GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Penobscot Bay; tenders land at Camden Public Landing

Best For: Schooner sails, lobster boat tours, Camden Hills State Park hikes

Walk to center: Immediate — town begins steps from the Public Landing

Don't Miss: A 2-hour windjammer sail out of Camden Harbor

Getting around: **Taxi** — (minimum fare) · **Rideshare** Uber, Lyft

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Windjammer Sail on Penobscot Bay** — Board one of Camden's historic two-masted schooners for a 2-hour day sail across Penobscot Bay.
 - **Lobster Boat & Lighthouse Cruise** — Ride a working lobster boat out to haul traps, learn the gear, and cruise past Curtis Island Light and Rockland...
- **Camden Hills State Park Hike** — A short drive (about 2 miles north on US Route 1) brings you to Camden Hills State Park.
 - **Downtown Camden Walk & Shops** — Camden's compact Main Street is packed with independent boutiques, art galleries, the historic Camden Opera House, and...
 - **Sea Kayaking Penobscot Bay** — Paddle rentals and guided kayak tours depart from the harbor area.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor Park to Downtown Loop** 0.5 miles · Easy · 30 min — From the Public Landing, walk along the harbor past the schooner fleet, through Harbor Park, and up Bayview Street to Main Street.
- **Mount Battie Trail, Camden Hills State Park** ~1 mile round-trip · Moderate (steep) · 1.5-2 hrs — Most visitors taxi the ~2 miles north on US Route 1 to the park entrance.

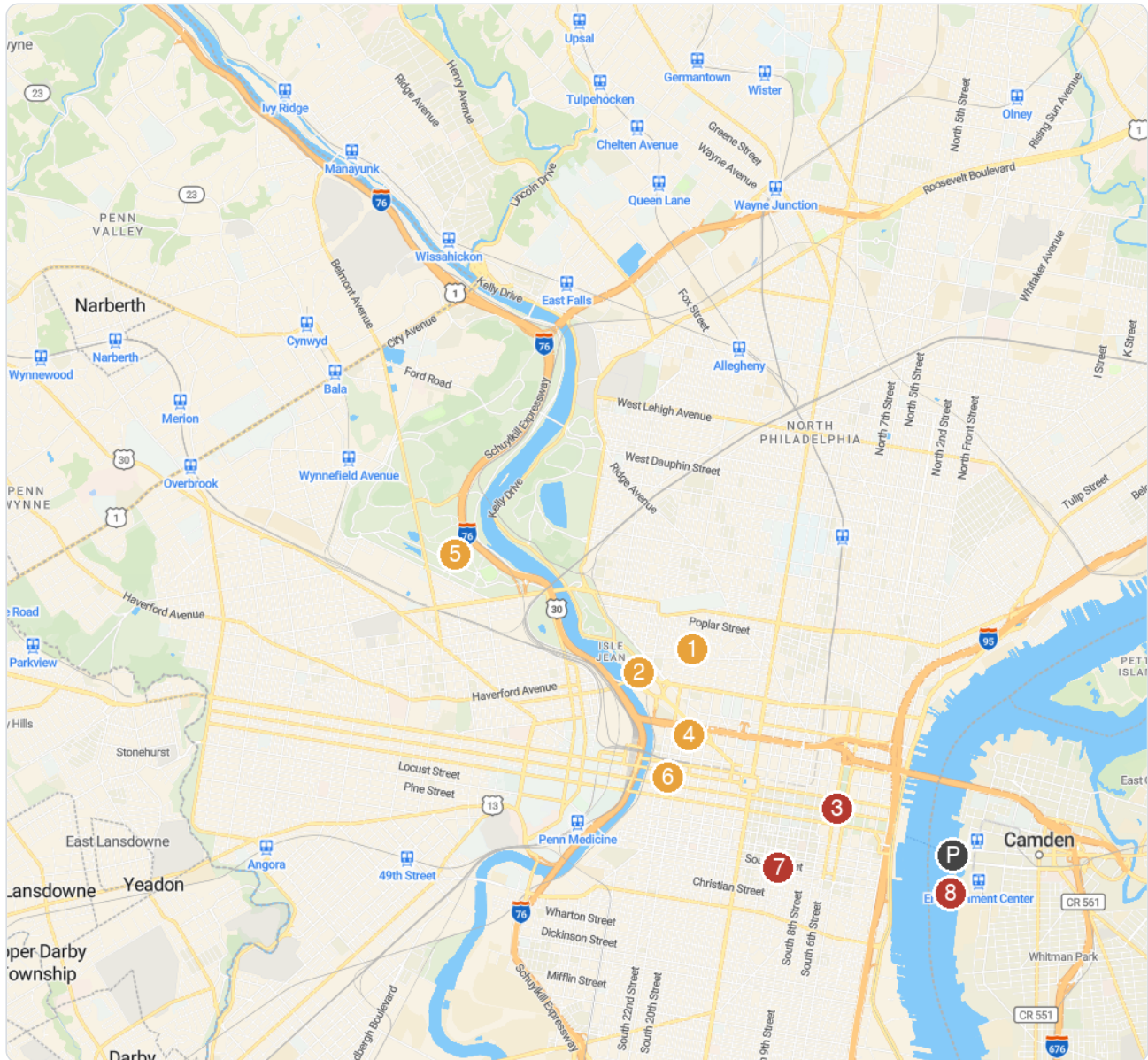
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Arrive early for tenders. Camden tenders can get backed up mid-morning in summer. First tenders ashore get the best schooner seats — many sails sell out.
- Eat lobster deckside. The Waterfront Restaurant and other harbor-facing spots serve fresh caught Maine lobster. Plan lunch
