 - Rua das Pedras Walk** — Stroll the cobblestone heart of Búzios, lined with boutiques, galleries, and cafés.
- Sailing Trip to the Islands** — Charter a traditional schooner and cruise the peninsula, stopping for snorkeling in crystal-clear Atlantic waters at...
 - Porto da Barra Visit** — Head to this waterfront complex in Manguinhos for fresh seafood, sunset cocktails, and views over the calm bay.

BEST WALKS

- The Bohemian Heart** Rua das Pedras & surroundings — Start at the pier, walk to Rua das Pedras, and explore the boutiques and cafes.
- The Coastal Path** Orla Bardot to Armação — Follow the oceanfront promenade past the fishermen's pier and colorful boats for a scenic coastal stroll.
- Beachside Wander** Praia da Ferradura — A relaxing walk around the crescent-shaped bay of Ferradura, known for its calm waters and peaceful atmosphere.

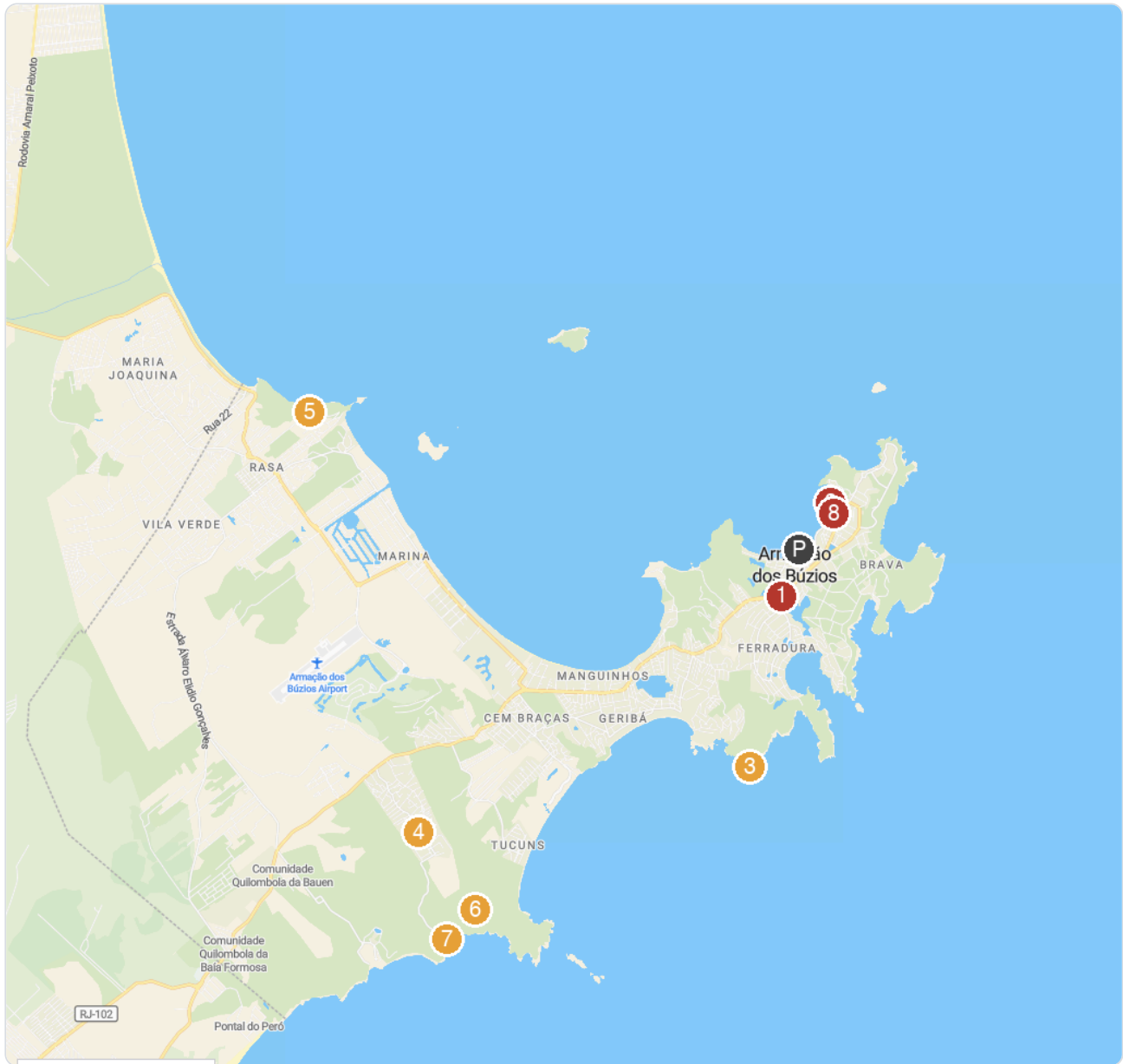
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
