GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Terminal Croisières, Ferry Terminal area — large ships may anchor and tender

Best For: History, art, coastal scenery, day trips to Cap Blanc-Nez or Boulogne

Walk to centre: ~20-30 min on foot; taxis and shuttle buses available

Don't Miss: Rodin's Burghers of Calais at the Town Hall & the Dragon of Calais on the beach promenade

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Burghers of Calais & Town Hall** — Rodin's monumental bronze stands outside the Flemish Renaissance Town Hall — one of the most famous sculptures in France.
- **Cité Internationale de la Dentelle et de la Mode** — Calais lace has dressed royalty and haute couture for two centuries.
- **Musée Mémoire 39-45 (WWII Bunker)** — Walk through one of Europe's longest accessible German Atlantic Wall bunkers, packed with original artefacts and maps...
- **Cap Blanc-Nez & Opal Coast Drive** — The dramatic white chalk cliffs of Cap Blanc-Nez rise 134 m above the Channel — on a clear day you can see the cliffs...
- **Dragon of Calais Beach Promenade** — The 10-metre mechanical Dragon of Calais breathes smoke and carries passengers along the seafront — half art...

BEST WALKS

- **Port to Place d'Armes & Town Hall** 2.5 km · ~30 min · Easy — Walk from the Terminal Croisières along Boulevard de la Résistance into the city centre, reaching the grand Place d'Armes and the...
- **Town Hall to Lace Museum & Beach Dragon** 2 km · ~25 min · Easy — From the Town Hall head north-west via Rue Dupont to the Cité de la Dentelle, then continue to the seafront promenade to find the...

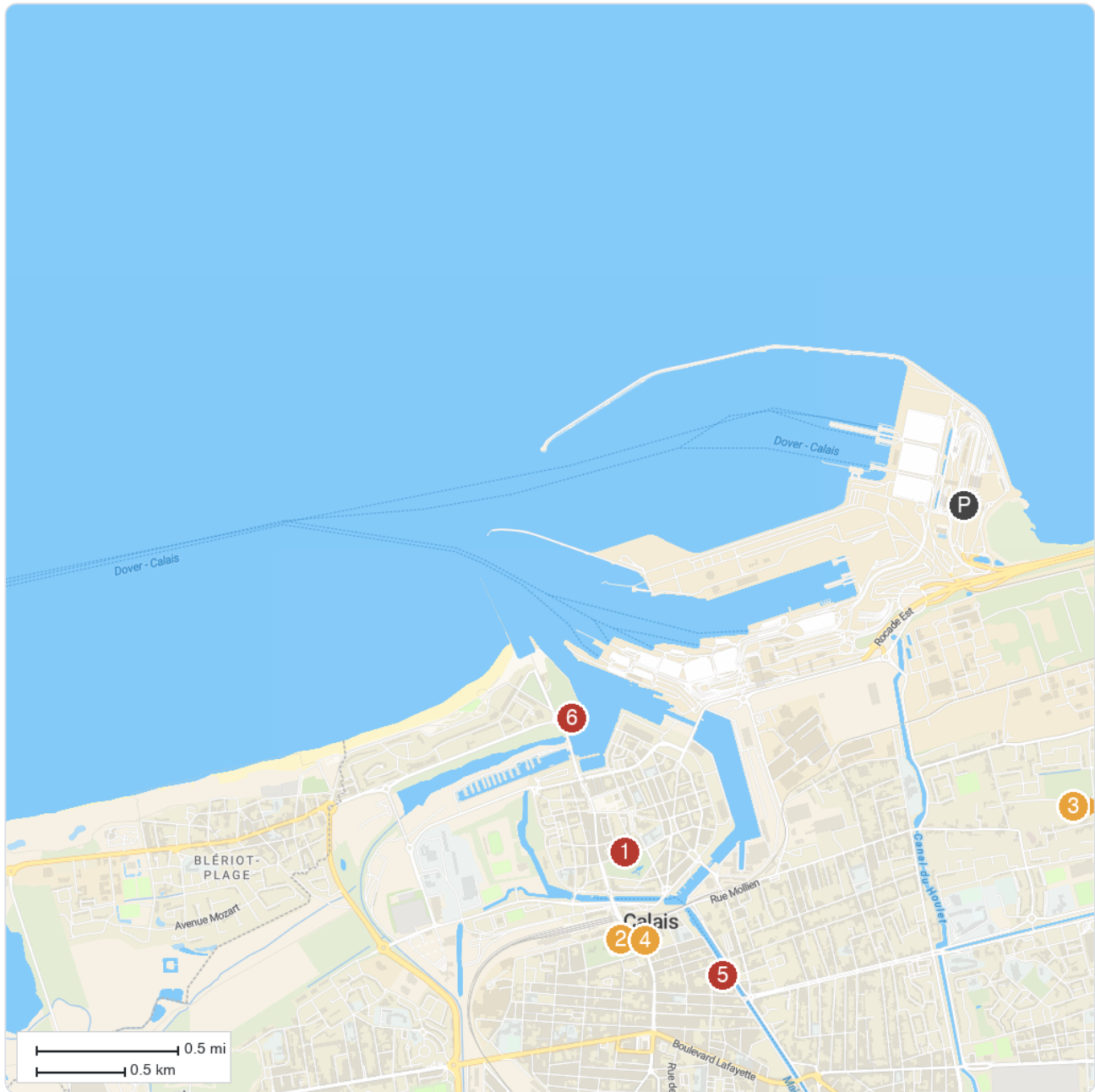
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Taxi from pier to centre costs €10-12 and saves 30 minutes. Agree the fare before getting in — meters aren't always used for short port runs.
- Book the Dragon ride in advance if you want to ride on top — day-of tickets sell out in summer. Walking alongside to watch is free.
