- **Old Town & Cathedral** — The golden-domed Cádiz Cathedral, the Roman theatre, Plaza de las Flores market, and the Torre Tavira camera obscura...
- **Seville Day Trip** — Andalusia's dazzling capital — the vast Gothic cathedral and Giralda, the Real Alcázar palace, and the Plaza de España.
- **Jerez: Sherry & Horses** — The home of sherry — a bodega tour and tasting — paired with the famous Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art's...
- **La Caleta Beach & Sea Walls** — The pretty city beach framed by two castles, plus a stroll along the Atlantic sea-wall promenades and the Genovés park...

BEST WALKS

- **Old town & cathedral loop** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From Plaza San Juan de Dios past the market and Plaza de las Flores to the golden-domed cathedral, then up the Torre Tavira for a...
- **La Caleta & castles** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — Out to La Caleta beach between the Santa Catalina and San Sebastián castles, with sweeping Atlantic views along the sea wall.
- **Genovés Park & sea promenade** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — The leafy botanical park and the Alameda sea-wall promenade on the city's northwest edge — shade, ocean breeze, and ramparts.

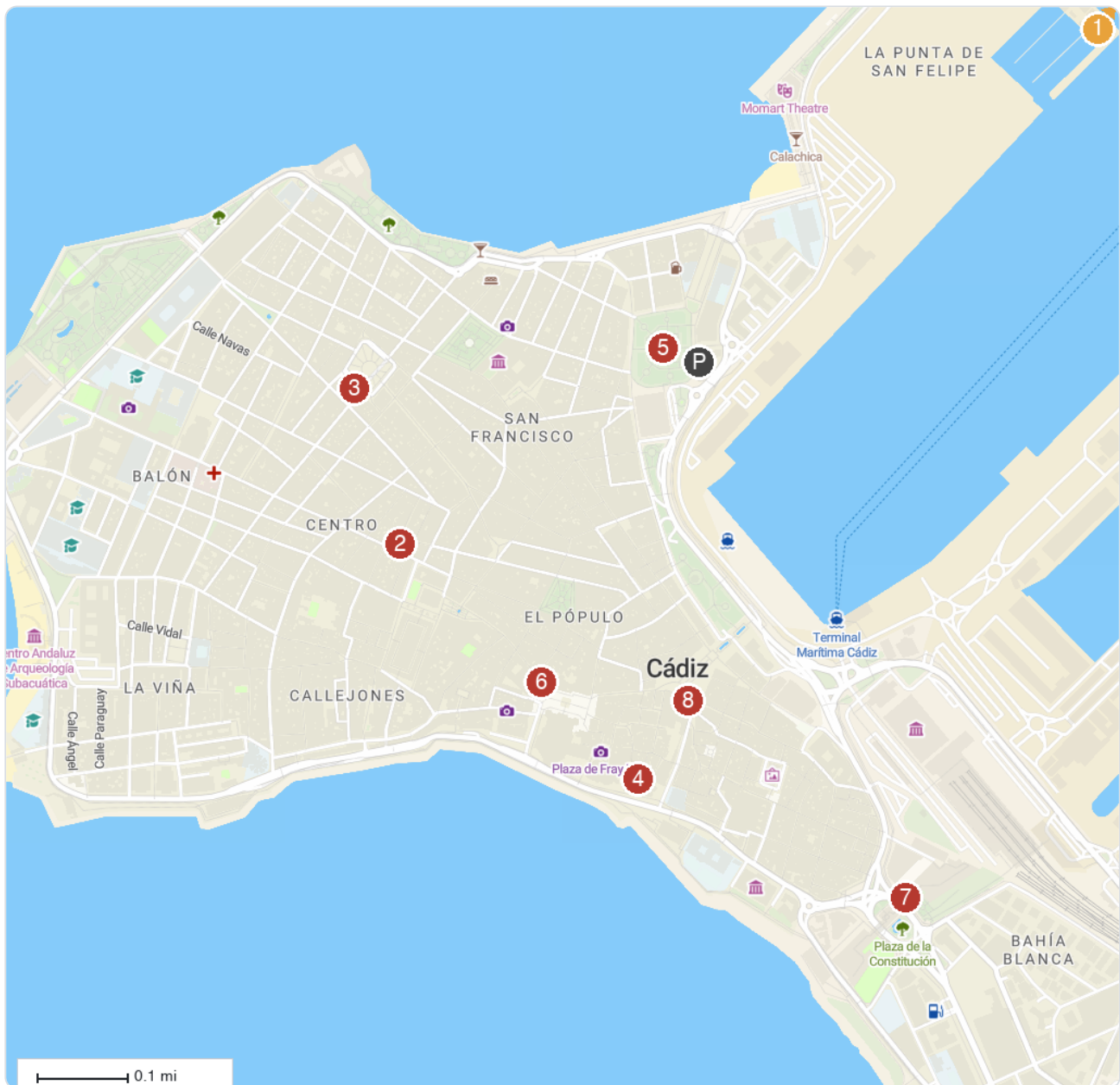
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Decide Seville early. It's an 8+ hour round trip — magnificent, but it eats the whole day. Jerez is a closer, lighter Andalusian alternative.
- Cádiz rewards wandering. One of Europe's oldest cities is compact and walkable from the ship — easy to DIY with no tour.
- Eat the fried fish. Cádiz invented pescaíto frito — grab a paper cone of fresh fried seafood from a freiduría in the old town.
