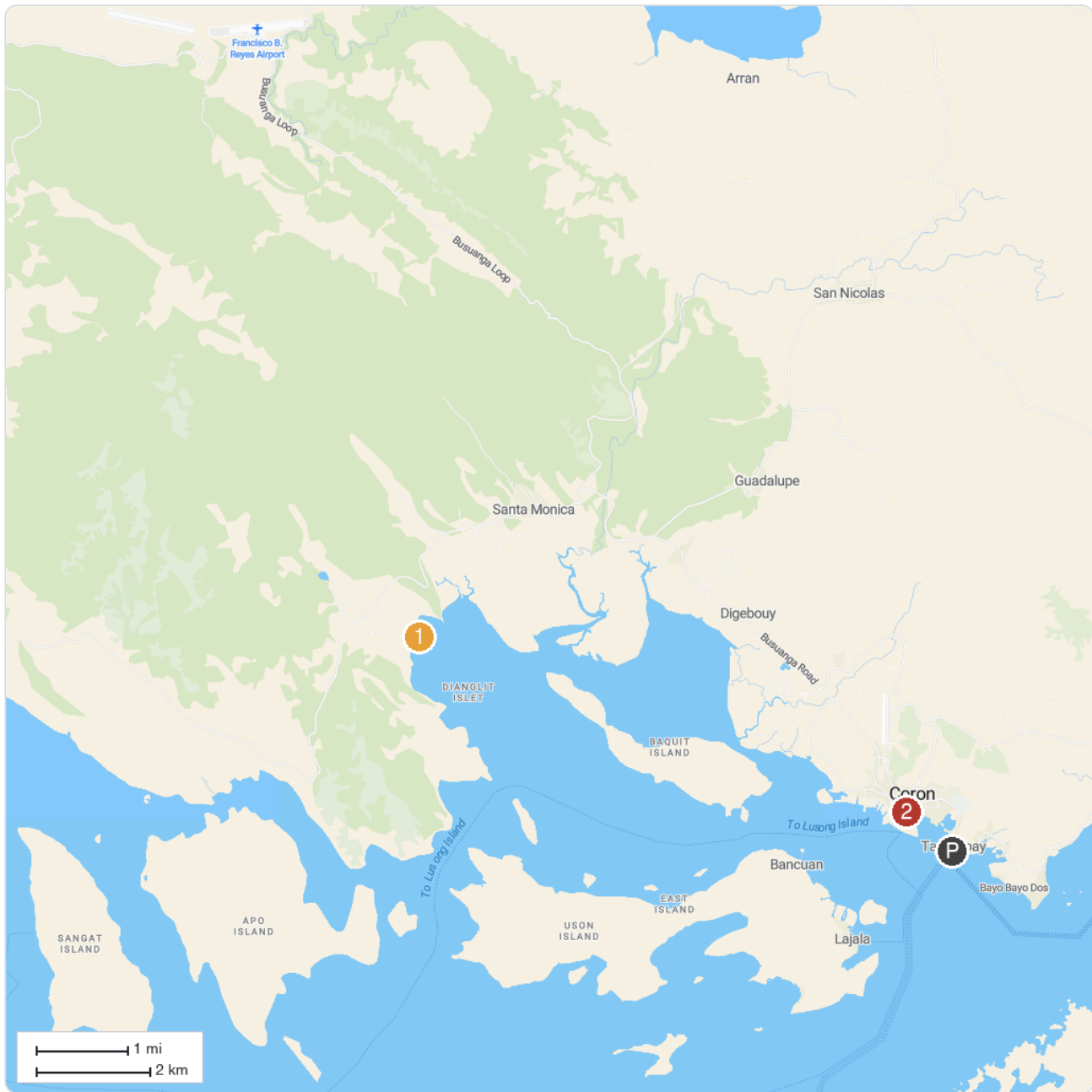
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
